SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

WELCOME TO THE JACKSON CHOURIO SHOW: With a 10th-inning walk-off home run on Tuesday from **OF Jackson Chourio**, *Baseball America's* top prospect recorded his first two home run game and his first walk-off home run of his career... The walk-off home run left the bat at 108.5 MPH and traveled 422 feet... Chourio's first home run, off **LHP Patrick Murphy**, was his first career home run off a left handed pitcher... The home runs marked his first at the Double-A level after being called up for the final series in 2022... It also marked the first multi-home run game by a Shucker since **OF Terence Doston** on September 8, 2022 against Mississippi.

HOME, SWEET, HOME: The walk-off home run from **OF Jackson Chourio** was the first Shuckers' walk-off in a home opener since 2015 when they won in 14 innings against the Mobile Bay Bears after 54 consecutive games on the road to open their inaugural season... In 2015, **INF Nick Shaw** lined a single to right to score **LHP Brent Suter** from second in a 5-4 win.

STARTING AT HOME: Tuesday's walk-off win marked the sixth home opener win for the Shuckers in franchise history (since 2015)... All-time, the Shuckers are 6-2 in home openers, and have won four of their last five dating back to 2018... Tuesday's win marked the first win in a home opener against Pensacola after the Blue Wahoos defeated the Shuckers 3-0 to open the 2017 season.

NOW THAT'S HOW YOU START A GAME: Through four games, Shuckers starting pitchers have allowed four earned runs over 19.0 innings, a 1.89 ERA... The staff has also combined to strike out 32 batters in 19.0 innings, a mark that's fourth-best in Double-A... On Tuesday, **RHP Justin Jarvis** dominated in the home opener, striking out eight over six scoreless innings... His 4.1 inning perfect inning was also the longest perfect game bid of the year by a Shuckers starting pitcher.

ABOUT THAT RUN GAME: Entering today, the Shuckers have stolen 10 bases in 11 attempts, tied for the fourth-most out of all teams in Double-A... The Shuckers are one of five teams in Double-A with at least 10 stolen bases.

TODAY'S GAME ONE STARTER // RHP TOBIAS MYERS (1-0, 0.00): **RHP Tobias Myers** is set to make his first start at MGM Park in 2023 during game one... Myers dominated on Opening Night in his Brewers organizational debut, striking out 11 over 5.2 scoreless innings... His 11 strikeouts were the most he's had in a start since striking out a career-high 12 against Pensacola in 2021.

TODAY'S GAME TWO STARTER // LHP ADAM SEMINARIS (2023 DEBUT): **LHP Adam Seminaris** makes his Brewers organizational debut and first start with the Shuckers... Seminaris joined the organization along with **RHP Janson Junk** in a trade from the Angels in exchange for **OF Hunter Renfroe** this past offseason... In 2022, Seminaris combined for a 3.54 ERA across High-A Tri-City, Double-A Rocket City and Triple-A Salt Lake... He walked 38 batters and struck out 97 in 101.2 innings... Tonight also marks his first start at MGM Park and first start against the Blue Wahoos.
