Jersey Shore BlueClaws (25-24/62-52) vs Brooklyn Cyclones (23-26/56-59)

Maimonides Park – Brooklyn, New York (opened 2001) RHP Casey Steward (2-2, 3.79) vs LHP Felipe De La Cruz (3-7, 4.40) Series: Game 2 of 6 (Jersey Shore leads season series 13-9 of 27)

Last Time Out...The BlueClaws erased an 8-2 deficit and rallied to top Brooklyn 10-9 at Maimonides Park on Tuesdsay night...Aidan Miller tied the game with a three run triple to cap a six run sixth inning and Jersey Shore took the lead on an unearned run in the eighth inning...Paxton Thompson gave up a run but got the last three outs for his second BlueClaws save

The Streaky BlueClaws...The BlueClaws have been guite streaky of late - they enter today on a five game winning streak, which was preceeded by a 4-12 stretch through July 27th...That stretch was preceded by a 13-6 run that began on July 3rd, and that was preceded by an eight-game losing streak...Jersey Shore's longest winning streak of the season was 11 (May 1st - 12th, a franchise record).

Comeback Claws...Jersey Shore erased an 8-2 deficit to win 10-9 on Tuesday...It was their largest comefrom-behind win of the season (they overcame a 5-0 deficit to win at Greensboro in June), and their largest since 5/24/2023, when they came from 8-2 down to win at Aberdeen

Playoff Picture...The BlueClaws are tied for second place, 1.5 games behind first place Hudson Valley and are level with Aberdeen (both won last night)...There are 17 games left...Last year, the BlueClaws trailed by six games on August 3rd and rallied to make the postseason on the final day.

Down on the Boardwalk ... The BlueClaws are on Coney Island this week to take on Brooklyn ... Jersey Shore leads the season series 13-9 from the Cyclones and took two of three from Brooklyn in the first series after the All-Star break.

Miller Heating Up...Aidan Miller homered on both August 15th and 16th (his other BlueClaws home runs were on July 4th and Father's Day) and had two hits and a three-run triple on Tuesday...He is 19-57 since August 2nd with three doubles, three triples and two home runs...After drawing three walks on Thursday, he has now drawn 24 with the BlueClaws in 211 plate appearances... His three hit game on Friday was his second with the BlueClaws (August 6th)... The 20 year old was the Phillies first-round pick last year...He hit five home runs with Clearwater before joining the BlueClaws on June 11th, two days after his 20th birthday.

Keaton Mashing ... Keaton Anthony homered (two and three with Jersey Shore) and had two hits on both Sunday and Tuesday...Anthony is 17-47 with three doubles, a triple, three home runs, and nine RBIs (and six multi-hit games) in his last 12 games ... The former Iowa Hawkeye is now 51-146 (.349) with the BlueClaws adding 16 multi-hit games...He had a walk-off single on July 23rd against Aberdeen...He was hitting .322 in 44 games with Clearwater, adding four home runs and 21 RBIs, and drew 28 walks in 186 plate appearances while striking out only 28 times...He signed as an NDFA from the University of Iowa in 2023 after three years with the Hawkeves.

Touch 'em All Troy... OF Troy Schreffler hit a home run on Sunday, his eighth of the season - four of them have come since July 30th...Schreffler hit three on the two week trip to Hudson Valley and Wilmington before his home run on Sunday, which was the 15th of his career...Schreffler needs two home runs (and Jordan Dissin who leads the team with nine needs one) to reach double-digits, something that has only happened eight times since the BlueClaws became a High-A affiliate (Jhailyn Oritz leads with 19 in 2021; Baron Radcliff hit 17 in 2022)...Schreffler (at 203 at bats) has fewer at bats than all 10+ home run players.

In the Second Half...Since the second half began on June 21st, Keaton Anthony is second in the league hitting .349 (Tre Morgan of Bowling Green leads at .389 and was promoted to AA Montgomery)...Anthony is also third in on-base percentage at .410 (Morgan leads at .467).

Ware It...Bryson Ware went 3-3 on Saturday after picking up two hits on Thursday and Friday and is 9-19 since August 13th...He had the game-winning RBI single in the seventh inning on Thursday...Ware is now 11-36 since joining Jersey Shore last week...Ware has started games at 1B, 2B, 3B, and SS with the BlueClaws...With Clearwater, he started games at 1B, 2B, 3B, SS, LF, and CF...Ware was an 8th round pick in 2023 out of Auburn.

Jumpin' JordanJordan Viars had two hits, both RBI singles, on Saturday night, the first two-hit game with Jersey Shore for the recently-turned 21 year old...Viars joined the BlueClaws on July 15th from Clearwater, where he was hitting .252 with 12 home runs and 39 RBIs...He was a 3rd round pick in the 2021 draft and turned 21 on July 18th, the day before his BlueClaws debut...He had a three home run, nine RBI game with Clearwater on 5/30 against Lakeland.

The Runnin' Claws eason: 152-193 (5th most in SAL)

Team Leaders (active) Emaarion Boyd - 20 Troy Schreffler – 13 Aidan Miller – 10 Trent Farguhar - 9 (Justin Crawford – 27, William Bergolla – 18, and Erick Brito - 14) are no longer with the BlueClaws.

The BlueClaws have 31 SBs in the 28 games since the break (since July 19th)...They had 14 SBs in the 21 games between the start of the second half on June 21st and the break (thru July 14th).

Closing the Door...Paxton Thompson earned his second BlueClaws save in the win on Tuesday at Brooklyn...Wen-Hui Pan threw two scoreless innings on Saturday to earn his first High-A save, adding two strikeouts...Trey Dillard threw a scoreless ninth inning on Thursday to earn his first BlueClaws save and Jaydenn Estanistata threw a scoreless ninth inning on Friday for his second BlueClaws save...Dillardearned one with Clearwater earlier this year...Gunner Mayer leads the active BlueClaws with four saves...Charles King and Estanista have two...Dillard and Pan each have one.

Keep on Getting On...Trent Farquhar is 16-69 with the BlueClaws but has also drawn 11 walks and been hit by six pitches...He had two hits last Friday...He was hit by three pitches in his July 20th BlueClaws debut in Brooklyn, tying the team single-game record set last year by Nick Ward on 6/6 against Hudson Valley...Farquhar signed as a non-drafted free agent last year out of Michigan State.

Going Going Gone ... The BlueClaws have hit 34 HRs in Lakewood and 36 on the road this season...Troy Schreffler and Keaton Anthony homered on August 18th...Aidan Miller homered on both August 15th and 16th, his third and fourth with the BlueClaws...Hendry Mendez hit his second of the year on August 10th at Wilmington...Jordan Dissin leads the team with nine and Leandro Pineda (now with Reading) and Schreffler each have eight.

The NEWClaws....The BlueClaws roster entering today has just nine players that have been with the team since Opening Day: Ps Jack Dallas, Charles King, Gunner Mayer, and Danny Wilkinson, C Jordan Dissin, IF Felix Reyes, and OFs Emaarion Boyd, Hendry Mendez, and Troy Schreffler.

Hitting Triple Digits ... A South Atlantic League starting pitcher has thrown 100 pitches nine times in a game this season eight are BlueClaws...Mitch Neunborn threw 108 over 6.2 innings on August 16th...Sam Aldegheri has done it three times (including 103 on June 13th), Jean Cabrera has done it three times (including a league-high 110 on Wednesday at Brooklyn), and Braeden Fausnaught has done it once...Cabrera's 110 pitches are the most by a BlueClaw since Nick Fanti threw 113 in two no-hitters in 2017 (7/17 vs CHA, 26 outs in a 5/6/17 nohitter at COL), not incluing Matt Russell, who threw 125 pitches in eight innings against ABD in 2022 but pitched three innings in April and the remaining five in June after the game was suspended.

Save Index...Daniel Harper (now with Reading) leads the BlueClaws with seven saves and earned his seventh on June 19th at Brooklyn...Andrew Walling (now with Reading) earned his sixth save of the year in the win on July 14th... Gunner Mayer has four while Charles King has two.

Walk-Off This Way... The BlueClaws have three walk-off wins this year – July 23rd vs Abedeen (Keaton Anthony RBI single), July 9th against Hudson Valley (Emaarion Boyd 2-run single) and April 5th against Aberdeen (Opening Night, Boyd scores on wild pitch)...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen...It was the first BlueClaws walk-off home run since Ben Pelletier hit one on August 15, 2019 against Delmarva.

The Comeback Claws...The BlueClaws erased a six-run deficit on August 20th at Brooklyn, trailing 8-2 and rallying to win 10-9 (their largest comeback win of the season)...The BlueClaws got a two-out, two-strike hit from Keaton Anthony and a two-strike RBI double from Felix Reves on July 21st at Brooklyn to tie the game, that they would win 9-6 in 10 innings...Jersey Shore erased a 5-0 deficit on June 8th at Greensboro and a 4-0 deficit on June 15th to come back and beat Wilmington...On June 15th, Troy Schreffler doubled home two runs to tie the game and Justin Crawford gave the BlueClaws the lead with a line drive RBI single to centerfield...Their largest comeback win last year was six (5/24/23 at Aberdeen in a game they trailed 8-2 and won 12-10).

Just Grand ... The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they have three grand slams since May 30th - one by Justin Crawford (May 30th), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9th), and one by Jordan Dissin (June

11th)...Boyd's home run was the second of his career while Dissin's was his sixth home run of the season.

Trying For Back to Back...The BlueClaws have only made the playoffs in back to back years once - in 2009 and 2010, both SAL Championship seasons...They have a chance to do so again this year after reaching the SAL Northern Division Championship Series last year.

Youth Is Served...Per Baseball America, the BlueClaws had five of the 25 youngest players in the South Atlantic League (based on Opening Day rosters of 360 players): William Bergolla (3rd youngest), Bryan Rincon (9th), Justin Crawford (11th), Hendry Mendez (17th), and Emmaarion Boyd (21st).

In the First Round...Aidan Miller is the 16th former first-round pick to play for the BlueClaws and the fifth to play for the BlueClaws as a High-A team...(his ex-teammate Justin Crawford in 2024, Andrew Painter and Mick Abel in 2022 and Bryson Stott in 2021)... Since 2000, the only two Phillies first round picks not to play for the BlueClaws are Joe Savery (2007) and Aaron Nola (2014) plus 2023 first-round pick Aidan Miller, who is currently with Clearwater.

Go Phils...The BlueClaws have two players that grew up Phillies fans: C Jordan Dissin (went to Malvern Prep in Philadelphia, 27 miles from Citizens Bank Park), OF Troy Schreffler (from Harrisburg)...LHP Braeden Fausnaught (from Danville and went to West Chester University) is another that was here this year but is now with Reading.

Most Games Back (2nd half) From The Shore to the Show...123 players have now gone From the Shore, to the Show including one this year (Ben Brown, Cubs)...Three debuted in 2023 – James McArthur with the Royals, Johan Rojas with the Phillies, and Orion Kerkering with the Phillies...Kerkering, who was with the BlueClaws from May 9th through July 6th, is the only player to play for the BlueClaws and Phillies in the same year.

On the Staff...Greg Brodzinski returns to manage the BlueClaws in 2024 after leading the BlueClaws to the playoffs and a league-best 73-58 mark in 2023...Pitching coach Brad Bergesen is in Lakewood for a third time (2018 and 2022) and is joined as a pitching coach by first-year Phillies coach Matt Ellmyer...Hitting coach Adam Lind hit 200 big league home runs and is in his first year as a coach...Position coach Orlando Munoz is in his first year with the BlueClaws after managing the DSL Phillies since 2017... Development coach Beth Greenwood is the first BlueClaws female position coach and a member of Team USA Women's National Baseball Team

Season Notes: Threw a career-long seven scoreless innings on 7/23 vs ABD...Earned first BC win on 7/3 at WIL (5 IP, 2 R/1 ER)...Struck out nine over five innings, one run in Claws debut on 6/27 vs GBO...Joined the BlueClaws on 6/27 from Clearwater where he was 4-2, 3.38 in 12 games (10 starts) with 52 strikeouts and 19 walks in 50.2 innings pitched...Threw five scoreless innings with five strikeouts on 5/4 at Lakeland.

Career Notes: Made five appearances between the FCL Phillies (two scoreless innings in two games) and Clearwater (two runs in four innings in three games) in first professional season...First player the Phillies have drafted from D2 Washburn University...Notable baseball alumni include Davey Lopes, who had a 16 year big league career, managed the Brewers (2000 – 2002) and was the Phillies 1B coach from 2007-2010, including for their 2008 World Series title...Has a twin brother named Calvin.

Career Notes: Spent all of 2023 with Clearwater, where he hit .262 with one home run, 36 RBIs, and 56 stolen bases for the Division Champion Threshers...Stole six bases in a 6/6 win at Fort Myers, tied for the most by a MiLB player last year and since 2005...
