Home for a While

The Fightin Phils remain home for the penultimate series of the season's first half on Sunday night against the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. It is the 12th-of-18 meetings between the teams this season and sixth-of-six at FirstEnergy Stadium. Reading trails the season-series 6-5 after dropping five-of-six at Portland from May 19-24 and going 4-1 so far this week. Following this week, Reading returns to Portland from Aug. 18-23 for the teams final matchup of the season.

Another Series Win

The Reading Fightin Phils improved to 28-34 with a 3-2 victory over the Portland Sea Dogs at FirstEnergy Stadium, securing the series win and taking a 4-1 lead with one game remaining. Raylin Heredia continued his hot streak by launching a solo home run in the third inning, his third consecutive game with a homer, to give Reading an early lead. After Portland tied the game in the fifth, the Fightins broke through in the seventh when Erick Brito singled ahead of Bryson Ware's two-run home run, providing the decisive runs. Adam Seminaris delivered one of the best starts by a Reading pitcher in recent years, allowing just one run on three hits over a career-high eight innings while matching a career-best with 10 strikeouts. The left-hander retired the final 11 batters he faced and recorded the longest outing by a Fightin Phils pitcher since 2018. Portland made things interesting in the ninth, scoring once and bringing the tying run aboard, but Wen-Hui Pan escaped the jam with a game-ending double play in his Reading debut. Ware finished with two hits, while Heredia's homer helped pace the offense in Reading's fourth win in five games against Portland.

Career Night for Seminaris

27-year old Adam Seminaris tossed arguably the best start of his professional career on Saturday night. He fired a career-high eight innings, allowing one run on three hits, while matching both a season and career-high with 10 strikeouts. His eight innings pitched marked the longest start by any Eastern League pitcher this season and the most by a Fightin Phils' arm since Tyler Viza fired eight innings on Sept. 1, 2018, at Trenton. Following his dominant start on Saturday, Seminaris is third in the Eastern League in ERA (2.83), first in strikeouts (76), second in innings pitched (63.2) and fifth in WHIP (1.18). He joined the Phillies as a minor league free agent this past offseason after spending time in the Angels, Brewers and Marines organizations.

Going, Going, Gone

The Fightin Phils are back to hitting home runs at a torrid pace this week, as they have lifted an Eastern League-busy 13 long balls through five games this week. Through 62 games, Reading has hit 78 home runs, which ranks second in the Eastern League and they are on pace for 173 this season, which comes after Reading hit 118 in 2025. The Fightin Phils have been led this week by multiple home runs from Raylin Heredia (3), Caleb Ricketts (3), Alex Binelas (2) and Bryson Ware (2). Ware hit the go-ahead home run, a two-run shot, in Saturday night's 3-2 win over Portland.

Raking Raylin

Raylin Heredia has continued his steady 2026 season with another strong week against Portland. Over five games this week, Heredia is slashing .300/.333/.850 (1.183 OPS), along with three runs, two doubles, three home runs and four RBI. Entering play on Sunday, Heredia leads the Eastern League with 21 doubles, while also ranking tied for third with 64 hits, first with 32 extra-base hits and third with 117 total bases.

Bring It Brito

Erick Brito's strong run with Reading has continued this week as he is slashing .471/.526/.824 (1.350 OPS) over five games, along with seven runs scored, three doubles, one home run, four RBI and five stolen bases. The highlight of his week was when he matched a career-high with four hits on Friday night, which featured a game-tying three-run home run in the bottom of the ninth with two outs. He has hits in his last four games and is batting .327 (17-52) over 15 games with Reading so far.

Welcome Back Caleb

Following his transfer from Lehigh Valley (AAA) on Tuesday, Caleb Ricketts reintroduced himself to the Fightin Phils in a big way in his first game back. The 26-year old blasted two home runs, which marked the fourth two-homer game of his career, and second this season (4/21: LHV vs DUR). Ricketts also drove in a career-high six runs, surpassing his previous high of four on June 8, 2025, when rehabbing with Clearwater (A) against Bradenton. His two home runs was the third multi-homer game by a R-Phil this season and his grand slam was the fifth hit by Reading in 2026. Then, he followed it up with four more RBI and another home run on Wednesday night. Through five games with Reading, Ricketts is 8-23 (.348), with three home runs, 11 RBI and a 1.174 OPS. On the other side of the ball, Ricketts ended Thursday night's win with a caught stealing at second base to end the top of the ninth inning.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 14, 2015: Reading ace Aaron Nola (7-3, 1.88 ERA, 59 K) is promoted to Triple-A. He was 3rd in the league in ERA, tied for 1st in wins and 5th in strikeouts.

Playing Portland

The Sea Dogs enter play tonight with a 30-31 record, which is fourth in the Eastern League's Northeast Division and five games out of first place with seven games left in the season's first half. Portland most recently hosted Hartford at home, taking three-of-six games, which included wins on Tuesday and Wednesday, then one on Sunday after dropping three-straight from Thursday-Saturday. Following this week, Portland returns home and welcomes Somerset. The Sea Dogs' roster features 10 of Boston's top-30 prospects: Franklin Arias (1), Anthony Eyanson (2), John Holobetz (12), Hayden Mullins (14), Miguel Bleis (15), Jeddixson Paez (19), Gage Ziehl (20), Nelly Taylor (21), Johanfran Garcia (26) and Yordanny Monegro (28).

Portland Pitcher

Righty John Holobetz makes his 11th appearance (10th start) of the season for Portland tonight. He is 2-3, with a 5.32 ERA (27 ER, 45.2 IP), along with 49 strikeouts. On June 3 vs Hartford, Holobetz fired 4.2 innings, allowing five runs. He earned the win with six-shutout innings vs Reading on May 22. Holobetz split his first pro season in 2025 between the Brewers and Red Sox systems, being traded to Boston on May 5 as the Player to be Named Later in the Quinn Priester deal. Holobetz was a fifth round pick by Milwaukee in 2024 out of Old Dominion and played at Pottsville High School, one hour north of Reading.
