NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

The Storm Chasers opened the 2026 season 0-4, then won 3 straight series, but Omaha enters this week having lost back-to-back series and need a win today to avoid a 3rd straight series loss.

After suffering a season-opening weekend sweep in Louisville, the Storm Chasers went 12-5 between April 1 and 21, with series wins over Buffalo, Iowa and Indianapolis ... Omaha proceeded to lose 7 straight games, from April 22 to 29 ... since April 22, the Chasers are 3-11, dropping 3 of the first 5 games to the Indians.

Omaha had a winning April, with a 13-12 record on the month ... last year, Omaha had just one winning month, going 15-11 in August.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN

Stealing bases has been one of the strongest areas for the Storm Chasers this season, led by one of the league's best baserunners.

Omaha's 84.0% stolen base rate (42-for-50) ranks 2nd in the International League and 3rd at the Triple-A level and is tied 18th among the 120 full-season Minor League teams.

John Rave leads Omaha in steals (10) ... Gavin Cross has 7 steals, while Kameron Misner and Tyler Tolbert have swiped 6 bags ... Tolbert joins Cross as 2 of 4 Storm Chasers who have stolen multiple bases without being caught this year.

PITCH, PLEASE

A constant in 2026 has been Omaha's ability to go deep in plate appearances.

The Storm Chasers are seeing 4.008 pitches per plate appearance, 5th-most in the International League and 8th at the Triple-A level.

Among 361 Triple-A players with 50+ plate appearances this year, John Rave ranks 9th in pitches seen/PA (4.458) while Kameron Misner ranks 16th (4.411).

VICTORY FIELD SCREECH

The Chasers have seen more success in recent years against Indianapolis than any other International League club, with a 59-35 record in 94 games since 2021 and have especially thrived against the Indians in the Circle City itself.

A .628 winning percentage vs. Indianapolis is Omaha's best among the 7 opponents the Chasers have seen at least 20 times since 2021 ... among 54 International League matchups that have happened at least 20 times since 2021, Omaha's .628 winning percentage against Indianapolis is the 5th-best.

Since 2021, Omaha and Indianapolis have played 16 series, with 10 going 6+ games ... Omaha has won 11 of 17 (including 7 of the last 9), while the Indians have won 3 and there have been 3 series splits.

Since 2023, Omaha has won 23 of 32 games at Victory Field (.719 winning percentage) - the most wins Omaha has at an opposing venue in that timeframe ... the .719 winning % at Victory Field since 2023 is the 6th-highest among 566 road team matchups of 24+ games in the Minor Leagues.

CAUGHT CLEAN-HANDED

The Storm Chasers are tied for the 8th-best fielding percentage in the International League with a .980 mark (1st: Louisville, .987), committing just 25 errors in 37 games.

The clean play extends throughout the roster - 5 of Omaha's 16 qualified fielders (min. 60.0 inn.) have a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage, while another 6 of those 16 have committed just 1 error on the season.

Omaha's 37 double plays turned are the 4th-most of any Minor League team ... 4 Storm Chasers infielders have participated in 10 or more double plays, led by Abraham Toro's 24, tied 4th-most of any Minor League player.

BULLPEN OR BUST

With Ethan Bosacker opening today, the Storm Chasers throw their 3rd bullpen game of the week and the 6th of the season.

Omaha has used 11 different starting pitchers this season ... 5 have made 4+ starts, led by Aaron Sanchez (8) and Ryan Ramsey (6).

6 different pitchers have thrown less than 10.0 innings as a starter for Omaha this year, with Ben Sears opening 3 bullpen games and Andrew Pérez and Shane Panzini each opening 1 ... the Chasers are 3-2 in bullpen games this year.

- Ethan Bosacker is making his **3rd start with the Storm Chasers** this year, his **7th overall appearance** in 2026 with Omaha.
- Playing his **4th professional season** this year, all in the Royals organization.

BOSACKER ATTACKER

- ROTATION ROULETTE:** Bosacker has split time between the rotation and bullpen in his four seasons in the Royals organization ... he entered this year slated to start with Double-A Northwest Arkansas before being assigned to Omaha in April 2, making 2 Triple-A starts before transitioning to the bullpen ... between Double-A and Triple-A, he made 8 consecutive starts to open the 2025 season (April 5 to May 17), followed by 8 straight relief appearances (June 13 to July 30), then alternated between roles over his final 9 appearances of last year (August 1 to September 14).
- LATE ROUND STEALS:** As a 13th round draft pick by the Royals in 2023, Bosacker joins **Ryan Ramsey** (13th, 2022), **Ben Sears** (14th, 2022) and **Luca Tresh** (17th, 2021) as a group of four players on the Storm Chasers roster selected by Kansas City in the back half of the draft since 2021.

LAST OUTING: FRIDAY, MAY 1 VS. LOUISVILLE

- Making his 4th straight relief appearance, worked his longest relief outing of the season with 2.2 scoreless innings out of the bullpen on 41 pitches ... took over for starter **Mitch Spence** with 1 out in the 4th inning and allowed an inherited runner to score, before getting the final 2 outs ... pitched a 1-2-3 inning in the 5th, then pitched around a 1-out single for a scoreless 6th inning ... did not come out for the 7th.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Did not appear in a Cactus League game for the Royals ... assigned to Omaha on April 2.
- On Omaha's Development List from May 4 to 7, activated May 8.

CAREER NOTES

- 2025** Split time as both a starter and reliever between Northwest Arkansas (AA) and Omaha ... combined to post a 4.05 ERA (49 ER in 109.0 IP) with a 1.25 WHIP in 28 appearances (15 starts) between the two levels.
- Opened the year with the Naturals and started his first 7 games before a promotion to Triple-A, pitching at least 5.0 innings in all 7 Double-A starts and posting a 5.00 ERA (20 ER in 36.0 IP).
- Made his Triple-A debut for the Storm Chasers on May 17 vs. Columbus (CLE), allowing 5 runs in 5.0 innings ... had 3 separate stints with Omaha, his longest (and last) stint between July 18 and August 19 when he produced up a 4.73 ERA (7 ER in 13.1 IP) across 7 games (2 starts).
- Finished the season in Double-A, working a 2.84 ERA (6 ER in 19.0 IP) and 0.74 WHIP across 5 appearances (3 starts) after being transferred back to NWA on August 19.

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER

- Split **2024** between Columbia (A) and Quad Cities (A+) ... combined for a 2.45 ERA (34 ER in 124.2 IP) with 96 strikeouts to 28 walks (3.43 K/BB) across 24 games (18 starts) between the levels ... named the Quad Cities Pitcher of the Year by Royals Player Development.
- Began **2024** in Single-A and posted a 2.78 ERA (23 ER in 74.1 IP) with a 1.12 WHIP across 15 games (9 starts) before his promotion to High-A on July 9 ... allowed 2 ER or less in his first 9 games (5 starts) for the Fireflies, managing a 1.81 ERA (9 ER in 44.2 IP) and 0.90 WHIP during that stretch ... pitched to a 1.97 ERA (11 ER in 50.1 IP) across his 9 starts for the River Bandits.
- Made his professional debut with the ACL Royals (R) in **2023** after Kansas City drafted him in the 13th round of the **2023** MLB Draft ... pitched in 2 games in the Arizona Complex League, including a scoreless 2nd appearance on August 21 vs. the ACL Giants Orange.
