SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Portland Sea Dogs, 7-5, in the series finale, their fifth win in six games for the series. Logan Wyatt opened the scoring with an RBI single in the second. Later in the inning, Ismael Munguia brought in a run with a single and Shane Matheny hit a three-run homer to open a 5-0 lead. The Sea Dogs rallied to tie the score with a two-run homer by NIck Yorke in the third, a solo shot by Phillip Sikes in the fourth and a two-run double by Alex Binelas in the fifth. Matheny moved Richmond back ahead, 6-5, with an RBI single in the sixth, his fourth RBI of the game. Brandon Martorano singled in a run later in the frame to extend the lead to 7-5. Juan Sanchez struck out five over the last two innings to close a six-out save.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. The two teams split a six-game series at The Diamond from May 2-7 and split another six-game set in Richmond from June 6-11. This series marks Richmond's only visit to Altoona this season. The Flying Squirrels are 5-1 in their last six series openers.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 23-11 in their last 34 games since June 18. They went 5-1 last week against the Sea Dogs after going 4-5 on the previous road trip to resume play out of the All-Star Break. Over the last 38 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined for a 3.20 ERA (52 ER/146.1 IP) and have allowed 11 home runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.82 ERA is second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 347.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 478.1 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.48 ERA, which is the second-lowest in Double-A and the seventh-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors.

THE CURVE have dropped three straight and are 3-6 in their last nine games since July 21. In that stretch, they are averaging 2.8 runs per game (25 runs/9 games). They have scored three-or-less runs in seven-of-their-last-nine games. Altoona's roster includes four of Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects, including LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 6), OF Matt Gorski (No. 12), SS Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 13) and RHP Braxton Ashcraft (No. 14). Gorski is rated by Baseball America as the Pirates' best power hitter and best outfield arm. MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects list includes four Curve players, including Solometo (No. 5), Gorski (No. 15), OF Matt Fraizer (No. 20) and Ashcraft (No. 27).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Carson Seymour takes the mound for his 16th Double-A start and his fifth outing against the Curve. Seymour last pitched on Wednesday against the Sea Dogs and allowed three runs over four innings. He has posted a 3.86 ERA in his four outings against the Curve this year, all at The Diamond. Among Eastern League pitchers who have worked at least 70 innings this season, Seymour has the 10th-lowest ERA (4.06), the seventh-lowest WHIP (1.26) and the fifth-highest groundball percentage (49.5). He also has the third-lowest HR/9 (0.70) in the Eastern League (min. 70 IP). A native of Poway, Calif., Seymour was selected by the New York Mets in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Kansas State University. After making four appearances in 2021, he began the 2022 season with Low-A St. Lucie, where he went 4-0 with a 1.19 ERA in seven outings (four starts). He was promoted to High-A Brooklyn on My 23 for 11 outings before being traded to the Giants on August 2 as part of the deal that sent Darin Ruf to the Mets. Seymour closed the year with High-A Eugene, going 2-3 with a 3.99 ERA in six starts. Seymour is rated by Baseball America as the No. 14 Giants prospect and No. 16 by MLB.com. FOR ALTOUNA: Right-hander Beau Sulser makes his fourth Eastern League start of the season. Last time out, he threw four innings and allowed one unearned run at Harrisburg last Wednesday. Sulser was selected in the 10th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the Pirates out of Dartmouth and first reached Double-A with Altoona in 2019. That year, he was selected as an Eastern League All-Star. Sulser made his MLB debut in 2022 before being designated for assignment that May and claimed by the Orioles. In October 2022, he was designated for assignment by Baltimore and claimed by the Pirates before being released last November. Sulser started this season with the KT Wiz of the KBO League in South Korea, going 1-7 with a 5.62 ERA. The Pirates signed Sulser on June 29.

JULY WRAP: The Flying Squirrels went 15-9 in July, the best record in the Eastern League. They opened the month with six consecutive wins before losing the next four. Richmond won two series, lost one (three-game set at Harrisburg) and split two. **Wade Meckler** tied the league lead in triples (2). **Hayden Cantrelle** and **Shane Matheny** tied for the league lead in walks (16). Cantrelle has the 10th-best OBP (.410). **Vaun Brown** ranked seventh with eight steals.

WADE PROMOTED: Outfielder Wade Meckler was promoted to Triple-A Sacramento this week. After opening the season hitting 456 in 20 games with High-A Eugene, he joined the Flying Squirrels on May 17. During his time in the Eastern League from May 17-July 30, Meckler led the league in batting average (.336), ranked second in OBP (.431), eighth in OPS (.881) and tied for seventh in runs scored (36). Overall in the Eastern League this season (min. 150 PA), Meckler ranks first in BABIP (.407), second in batting average (.336), fourth in OBP (.431), eighth in wRC+ (148), 12th in OPS (.881) and is tied for the fourth-lowest swing-and-miss percentage (6.0), went on a 24-game on-base streak from May 17-July 6, which was the longest on-base streak to begin a Double-A career in Flying Squirrels history, passing the previous record set by Luis Matos (17 games) earlier this season. It was also tied for the ninth-longest on-base streak in franchise history. Meckler also had an 11-game run scored streak from June 23-July 6, which was a Flying Squirrels franchise record, passing the previous mark of nine straight games by Tyler LaTorre in 2014. In Game 1 of a doubleheader on June 23, Meckler tied the single-game franchise record for hits, going 5-for-5 and capping the night with a two-run, walk-off single for a 9-8 win over the Senators. Through his promotion, Meckler led the minors (min. 250 PA) in batting average (.377) and BABIP (.439), ranked eighth in OBP (.452) and eighth in wRC+ (166).

SO LONG, SANCHEZ: Lefty reliever **Juan Sanchez** was promoted to Triple-A Sacramento this week. In his 28 games with Richmond, he went 6-4 with a 2.39 ERA and 52 strikeouts over 49 innings, adding three saves. At the time of his promotion, Sanchez ranked fifth in the Eastern League (min. 40 IP) in ERA (2.39), was tied for the eighth-lowest HR/9 (0.55) and was tied for the eighth-lowest BAA (194). Among EL relievers (0 starts, min. 30 IP), Sanchez ranked sixth in ERA and eighth in BAA (194). In his final outing before his promotion on Sunday against the Sea Dogs, Sanchez set a Double-A high with five strikeouts while working a six-out save.

FULL MUNGUIA: In his nine games since returning from the IL, Ismael Munguia is batting .382 (13-for-34) with two doubles, three walks and seven RBIs, adding a .432 on-base percentage. He picked up four hits in his three games in his first series back on the road in Akron from July 21-23. He had nine hits and two walks over six games in last week's series against the Sea Dogs. On Thursday, he had three hits and scored three runs. He entered as a pinch-hitter in the ninth on Saturday night and tied the game with an RBI single, later scoring the winning run. Munguia was placed on the injured list on May 20 and reinstated on July 20, missing 49 games.

GLOW SHOW: Over his last 15 games since July 6, **Jimmy Glowenke** is batting .320 (16-for-50) with two homers, five doubles, 10 RBIs and six walks. On July 18 at Akron, he closed the game a triple shy of the cycle and went 3-for-6 with a three-run homer, a two-run double and an RBI single, picking up a career-high six RBIs. On Saturday against the Sea Dogs, he hit a lead-off double to start the bottom of the ninth in Richmond's comeback win.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny has reached base 14 times in his last six games (six hits and eight walks), posting a .519 on-base percentage and a .316 batting average. On Sunday, he hit a three-run homer and finished the afternoon with four RBIs. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 116 walks, moving ahead of Ricky Oropesa (112, 2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails Jacob Heyward (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career.

TAKE A WALK: Hayden Cantrelle has walked 60 times this season, which is second-most in the Giants organization and is tied for the fourth-most in the Eastern League. His 18.9% walk rate is tied for the second-highest in the league this season. He also has the second-best on-base percentage (,397) in the league this year. His 60 walks this season are the fourth-most in a single year in Flying Squirrels franchise history. He is two walks shy of tying the second on the list, which is currently held by Jarrett Parker (2013) and Mark Minicozzi (2013). The single-season record of 80 was set by Jacob Heyward in 2019. Cantrelle is on pace for 86 walks this season.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have seven players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 6), OF Vaun Brown (No. 8), RHP Mason Black (No. 9), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 14), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 15), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 27) and RHP José Cruz (No. 30). Brown is rated by Baseball America as the best hitter for average and the best athlete, Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best change-up. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes seven Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 4), Brown (No. 6), Black (No. 9), Roupp (No. 12), Seymour (No. 16), Murphy (No. 25) and Cruz (No. 28).

Adam Duvall had three hits, including his 12th homer in the sixth inning.
