



In his first year of full-season baseball, James Triantos entered the record books with two 17-game hitting streaks, ranking as the fourth-longest in franchise history. The 2021 second round draft pick also reached base in 30 consecutive games from April 20th to May 28th, which ranks as the third-longest streak in Pelicans history.


