SEVEN-RUN 11TH LEADS SHRIMP TO VICTORY

Jacksonville erupted for seven runs in the 11th inning on Wednesday to beat Norfolk 7-1. The game was scoreless through the 10th inning. RBI singles from **Jesús Bastidas** and **Jared Serna** started the scoring. **Andrew Pintar** and **Deyvison De Los Santos** added bases-loaded walks before a **Joe Mack** RBI ground out made it 5-0. **Johnny Olmstead** capped the scoring in the inning with a two-run double. In the bottom of the 11th, **Weston Wilson** scored on a wild pitch to set the final margin at 7-1. The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen combined to yield only one unearned run on two hits in 6.2 innings, striking out 12.

SEVEN ELEVEN

Following 10 scoreless innings by both sides on Wednesday, the Jumbo Shrimp exploded for seven runs in the top of the 11th to earn their fourth consecutive win. The seven runs scored not only matched Jacksonville's largest output in a game this season, but were the club's most in an inning since tallying eight runs in game two of a doubleheader on August 21, 2025 at Worcester. On the pitching side, the Jumbo Shrimp's 17 strikeouts were their most in a game since also fanning 17 Charlotte Knights on September 6, 2025.

SHUT DOWN CYCLE

Over the last four games, Jacksonville has yielded only four runs, three earned, on 10 hits in 38.0 innings (0.71 ERA). The club's pitching dominance coincides with a four-game winning streak to help the Jumbo Shrimp rebound from a 1-6 start - their worst in recorded club history (since at least 2005). During this four-game stretch, Jacksonville hurlers have combined to tally 55 strikeouts (38.5 percent of their 143 batters faced) against 20 walks.

MEN OF STEAL

In 2024, the Jumbo Shrimp mustered only 86 stolen bases, 29th in Triple-A and 119th out of the 120 MiLB teams. In 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp swiped a franchise-record 305 bags, second-most in Triple-A and sixth-best in MiLB. Jacksonville, which had not finished in the top five at their level in stolen bases since at least 2005, had more games with multiple stolen bases (84) in 2025 than games with either one steal (32) or no steals (34) combined.

GOOD MORNING, GOOD AFTERNOON, GOODNIGHT

Jacksonville has recorded double-digit strikeouts in all but two games thus far in 2026, with the lone exceptions being a pair of nine-punchout performances. Jumbo Shrimp hurlers have tallied at least 14 strikeouts in seven of the last eight games, totaling 112 against 37 walks during that span. As a result, heading into play on Thursday, Jacksonville leads all of Triple-A with 141 strikeouts on the season. The club's pitchers have combined to fan 32.9 percent of opposing hitters (MLB average: ~24.1%). Second-place Louisville's 119 strikeouts are closer to 16th-place than they are to Jacksonville in first.

TRUST THE PROCESS

Jacksonville ranks 29th or 30th in Triple-A in several offensive categories, including average (.188), OBP (.312), SLG (.292), OPS (.604) and hits (65). The potential silver lining for the club has been they also own Triple-A's second-lowest BABIP at .244, far below the baseball-wide average of roughly .300. Perhaps encouragingly is that the Jumbo Shrimp rank much higher, even if not elite, at the level in chase rate (15th, 28.0 percent), barrel percentage (18th, 5.8 percent), average exit velocity (18th, 87.9) and hard-hit percentage (19th, 34.7 percent).

'PEN PALS

Jacksonville's bullpen led Triple-A in ERA (3.64) and BAA (.214) in 2025 while also throwing the fifth-most innings (700.2) of any bullpen at the level. However, over the first five games of 2026, Jumbo Shrimp relievers combined to surrender 22 runs, 21 earned, on 27 hits (9.6 H/9) in 25.1 innings for a 7.46 ERA (21 BB, 7.5 BB/9, 38 K, 13.5 K/9). The club has turned that around over the last six contests, yielding only three runs, two earned, on 10 hits (2.6 H/9) in 34.0 innings for a 0.53 ERA (12 BB, 3.2 BB/9, 55 K, 14.6 K/9). Jacksonville relievers have combined to cede one unearned run over their last 21.2 innings.

POPCORN SHRIMP

Jacksonville is just 11-for-73 (.151) with runners in scoring position over the last seven games... **Jared Serna** matched a career-high on Wednesday with four hits... **Deyvison De Los Santos** has reached base in all seven Triple-A games he has played in this season.

ABOUT PATRICK

-Monteverde is the youngest child from a massive family. He is the youngest of 27 grandchildren on his dad's side and the youngest of 18 grandchildren on his mom's side. Both of Monteverde's parents are the youngest of twelve.

-A native of Pittsburgh, Monteverde started his collegiate baseball career at Division III Virginia Wesleyan (Norfolk, Va.) for a season, posting a 1.96 ERA in 82 2/3 innings. In 2018, he moved up a rung, transferring to Division II Seton Hill in Greensburg, Pennsylvania, about 45 minutes from Monteverde's home. He had a solid first year there in 2018 (3.04 ERA), but three starts into his second season with the Griffins, he heard a pop in his elbow and underwent Tommy John surgery. Monteverde made just one more start for Seton Hill in 2020 before the COVID pandemic then shut down the season for him.
