### FROM THE CROW'S NEST

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Marauders managed just four hits, all singles, in Tuesday's 4-1 loss to the Tarpons... **Rodolfo Nolasco** recorded three of the team's hits, going 3-for-4 with an RBI... Rehabbing Pirates righty **Duane Underwood Jr.** (right hamstring strain) was unable to escape the first inning, throwing 23 pitches and leaving with the bases loaded... **Darvin Garcia** took over in relief and walked home a run before escaping the inning... Nolasco delivered an RBI-single in the bottom of the first to tie the score, but Bradenton would not score again, stranding 10 runners in the game... A go-ahead, two-run double in the fourth by Grant Richardson off **Justin Meis** put the Tarpons in the lead the rest of the way... **Carlos Jimenez** worked 3.1 IP in relief, striking out a season-high eight (one shy of career-high).

**THE OPPONENT:** The Tarpons are coming off a rain-shortened three-games-to-two series win over Lakeland after being swept at Clearwater in their previous series. Tampa's roster currently features four players in *Baseball America's* pre-season top 30 prospect rankings for the Yankees organization: OF Jasson Dominguez (#3), LHP Brock Selvidge (#17), 1B Anthony Garcia (#27), and INF Alexander Vargas (#28).

**NEW KID ON THE BLOCK:** RHP **Johan Montero** joined the Marauders last Friday after beginning the season in the Complex. The right-hander from Maracay, Venezuela made his Single-A debut Sunday against Dunedin, retiring six of seven batters in two scoreless innings of relief. Montero owns a career 3.75 ERA and 1.45 WHIP in 29 appearances (all in relief) across three seasons.

**GONZALEZ GOES ON:** First baseman **Jacob Gonzalez** is enjoying a productive first season in the Pirates organization. The Scottsdale, Az. native has reached base safely in each of his first 20 games, batting .425 (31-for-73) with four home runs, 14 RBI, and a 1.191 OPS. Gonzalez leads the Florida State League in AVG, SLG, OPS, hits, and total bases. The Pirates acquired Gonzalez from San Francisco in the minor league portion of the Rule 5 draft in December.

**TOP PROSPECTS:** The Marauders roster currently includes one prospect in *Baseball America's* pre-season Top 30 ranking for the Pirates organization: outfielder **Rodolfo Nolasco** (#21). *Baseball America* lists the Pirates' farm system as the third-best in baseball.

**FIELD STAFF:** Manager **Jonathan Johnston**, 2021 Low-A Southeast Manager of the Year, is in his second season at the helm for the Marauders... Former major leaguer **Yorman Bazardo** is the club's new pitching coach after spending 2021 as a pitching coach for the FCL Pirates... Former Pirate **Mendy López** joins as hitting coach after serving as the Pirates' Latin American Field Coordinator in 2021... **Casey Harms** is the Marauders' Integrated Baseball Performance Coach after a collegiate coaching career in the Northwoods League (Waterloo Bucks, 2019-20) and at UC Santa Barbara (2013-2018)... **Gustavo Omaña** is the Marauders' Development Coach after serving on staff at Triple-A Indianapolis in 2021.

**THE MORE, THE MERRIER:** The Florida State League will play a 132-game schedule this season after playing a 120-game campaign in 2021. The Marauders will play 102 of their 132 games against West Division foes, including 21 games against Dunedin, the largest season series of the year for Bradenton. All but two teams—Daytona and St. Lucie—will visit LECOM Park this season, and the Marauders will travel to each city in the league in 2022 except for Port St. Lucie.

**HITTING TRIPLE DIGITS:** The 2022 season marks the 100th year of operation for LECOM Park, known as City Park upon opening in 1923. It has served as a spring training home for six different MLB franchises, including the Pirates since 1969. Baseball hall-of-famers who once called the historic park their spring home include Henry Aaron, Roberto Clemente, Dizzy Dean, Rogers Hornsby, Reggie Jackson, and more.
