TICKET PUNCHED: The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on May 26 paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron,
but held the tiebreaker with a 7 -5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019 . After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffts for the third time in franchise history. In 2011 , they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the
Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.
THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 19 -37 in the second half. They are $13-29$ in the last 42 games including a season-high six-game losing streak from July 14 -23. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost 10 and split five this year. Richmond

Richmond is $25-24$ in games decided by two--r-less runs.
THE BAYSOX are tied for first place in the Western Division in the second half with 12 games remaining. Last week, the Baysox Split a six-game series on the road against the SeaWolves. It was the only set between the two teams in the second half. If the
Baysox and the SeaWolves finish the regular season tied, the team with the best record over its final 20 games will advanc to the Eastern League playoffs. FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Keaton Winn makes his fourth Double-A start and his first against the Baysox. He last pitched On Wednesday against the Senators and allowed five runs over five innings with five strikeouts. Over his final four starts with
High-A Eugene, Winn went $3-0$ with a 2.57 ERA ( 6 ER/21.0 IP) and struck out 33 batters, including setting a career high with 10 strikeouts twice on July 29 against Hillssoro and August 4 at Spokane. Winn was selected by the Giants in the fifth round of and returned to the mound this year to open the season with Low- A San Jose. After going 1-1 with a 4.87 ERA in 13 outings in
the California League, Winn was promoted to Eugene on June 28 . He was assigned to Double-A Richmond on Thursday. For more on Winn, see page two.
FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Grayson Rodriguez makes his first Double-A star to the season. Rodriguez is currently rated as the Orioles No. 2 prospect and the NO. 4-overall prospect by MLB.com. Last yerr, he made 1 . 8 starts for the theansoo and went $6-1$
with a 2.60 ERA and 121 strikeouts, which led the Eastern League, in 79.2 innings. He finished the year with 161 total strikeouts which was sixth-most in the minors. This year, he began the season with Triple-A Norfolk and went 5 - 1 with a 2.09 ERA in 11 starts
before being placed on the iniured list on June 4 with a right lat strain. He made a rehab start for High-A Aberdeen on Thursday and threw 3 pitches over i. scoreless innings, working around two walks and one hit.
PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying S Suirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,140) and rank second in total attendance ( 368,4077 ). Richmond is 15 th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attena.
