Tonight's Game: The Sounds are set for game two this evening at First Horizon Park. Nashville will send right-hander Carlos Rodriguez to the mound. He will face off against left-hander Daniel Lynch IV. The first pitch is set for 6:35 p.m. from Hit City.

Carlos Rodriguez: The 22-year-old right-hander is making his fourth appearance (third start) for the Sounds this season. He has been charged with the loss in all three outings thus far. Last time out, Rodriguez set his Triple-A high in innings (5.1) while allowing five hits, six earned runs, two walks and striking out six. He has a 7.41 ERA ( $17.0 \mathrm{IP} / 14 \mathrm{ER}$ ) in four total appearances in Triple-A compared to a 2.77 ERA (123.2 IP/38 ER) in 25 starts for Double-A Biloxi. Rodriguez ranks as the number eight prospect for the Brewers according to MLB.com. He is the third highest ranked pitcher in the system behind Jacob Misiorowski and Robert Gasser. Rodriguez was selected in the sixth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft from Florida Southwestern State Junior College.
vs. LH Starters:
Daniel Lynch IV: The 27-year-old lefty is making his fourth start for Omaha this season. He is 1-0 with a 5.79 ERA ( $14.0 \mathrm{IP} / 9 \mathrm{ER}$ ) and 11 strikeouts. Lynch IV has 51 career starts in the MLB with Kansas City posting an 11-23 record with a 5.18 ERA (252.0 IP/ 145 ER ) and 211 strikeouts. He was drafted 34th overall by the Royals in 2018 from the University of Virginia. In 22 career appearances ( 21 starts) for Triple-A Omaha he is $7-3$ with a 5.14 ERA ( $98.0 \mathrm{IP} / 56$ ER) and 99 strikeouts. He ranked third in the American League with 13 losses in 2022 for Kansas City. Lynch IV peaked as the \#3 ranked prospect in the Royals Organization according to MLB.com back in 2021 behind Bobby Witt Jr. and Asa Lacy.

In the Air Tonight: Isaac Collins had two doubles and a triple last night. This was his first time recording three extra-base hits in a game since July 14, 2022, vs. Harrisburg where he also had two double s and a triple. It also ties his career high in doubles in a game with two which he has accomplished eight times. Last night was the first time this season that two Sounds players have recorded three hits in the same game (Collins and Monasterio). Collins has a .290 batting average ( 9 -for- 31 ) this season with a .710 slugging percentage. His 22 total bases in only nine games ranks fourth on team trailing Owen Miller ( 23 in 13 games), Tyler Black (23 in 15 games) and Brewer Hicklen ( 31 in 15 games).

Hit City: The Sounds offense exploded last night setting season-highs in hits (13), doubles (5), extra-base hits (7), and stolen bases (4). As a team, they also set season-highs by
striking out 14 times and hits allowed (13). Andruw Monasterio had a three-hit effort in his first game of 2024 for the Sounds. This was his first three-hit game for Nashville since May 9, 2023, versus Gwinnett. He had a three-hit game in his last series against Omaha (April $26,2023)$. Vinny Capra had his second consecutive two-hit game and has five on the season. He is tied with Brewer Hicklen for second on the team and trails Owen Miller with six.

Bullpen Beat: The Sounds bullpen allowed its first earned run in 22.0 innings dating back to the sixth inning vs. St. Paul on April 7. Nashville relievers have four wins on the season and boast the best ERA (1.10),
WHIP ( 0.95 ) and opponent batting average (.152) at the Triple-A level Enoli Paredes (7.0 IP), Rob Zastryzny (5.2 IP), Harold Chirino (5.0 IP), and Darrell Thompson (2.0 IP) have yet to allow an earned run in multiple appearances this season. The next best ERA among Triple-A bullpens is Columbus at 3.17 ( $65.1 / 25 \mathrm{ER}$ ) and the next closest opponent batting average is Syracuse at .201. Overall, Nashville's pitching staff has the lowest WHIP (1.28) and opponent batting average (.214) has the fourth-lowest team ERA (4.07) in the league.

Hoppy Haase: Eric Haase clubbed his third home run of the six-game series at Memphis on Sunday, a go-ahead three-run shot that gave Nashville an early lead. Only former-Sound now Durham Bull Alex Jackson (4) and Iowa's Matt Mervis (4) had more home runs in last week's International League games. Haase's eight RBI also finished tied for the second most in the league, one behind Drew Waters' (Omaha) nine. In eight games, Haase is batting . 273 ( 9 -for-33) with five of his nine hits going for extra bases. He has recorded an RBI in three straight games and reached base in eight of his nine games played this season.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 690-592 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,282-2,113 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).
