PLAYOFF BOUND

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.

- Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
- This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
- The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

IN GOOD STANDINGS

While the standings reset for the start of the 2nd half on June 25, Omaha's enters today's game 26 games over .500 with a 62-36 record (.633 winning percentage).

- 62 wins are the 2nd-most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, trailing 64 from the Sugar Land Space Cowboys, Houston's Triple-A affiliate.
- Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .633 winning percentage overall this year is the 3rd-best the Minors, just behind Sugar Land (.643) and the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (.645), Milwaukee's High-A team.
- The Storm Chasers have still been 1st or 2nd in the Minors in wins every day since May 25 ... Omaha previously held sole possession of the best winning percentage in full-season Minor League Baseball for 30 days, June 5 to July 5.
- Omaha is currently on pace for 94 wins ... the franchise record is 86 wins from the Omaha Royals in 1990 ... the best winning percentage in Triple-A Omaha history was .607 (85-55) in the inaugural 1969 season.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

62 of Omaha's 98 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 23 of 36 losses in 2024, with 12 of 36 losses by just one run (36%).

- Close games have been a struggle for Omaha in recent weeks, with the bullpen converting just 10 of its last 19 save opportunities, since June 5 (52%).
- Omaha is 19-12 in 1-run games this season, which ranks as tied for the 7th-most 1-run wins of any Minor League team.
- As a team, Omaha's 30 saves are tied for the 4th-most of any Minor League team, 2nd-most in Triple-A and the top mark in the league ... **Will Klein's** 9 saves individually rank 6th in the International League, while **Evan Sisk** has recorded the team's last four saves in his last four appearances.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 546 to 451 this season, a +95 run differential.

- A +95 run differential this year ranks as the best mark in the International League and 3rd at the Triple-A level, behind Tacoma (+106) and Syracuse (+98).
- Omaha is 10th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Greensboro Grasshoppers lead the Minors at +162 (574 to 412).

JULY, JULY!

A pair of Omaha hitters are in their best stretches of this season in the month of July.

- In 17 games this month, outfielder **Tyler Gentry** is hitting .400 (24-for-60) with a 1.104 OPS this month and leads the team in hits and total bases (38).
- Over 10 games in July, catcher **Brian O'Keefe** has thrived despite limited playing time, hitting .448 (13-for-29) in July, with a 1.450 OPS ... he is tied for the team lead in HR (4), 2nd in RBI (11) ... O'Keefe is on a career-best 20-game on-base streak too.

DAZZLING DEFENSE

Omaha's defense has had its ups and downs this season, but the team is on one of its best stretches in the field this season.

- Over Omaha's last 42 games (since June 5), a .986 fielding percentage (20 errors in 1,451 total chances) is the BEST in Minor League Baseball over that span.
- Overall this year, a .981 fielding percentage is tied 7th in the league, tied 9th in Triple-A and tied 12th of the 120 full-season Minor League teams.
- The Storm Chasers have not made an error in 15 of the team's last 25 games ... Omaha went 7 straight games without making an error, March 31 to April 7, also with a stretch 6 straight errorless games from June 29 to July 4.

COMEBACK KIDS

Omaha has 36 come-from-behind wins this season, meaning over half (58%) of this year's wins have been games where the Chasers trailed at some point.

- The Storm Chasers have come back from down as many as 5 runs to win and have overcome a 3+ run deficit to win on 10 occasions.
- Omaha has trailed for three innings or more in 14 of the 35 comeback wins, with 6 victories where the club had to overcome multiple deficits ... the team has 9 wins in games where they trailed after the 6th inning, including last Sunday's victory when trailing from the first pitch of the game, into the bottom of the 9th inning.

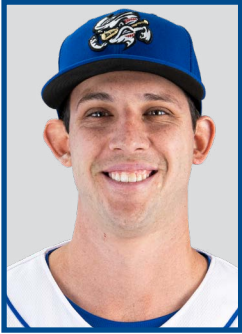

TODAY'S START

- Lynch IV is making his 17th Omaha start this season, his 20th overall start and 22nd overall appearance in 2024... today is his 6th career start vs. St. Paul... Lynch is on his 4th stint in Triple-A with Omaha... Daniel ranks 4th in the International League in ERA (3.70) and 6th in WHIP (1.30)...

LAST OUTING: SUNDAY, JULY 21 vs. INDIANAPOLIS

Allowed a first-pitch leadoff home run to Ji Hwan Bae, but kept Indianapolis scoreless the rest of his outing... did not record a 1-2-3 inning all game, stranded one runner on in the 2nd through 6th innings; single in the 2nd, walk in the 3rd, error in the 4th, single in the 5th, catcher's interference in the 6th... got the first two outs of the 7th inning, but a walk and single ended his day, runners didn't score.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Daniel was optioned to Triple-A Omaha on March 20 and started Opening Day for the Storm Chasers, March 29 @ Iowa, his first of 5 Omaha starts that have been 5.0 innings. In his second stint with Omaha, Daniel threw back-to-back quality starts for the Chasers, May 19 @ St. Paul and May 25 vs. Columbus... combined to allow 2 earned runs on 10 hits with 1 walk over 13.2 innings.

CAREER NOTES

- Limited to just 9 starts for the Royals around a pair of stints on the Injured List... missed the first 53 games of the season due to a rotator cuff strain suffered in Spring Training, then missed the last 66 games of the season with a left shoulder strain. Made 5 rehab appearances (4 with Omaha) prior to his return to the Royals, during which he recorded a 3.98 ERA (9 ER in 20.1 IP)...

- Spent April at the Alternate Training Site in Springdale, AR and was slated to start the year in Omaha... had his contract selected on May 3 without having pitched in a game above the High-A level and went on to make 15 starts with the Royals over two stints. Allowed 15 runs in 8.0 innings over his first stint (3 starts)... he was optioned to Omaha May 14 and made 12 appearances (11 starts) and returned to Kansas City on July 25 and went 4-1 over his next 7 starts with a 2.23 ERA (10 ER in 40.1 IP).
