TODAY'S GAME: The Curve open the second half of their season with a six-game set against the Akron RubberDucks.

LAST TIME OUT: Bubba Chandler struck out a career-high 11 and Carter Bins had three hits in a 6-4 win over Akron.

BUBBA'S BURGERS: On Thursday, June 27 at PNG Field, **Bubba Chandler** struck out a career-high 11 batters in 6.2 innings against Akron. One start after striking out 7 straight hitters and retiring 16 straight, Chandler struck out five in a row twice during his outing on Thursday. Chandler's second straight strikeout performance was just the third time in franchise history that a Curve pitcher had struck out 10-or-more batters in back-to-back outings joining **Tyler Glasnow** (7/21/15 vs Erie, 7/26/15 vs Akron) and **Roansy Contreras** (5/4/21 vs Bowie and 5/11 at Binghamton).

Chandler and **Braxton Ashcraft**'s combined four 10-strikeout games this season make the Curve one of six teams, and the lone team at Double-A or Triple-A, to have two pitchers strikeout 10 or more in a game twice.

Since his return from the IL on May 29, Chandler has walked just 4 batters in 29.1 IP with 38 strikeouts, recording a 3-2 record with a 2.76 ERA (9 ER / 29.1 IP) with a 0.89 WHIP. Chandler was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week, the first to receive the honor since **Mike Burrows** and **Quinn Priestler** took home weekly honors during the 2022 season.

A NICE NUMBER REMAINS: Altoona finished the first half with a 29-40 record, in 6th place in the SouthWest Division and the worst mark by an Eastern League team. The Curve, however, have played their best baseball in the last three weeks, picking up wins in 13-of-16 games to finish the First Half. The Curve's 29-40 mark was the just the third time in 25 seasons of play that Altoona has won fewer than 30 of their first 69 games in a season (2001 - 29 wins, 2004 - 24 wins).

HE WILL McADOO: Infielder **Charles McAdoo** made his Double-A debut with a bang on Saturday, June 23 at Bowie. McAdoo made a terrific play in the first inning in the field and then went 2B, BB, 2R HR in his first three at-bats for the Curve. McAdoo homered in each of the first two games he played for Altoona. Since joining the Curve (5G) he's batted .350/.458/.850/1.308 with 2 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 3 RBI, 4 BB, 2 K and 2-3 SB. He ranks 1st among PIT MiLB in H (82), 2B (17), RBI (55), T-1st in SB (15), and 1st in OPS (1.003), min. 150 AB's in minor leagues.

FEELING PEACHY: Infielder **Kervin Pichardo** turned in a massive effort at the plate on Thursday, June 20 at Bowie, aiding the Curve to a 10-8 win in 12 innings. Pichardo picked up a career-high 4 hits as part of a 4-for-5 day at the plate with a homer and 3 RBI in the win. Pichardo picked up a hit in 12 straight games from June 12-26, the 4th-longest streak in the Eastern League this season (.400/.438/.511/.949 with 2 2B, 1 HR, 6 RBI) and ranks 10th in the league in batting average (.329), 5th in hits (26) and T-7th in runs (16) during the calendar month.

A BIG ADDITION: Utilityman **Yoyner Fajardo** has reached base safely in 12 straight games, during which he's batting .380/.448/.420 with 2 2B, 5 RBI, 7 BB, 8-9 SB.

PETEY'S BIG FLIES: Outfielder **Dustin Peterson** recorded his fourth career two-homer game in Altoona's 6-4 win over Richmond on Sunday, June 9. Peterson recorded the second multi-homer game by a Curve batter this season (Aaron Shackelford - April 9) and the 129th instance in franchise history. Peterson batted .308/.386/.513/.899 with 2 2B, 2 HR, 6 RBI during his a 10-game on-base streak (6/9 - 6/26).

THE CHEN CHRONICLES: Righty **Po-Yu Chen** overcame a difficult month of April (7.93 ERA) and hit his stride as the calendar flipped to June. Chen fired a career-high 8.0 innings and struck out 9 on June 7 at Richmond to lead the Curve to a 3-1 win. Chen allowed just one run in three straight outings, and since May 25 he has recorded a 2.67 ERA (10 ER / 33.2 IP) with 29 strikeouts.

K SPELLS TROUBLE: Altoona has struck out at least 10 times at the plate in a game 34 times this season in 72 games.

THE RUBBERDUCKIES: Greg DiCenzo takes over for the 'Ducks after spending last season as the Bench Coach at Triple-A Columbus. 2024 is DiCenzo's fourth season working in the Guardians system after spending 12 years as the Head Coach for Holy Cross where he led his team to 20 or more wins 10 times. Akron has several top prospects in their lineup including OF Chase DeLauter, OF Petey Halpin, INF Milan Tolentino and INF Kahlil Watson.

THE FIRST QUACKER: Austin Peterson was Cleveland's 9th round selection in 2022 out of the University of Connecticut, he hails from Chesterton, Indiana. Peterson is making his Double-A debut tonight after going 7-2 with a 2.44 ERA in 14 starts at High-A Lake County where he walked 6 batters in 85.0 IP with 87 strikeouts. Peterson began his collegiate career at Purdue (2019) then spent one season at Wabash Valley Community College in Illinois (2020) and two years at UConn ('21 and '22) where he was a two-time All Big East selection and set the program's single-season record with 147 strikeouts in the 2022 season. Aided UConn to a Super Regional appearance at Stanford.

 Features a fastball (92-94), sweeper, cutter, change-up and curveball

CURVE CUTS: Thomas Hinson Harrington... Told Young Bucs that his favorite Ice Cream flavor is Coffee and that he cannot live without his golf clubs, sushi, and sweet tea... Told Andrew Destin of the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette that he did not begin pitching until halfway through his Prep career at Southern Lee High School in Sanford, N.C.... Also played quarterback at Southern Lee... Mostly played shortstop prior to turning his attention to the mound... Had his senior season of high school baseball cut short by the COVID-19 Pandemic... Didn't receive significant interest from collegiate programs until late in his high school career and chose to walk-on at Campbell, a school located approximately 35 minutes from his hometown... Was put on scholarship after his freshman season at Campbell... Was the second-highest draft pick in Campbell and Big South Conference history, trails only teammate Zach Neto (Angels, 13th overall, 2022)... Has four siblings, Blake, Cooper, Ben and Elizabeth... Parents are Tommy and Tina Harrington... Told *Baseball America* that one of his biggest adjustments to professional baseball has been pitching on a 5-day rotation which he experienced for the first time when he was promoted to Greensboro in June of 2023, uses dry needling as a recovery process which is a technique similar to acupuncture that allows muscles to recover... Adjusted the grip on his slider to adopt more of a sweeping slider as a pro, described it as a "fun challenge"... Spent the 2023-24 season training as a remote athlete with Ascent Athlete, a baseball and softball development center located in Garnet Valley, PA... Adjusted the grip on his change-up at the Pirates Pitching Camp in the winter of 2024, working with Pitching Advisor Dewey Robinson and Pirates Pitching Coach Oscar Marin to improve its action... Is a scratch golfer... Said that Bubba Chandler would be his scramble partner of any Pirates minor leaguer... Grew up not far from Tobacco Road and follows Duke Men's Basketball closely... Not a fan of St. Louis Cardinals fan and listed his favorite player as Albert Pujols at age 10... 2024: Was a non-roster invitee to Pirates Spring Training... Selected to the Pirates Spring Breakout Roster but did not participate due to injury (right shoulder soreness)... Struck out 4 in 3.0 no-hit innings in his Double-A debut on 5/12 vs. Somerset... Tossed 7.0 no-hit innings to begin his tenure with the Curve... Made his first career relief appearance on 6/5 at Richmond, allowed a career-high 8 hits and 6 runs... Set a new career-high with 10 hits allowed on 6/11 vs Erie...

2023: Split the season between Single-A Bradenton and High-A Greensboro... Finished the season tied first among Pirates minor leaguers in strikeouts (146) with RHP Jared Jones, also ranked second in ERA (3.53, minimum 90.0 IP)... Began the season with Single-A Bradenton and struck out 40 batters in 39.0 IP with a 2.77 ERA... At the time of his promotion to High-A Greensboro on June 1, ranked fourth among Florida State League pitchers in ERA with a 2.77 mark... Tossed a career-long 7.0 scoreless innings on June 8 against Wilmington allowing just two hits, no walks and struck out eight... Matched his career-long outing again on August 1 against Asheville and picked up a career-high 11 strikeouts... Matched his career-long outing again on August 18 against Bowling Green and struck out eight in a Grasshoppers win... Recorded a 2.67 ERA (10 ER / 33.2 IP) in six starts during the month of August...
