### RIDERS ERASE FIVE-RUN DEFICIT, TAKE DOWN HOOKS 8-6:

The Frisco RoughRiders earned a comeback victory over the Corpus Christi Hooks 8-6 on Friday evening from Riders Field. Trailing by a score of 6-5, **Cody Freeman** stepped to the plate in the bottom of the seventh and belted a three-run homer to complete the RoughRiders (3-1, 47-26) five-run comeback. After Frisco starter **Winston Santos** struck out the first batter he faced at the Double-A level, Corpus Christi's (1-3, 27-46) **Brice Matthews** singled and then scored on a two-run homer by Jacob Melton. Santos went on to strike out the side. Trailing 2-0 in the bottom of the first frame, **Alejandro Osuna** ripped a leadoff double to left center in his first at bat for Frisco, but was stranded at second base. Jacob Melton extended the Corpus Christi lead to 4-0 in the top of the third with his second two-run homer of the game. Zach Dezenzo tacked on another run with a solo shot in the frame. Santos gave way to **Bryan Chi** in the third inning, lasting 2.2 innings while surrendering a season-high five earned runs on seven hits with five punchouts. The Riders got on the board when **Frainery Chavez** homered to left, a three-run jack that cut the deficit to 5-3 in the bottom of the fifth. In the top of the sixth, Collin Price got a run back for Corpus Christi with an RBI double that brought Colin Barber across the plate, making it a 6-3 game. Chi held the Hooks to just one run on three hits across 2.2 innings, striking out a pair before handing the ball to **Skylar Hales** (1-0). Hales, making his Double-A debut, tossed 1.2 scoreless, hitless frames while striking out four. **Abimelec Ortiz** delivered an RBI double in the bottom of the sixth, scoring Freeman before Chavez provided an RBI groundout to bring the Riders within a run, 6-5. Freeman's three-run bomb in the bottom of the seventh against James Hicks (0-1) propelled the Riders to an 8-6 lead, bringing the score to its final resting place. **Tyler Owens** picked up his fourth save of the season, spinning a scoreless ninth that featured a strikeout. Offensively, the Riders notched 12 hits. Osuna, Freeman, Ortiz, Chavez and **Aaron Zavala** each collected multi-hit games. Chavez paced the offense with four RBIs.

### I WANT TO BREAK FREE(MAN):

**Cody Freeman** blasted a go-ahead home run in the seventh last night, giving him the team lead with nine this year. While he has slowed down slightly at the plate in June (batting .238/.279/.438/.717), he has clubbed three home runs in his last four games with two of them being game-winners. This season, he has a career highs in average (.272), slugging percentage (.464) and OPS (.790) while being on pace to set new career bests in RBIs (65) and home runs (17).

### WE'RE GOING DANCING:

Tuesday marked the first day of the second half. After a Midland loss on last Sunday, the RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

### DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The Riders have the fewest errors in all of Minor League Baseball (42) while also ranking second in fielding percentage (.983) in the minors. Frisco's 68 double plays are second in the Texas League. Frisco have allowed the third-fewest stolen bases in MiLB (51), throwing out 27 percent of total base runners against them.

### THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen has been the best in the Texas League this season, owning a 2.85 ERA, which is also the third-best in all of Minor League Baseball. The Riders' pen allowed three runs last Friday, which was more than their previous 12 games, owning a 0.41 ERA (2 ER/43.2IP) over that span. In their last five series, spanning 29 games, Frisco's bullpen has a 1.61 ERA (19ER/106.0IP). In June, **Steven Jennings** has been fantastic, not allowing a run over his eight outings, throwing 16.1 innings.

### FIRING BLANKS:

In their last 20 games, the Riders have allowed just 47 earned runs over 175.0 IP (2.42 ERA). Frisco has the second-best ERA in all of Minor League Baseball during the month of June, at 2.80 through the first 24 games. Having won 22 of their last 31 games since May 25th, the Riders have the best ERA in Minor League Baseball (2.59) during that stretch while also being tied for third in saves (10) and tied for first in wins (22) since May 25th. The team with the second-best ERA in that stretch (Lake County) has a 3.04 ERA. In those last 31 games, the Riders have allowed more than three runs in a game just 10 times and seven times in the last 19 games. Their Tuesday and Thursday 2-1 losses last week marked their first two losses when allowing three runs or fewer, dropping them to 36-2 in those games.

### HICKS IS THE PICK:

**Liam Hicks** has been on fire at the plate for the Riders over his last 36 games, batting .328 (40-for-122)/.437/.459/.896 with seven doubles, three home runs, 18 RBIs, 19 walks, 17 strikeouts and 23 runs. In his last 20 games, he is hitting .338 (24-for-71)/.448/.535/.983. Two Fridays ago in Corpus Christi, Hicks collected two home runs for his first multi-home run game of his Minor League career.

### ABOUT DANE

-Went to Brenham High School in Brenham, Texas (between Austin and Houston). His senior year of high school, he went 5-2 with a 1.79 ERA.

-Acker attended Rice for freshman season, going 5-2 with a 4.20 ERA and earned Conference USA All-Freshman Team honors. From there, transferred to San Jacinto College for sophomore season in 2019, going 10-0 with a 2.36 ERA in 14 starts. He struck out 97 batters in 76.1 IP.

-Drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 2019 23rd round, but did not sign.

-For his junior season, he went to Oklahoma University, making four starts in the COVID-shortened season, going 1-1 with a 3.51 ERA. At the Schripes College Classic on March 1st against No.11 LSU, Acker threw the first Oklahoma no-hitter since 1989, striking out 11 batters to just one walk and two hit batters. He threw 117 pitches in the game.

-Acker was taken by the Oakland Athletics in the 4th round of the 2020 draft, one pick after Braves pitcher Spencer Strider.

### 2024 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 28 prospect in the Texas system by MLB.com entering the season.

-In first start at Wichita on Opening Day, threw 3.2 no-hit innings before allowing his first hit. Finished with 4.2 innings, allowing just one run in a 6-4 Riders win.

-Pitched first two quality starts in MiLB career on 6/15 and 6/22. On 6/22, he went 5.0 scoreless before allowing three runs in the sixth.

### 2023 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 22 prospect in the Texas system by MLB.com entering the season.

-In Double-A debut at San Antonio on July 3rd, allowed two-run inside the park homer in the third inning to Juan Fernandez, but struck out five.

-When he was promoted to Double-A Frisco on July 3rd, Acker had just thrown 53.1 career MiLB innings over 17 games with only 50.1 innings and 12 games in affiliated ball above the Rookie level.

-Finished out High-A time with a 1.65 ERA (3ER/16.IP) in June.

-Induced ground balls at a 46.9% rate with High-A Hickory over his six starts.

-Earned first career MiLB win with five strong innings against San Antonio on July 18th.

-Made best start of MiLB career on August 30th against CC with 5.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 2 BB, 5 K.

### 2022 SEASON

-Acker returned from rehab in mid-July, throwing in the Arizona League before making four starts with Hickory, debuting with the Crawdads on August 21st.

-After the season, Acker participated in the Rangers' Fall Instructional League program.

### 2021 SEASON

-After trade to Rangers, Acker made two starts with the Down East Wood Ducks before his second ended with "Tommy John" surgery.

-Traded from the Oakland Athletics along with OF Khris Davis and C Jonah Heim in exchange for INF Elvis Andrus and C Aramis Garcia and cash on February 6th, 2021.
