RIDERS WIN FINALE IN AMARILLO TO FORCE SERIES SPLIT:

The Frisco RoughRiders scored in every inning except for two in a 12-7 win over the Amarillo Sod Poodles on Sunday afternoon from HODGETOWN. Frisco (11-10) jumped out in front in the first inning when two runs scored on a dropped fly ball by Amarillo's center fielder Neyfy Castillo. It was the first of four errors for Amarillo on the day. The Riders extended their lead against Amarillo (11-10) starter Marcos Tineo (0-1) in the third when **Luisangel Acuña** stole third and scored on a throwing error by the catcher Nick Dalesandro. **Dustin Harris** later came in on an RBI groundout to short to increase the advantage to 4-0. After Amarillo answered back with a run in the bottom of the third, **Evan Carter** boosted the Riders lead to 5-1 with an RBI single in the fourth. The Sod Poodles volleyed back again with a tally in the home half of the fourth, but **Jax Biggers** smashed a two-run double down the left field line in the top of the fifth to make it a 7-2 game. The back-and-forth affair continued in the bottom of the fifth when A.J. Vukovich hit a two-run home run to cut the game to 7-4. **Thomas Saggese** plated another Frisco run in the sixth with an RBI infield single, but Jonathan Guzman lifted another two-run homer for Amarillo in the bottom of the inning to make the score 8-6, Frisco. The RoughRiders pulled away for good in the seventh, scoring three times. Carter drew a bases-loaded walk before Harris clobbered a two-run double into left-center field to make it 11-6. Frisco added on with a **Nick Tanielu** sacrifice fly in the ninth before the Sod Poodles tallied another run in the bottom of the inning. **Marc Church** (1-1) earned the win for the RoughRiders, throwing two scoreless innings. **Owen White** looked strong in his start, tossing three innings and only ceding one run while striking out six.

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire to start his 2023 season. Acuña is hitting .319 (30-for-94)/.369/.436/.805 through the first 21 games while ranking second in the Texas League in hits (30), tied for eighth in doubles (6) and seventh in total bases (41) and second in stolen bases (10). When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he struck out at a 21.3 percent clip. This season, he is striking out just 20.2 percent of the time and his wRC+ has nearly doubled (68 in 2022, 113 in 2023).

STRONGER IN A WOLF(RAM) PACK:

The RoughRiders bullpen has been highlighted by **Grant Wolfram** this season. The 6'8 lefty has thrown six scoreless outings this season and is 2-0. Over 9.1 innings, he has allowed just three hits while striking out 11 and walking one. On Thursday in Amarillo, Wolfram threw 3.0 scoreless innings, his longest scoreless outing since July 4th, 2021 when he threw 6.0 scoreless as a starter with Hickory. Through his last 16 games with the Riders in 2022, he went 1-1 with a 1.77 ERA.

LOAD UM UP:

The RoughRiders have had a league-high 32 RBIs with the bases loaded this year, which is also second most in Double-A (Biloxi, 34). As a team, they are hitting .385 (10-for-26)/.375/1.000/1.375 with four grand slams and 32 RBIs. They are one of two teams in Minor League Baseball with four grand slams this season already (Triple-A Norfolk) as **Trevor Hauver** hit one on Opening Day, **Dustin Harris** added another in San Antonio, **Luisangel Acuña** blasted one against Arkansas and **Jax Biggers** slugged one in Amarillo. The Riders have had one grand slam in each of the four series they have played this season. **Evan Carter** is leading all of MiLB (min. 25 PA) with a .550 average with runners in scoring position this season.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The RoughRiders have just committed nine errors through 21 games. The team's .988 fielding percentage is the best in Minor League Baseball. Their nine errors are the fewest in the minors.

WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 124 walks lead Double-A while their .363 team OBP is second in Double-A. **Evan Carter** has the Texas League lead with 21 walks and **Dustin Harris** is second with 19 while Carter is first in OBP (.500) in the league and in Double-A.

I LIKE BIG WINS AND I CANNOT LIE:

The RoughRiders 11 wins this season have come by eight, six, seven, seven, 10, four runs, eight runs, three runs, four runs, six runs and five runs, respectively, while their 10 losses have come by a combined 32 runs. That gives Frisco a +36 run differential through 21 games, which is first in the Texas League (third in Double-A) despite being 11-10 in the South Division. The only team with a +20 run differential in the league is Tulsa, which is 12-9 (+28). The RoughRiders have scored at least six runs 11 times (10-2) and scored four or fewer runs eight times (0-8). Frisco pythagorean record (what their record projects as based on run differential) is 14-7, which would tie Arkansas for the best record in the league.

EVAN ALMIGHTY:

Outfielder **Evan Carter** has reached safely in 17 of his 18 games this season, batting .343 (24-for-70)/.500/.543/1.043 with two doubles, four home runs, 21 walks, 20 RBIs and three stolen bases. Carter is sixth in the Texas League in average (.343), first in OBP (.500), tied for eighth in home runs (4), fourth in RBIs (20), first in walks (21) and fifth in OPS (1.043). The No. 1 prospect in the Rangers system won a MiLB Rawlings Gold Glove in 2022. The reigning Tom Greive Rangers Minor League Player of the Year, Carter joined the RoughRiders for the last week of the 2022 season and the playoffs. Carter also opened the season as the second-youngest player in the Texas League this season, trailing on 19-year-old Deyvison De Los Santos of Amarillo. Since going 0-for-4 for the first time this season on Saturday in San Antonio, Carter has walked 16 times to four strikeouts over 10 games with a .537 OBP.

ABOUT GRANT

-A three-sport star at Hamilton High School in Hamilton, Michigan, Wolfram chose at baseball above basketball and tennis. As a basketball player, Wolfram led his team in both points-per-game and rebounds-per-game and was named an All-Conference player as a junior and senior. On the tennis court, he was a three-year all-area honoree as a doubles player.

-For his junior season on the baseball diamond, he was recognized as *Holland Sentinel* Co-Player of the Year and with all-conference, all-area, all-district and all-region honors after posting a 1.00 ERA with 88 strikeouts against 12 walks in 56 innings (8-1 record). After his senior season, he was the No. 9 prospect in Michigan by Prep Baseball Report and was drafted by his hometown Detroit Tigers in the 16th round of the 2015 Draft, but chose to attend Central Michigan University instead.

-After one season at CMU, he transferred to Division-II Davenport University and pitched two seasons there. After those two years, he left Davenport as the all-time leader in K/9 (10.81) while he was second in games started (29), third in wins (19), third in strikeouts (195), fifth in most innings pitched (162.1) and sixth in lowest ERA (3.71). Wolfram was then drafted by the Rangers in the 18th round of the 2018 draft.

-Grant and his now-wife Abby were married on January 6th, 2023 in Grand Rapids, Michigan.

2023 SEASON

-Has pitched 9.1 scoreless innings over six outings to begin the season

-On Thursday, 4/27 in Amarillo, Wolfram threw 3.0 scoreless innings, his longest scoreless outing since July 4th, 2021 when he threw 6.0 scoreless as a starter with Hickory.

-Wolfram added a two-seam fastball during this season.

2022 SEASON

-Wolfram vastly improved in the second half of the season in his first year as a full-time member of the bullpen. Through his first 22 games, he owned a 6.23 ERA (24 ER/34.2 IP), but posted a 1.61 ERA (4 ER/22.1 IP) over last 17 G (beg. 7/23).

-Limited opponents to a .232 average (49-for-211), including a .160 average (12-for-75) against lefties and a .272 average (37-for-136) against righties.

-Pitched in the AFL: 1-0 with a 1.86 ERA (2 ER/9.2 IP) over 7 relief outings for the Arizona Fall League Champion Surprise Saguaros

2021 SEASON

-Posted a career-high six innings in a shutout performance against Asheville on 7/4/21 with nine strikeouts.

-His 13.43 SO/9 figure led the Hickory staff and was 2nd-highest among High-A East leaders (min. 60.0 IP).

-Limited opposing batters to a .242 average (63-for-260), including a .154 average (12-for-78) by lefties.

2019 SEASON

-Wolfram was on the injured list from 6/15-22 (right calf strain) and 8/22-end of season (left shoulder strain).

-Began the season in the bullpen (6G in April) before making first start on 5/3/19 at KAN.
