TODAY'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Gwinnett Stripers (Atlanta Braves) get set for the series finale on Sunday afternoon. Round Rock used a strong start from RHP Cal Quantrill and a three-hit night from LF Trevor Hauver to beat Gwinnett 5-2 on Friday night at Dell Diamond. C Jose Herrera homered, Hauver drove in two, and the Express answered Gwinnett's eighth-inning push with two insurance runs before RHP Peyton Gray closed it out.

ALLY-ALLY-ALEJANDRO

OF Alejandro Osuna went 1-for-5 with an RBI and a run scored. He has reached base in six consecutive games and seven of eight on the year. Since the start of the 2025 season, Osuna has drawn 20 walks at the Triple-A level for a 19.2% walk rate, the sixth-highest of any PCL player in that span (min. 75 PA). Osuna has a .433 OBP in 23 PCL games. League average to start 2026 is .358.

FOSS FEELING GOOD

INF Justin Foscue went 1-for-4 with an RBI and a strikeout on Friday night and did not appear in Saturday's win. He has a seven-game hitting streak to start the year and an 11-game hitting streak dating back to 2025. Through seven games, he is slashing .345 (10-29)/.406/.517/.923 and leads the club in batting average, slugging percentage and OPS.

MISSING BATS

In their Saturday night victory, the Round Rock pitching staff tallied its sixth game this year with at least nine strikeouts, which leads all PCL clubs. Starting pitcher RHP Cal Quantrill earned the win and threw 5.0 scoreless innings while generating 11 whiffs, the most of any Express pitcher this season. Round Rock pitchers rank second in all of Triple-A, holding batters to a 30.1% hard hit rate while pacing the PCL in whiffs (166) and whiff percentage (28.6%).

CLOSE GAMES

Saturday's win was the sixth game out of eight games decided by less than three runs. Of Round Rock's six losses, four of them have been decided by three runs or less and three have been determined by two runs or fewer with two games going to extra innings. The Express have led by no more than three runs at any time this year. Their -15 run differential is the third-lowest in the PCL.

TRIED AND TRUE

Round Rock's relievers continue to pace the league with 53 strikeouts and a 2.52 K/BB ratio with the most innings pitched (43.0). The bullpen has thrown at least 4.0 innings each game and held opponents to three runs or less in six of the eight contests. LHP Robby Ahlstrom, RHP Alexis Díaz and RHP Peyton Gray have made three appearances each and hold a combined 4.20 K/BB ratio.

ON THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - FRIDAY, APRIL 5, 1974

Nolan Ryan was appointment viewing every time he took the mound in his career but on Opening Day 1974, he wasn't the story. George Langford of the Chicago Tribune described the scene: Opening Day in Comiskey Park (or is it now a zoo) was a fiasco.

The baseball was bad, but the customers were worse. The scorecard for the number of streakers, strippers, fights and bottles thrown was incalculable. Ryan went 8.0 innings, walked 10 and threw 138 pitches to earn his first of what would end up being a career-high 22 wins from the 1974 season. He had only four strikeouts with his first coming in the fifth inning. Knuckleballer Wilbur Wood was coming off a 24-win season in 1973, but he'd get the loss this day after 6.2 innings and three earned runs.

With the Angels leading 3-2 in the eighth, they delivered with a five-run frame to run away with it. A 22-year-old named Rich (Goose) Gossage got the White Sox out of the eighth and tossed 1.2 innings of scoreless baseball. While there was a baseball game being played, the entertainment was in the stands as fans fought the entire afternoon.

"The White Sox' Dick Allen, who went hitless and drew a scattering of boos in the seventh inning when he was fanned by Nolan Ryan in a critical situation was philosophical about the near riot. "We didn't give them too much to hold their attention," the first baseman said."

In other baseball news, Hank Aaron was on the doorstep of becoming the home run king. He tied Babe Ruth the day prior (Thursday) when the Braves opened the year against Cincinnati. Aaron broke the record three days later (Sunday) against the Dodgers at Atlanta Stadium.

- The right-hander made his Triple-A debut with Round Rock at Tacoma (3/29/2025) and was 1 of 5 Round Rock relievers to log 40.0 innings in 2025.
- Led all Rangers farmhands with 10 double plays induced as a reliever.
- Combined for a 2.54 ERA over 18 starts between Hickory (A+) and Frisco in 2023, earning his first promotion to Double-A on July 3.
- Underwent season-ending Tommy John surgery on May 26, 2021 after two starts in his professional debut season.
- Acquired by TEX from OAK, along with C Jonah Heim and OF Khris Davis, in exchange for SS Elvis Andrus, C Aramis Garcia, and cash considerations on 2/6/21.

2025 NOTES

- Was in his first career Major League Spring Training camp before beginning the year at Round Rock (AAA).
- Used mostly as a reliever for first time as a professional, owning a 5.26 ERA (31 ER/53.0 IP) over 32 games/2 starts between the Express (30 G/1 GS) and a short rehab assignment with the ACL Rangers (2 G/1 GS).
