TODAY'S HEADLINES

LAST GAME'S RESULT - Jermaine Palacios hit a grand slam and tied a career high with five RBI as the St. Paul Saints defeated the Indianapolis Indians 9-8 in 10 innings. Tim Beckham collected three more hits and Ian Hamilton worked 2.0 scoreless innings to pick up the win.

LOCKED IN WHEN LOADED: Jermaine Palacios crushed a grand slam on July 22 @ Indianapolis. It was the sixth grand slam hit by the Saints this season and the first of Palacios' career. The six grand slams are tied with Columbus for the most in the International League and are tied for the fourth most in Minor League Baseball only behind Reno (8), Albuquerque (7) and Lake County (7).

DO WE GET PAID EXTRA FOR THIS: The St. Paul Saints continue to pile up extra inning games. For the 14th time this season, they played an extra inning game on July 22 @ Indianapolis, the third extra inning game vs. the Indians. The 14 extra inning games are the most in Triple-A and are tied with the South Atlantic League's Wilmington Blue Rocks for the most in Minor League Baseball. The Saints are 6-8 while Wilmington is 9-5.

HOLES IN THE BATS: The St. Paul Saints fanned 13 times on July 22 @ Indianapolis. It was the 36th time in 89 games (40.1%) they have struck out double-digit times in a game.

SHAWTY: The shortest series the Saints have played as a Triple-A affiliate is a five-game series. Last season, the final two series of the season were five-games. All other series were six-games. This season, they played one five-game series against the Nashville Sounds because the final game was washed out. The three-game series against the Indianapolis Indians will be their shortest series in franchise history. They will also play a three-game series to end the season at home against Omaha.

GO TO YOUR HOME: Jermaine Palacios is quietly having a solid season for the Saints. His 42 runs are third most on the team. He currently has the longest active run scoring streak in the International League, scoring in seven consecutive games. It's the third time in his career he's scored a run in seven straight and the second time this season. He scored in seven straight from May 20-27. The one caveat, Palacios is in the lineup for the June 17 vs. Toledo that was rained out in the top of the first. Should he score a run in that resumed game (scheduled for a date in September), he would break his streak. Should he fail to score a run, the streak would end at six.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The St. Paul Saints collected two doubles on on July 22 @ Indianapolis. Overall, the Saints have collected 169 doubles, tied for fifth in Triple-A and tied for 10th in all of Minor League Baseball.

RISPY (WITH 2 OUTS) BUSINESS: The St. Paul Saints gave up two more runs with runners in scoring position and two outs on Friday night. With RISP/2 outs this season, opponents are hitting .283 against the Saints, third worst in all of Minor League Baseball. Tacoma has the highest average at .308, El Paso is second at .295.

FIRST INNING FLOP: The St. Paul Saints have allowed at least one run in the first inning in 38 of 89 games (42.7%) the Saints have allowed at least a run in the first inning. They have allowed 78 runs in the first, most in the International League and fifth most in all of Minor League Baseball behind Albuquerque (98), Stockton (86), Binghamton (84) & Visalia (79). Their 19 home runs allowed are tied for sixth most in Minor League Baseball.

EXTRA EXTRA READ ALL ABOUT IT: The St. Paul Saints have played 89 games this season and have an extra base hit in all, but one game. They have an extra base hit in 81 consecutive games, the second longest streak in all of Minor League Baseball. The only team with a longer streak is El Paso's 92 game streak, which is also active. The lone game they didn't collect an extra base hit was the game they were no-hit on April 13 vs. Indianapolis. They have just one extra base hit in only 10 games.

FINAL FOUR: The St. Paul Saints are a part of the final four, but not a final four they care to be included in. The Saints have yet to throw a shutout in 2022. They are one of only four Minor League teams that have yet to throw a shutout. They are joined by the the Chattanooga Lookouts in the Southern League, Columbia Fireflies, and the Visalia Rawhide in the California League. The Saints 5.35 ERA in the third highest of the four teams. Chattanooga's ERA is the best at 5.17, Columbia has a 5.24 while Visalia is 6.07. The Charlotte Knights and Delmarva Shorebirds took their names off the list with a shutout on July 10.

WE BELIEVE THE PROSPECTS ARE OUR FUTURE: On July 7, Spencer Steer was chosen to the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium. Steer is one of two Minnesota Twins Minor Leaguers to be chosen. He joins newly promoted outfielder Matt Wallner. Steer is the first Saints player chosen to the Futures Game. Josh Winder, who was chosen in 2021, was called up to the Saints two days before the announcement, but hadn't pitched for the Saints. Wallner delivered in the game going 1-2 with a home run while Steer was 0-2.

TWINS UPDATE - The Minnesota Twins return to action following the All-Star break on Saturday night at Comerica Park against the Detroit Tigers.

HOW IT ALL STARTED: Jordan began the season on the injured list with a left knee strain and didn't begin the season until his first start on May 7.

MOVING ON UP: Prior to the 2021 season, Balazovic was the #6 rated prospect in the Twins organization. Just a year later he is now the #3 rated prospect in the organization and #85 overall

NOT THE NEXT JOHN TAVARES: Canada is a hotbed for NHL talent. Born and raised in Mississauga, Ontario, Canada, Jordan grew up playing both hockey and baseball, but the grind of both sports got to be too much. His parents made him choose one sport over the other and he chose basketball. That had to be a relief to his parents because despite being from Canada they aren't a big fan of winters.

A PORTRAIT OF A PITCHER AS A YOUNG MAN: When Balazovic looks around the Saints clubhouse, he will notice he's a boy among men, at least age-wise. At 23-years-old, he is the youngest pitcher on the staff and the second youngest player on the team, only behind Royce Lewis. Lewis was born June 5, 1999 while Balazovic is a full nine months older, born on September 17, 1998. The next closest in age to Balazovic is Jose Miranda who was born on June 29, 1998.

HE WANTS TO PUMP YOU UP: At 6'3 and 175 pounds at the age of 17 when the Twins drafted him in 2016, Balazovic definitely had room to grow, both in height and strength. Since that time he has grown two inches and put on 40 pounds.

ALL IN THE FAMILY: Baseball and softball run in the family. His Dad grew up playing baseball and his grandfather, Joseph, played two years in the Cleveland Indians organization. He played for the Fargo-Moorhead Twins, a C-Level team in 1957 and was promoted to the Burlington Indians in 1958, a B-Level team. Overall, the outfielder hit .238-6-48 while slashing .238/.333/.332 in 143 career games. Joseph hit the first pitch he saw in 1958 with Burlington for a home run.

QUITE THE OPENING ACT: As far as first appearances of the season goes, it's tough to beat what Balazovic has done in his career. In his five seasons pitching he is 1-0 with a 1.97 ERA allowing just four runs in 18.1 IP. Of those five appearances he only started his first appearance once, in 2019 with Cedar Rapids. He went 5.0 innings allowing one run on four hits while striking out nine on 76 pitches, 54 for strikes.

OPENING ACT PART DEUX: In 2019, Balazovic was promoted from Cedar Rapids to Fort Myers on May 3. He made his High-A debut for the Miracle two days later and had a debut for the ages. He pitched 7.0 perfect innings while striking out 10 at the Palm Beach Cardinals (St. Louis Cardinals). He threw 95 pitches, 62 for strikes.

OH CANADA: Balazovic was the top-rated Canadian coming out of the 2016 draft. He was the fifth Canadian selected that year. RHP Cal Quantrill (Port Hope, ON) went 8th overall to San Diego out of Stanford (CA) University, C Andrew Zerzy (Toronto, ON) went 52nd overall to Arizona out of York Mills (Toronto) Collegiate Institute, RHP Curtis Taylor (Port Coquitlam, BC) went 119th overall to Arizona out of the University of British Columbia, and SS Charles LeBlanc went 129th overall to Texas out of the University of Pittsburgh.
