Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Kevin Herget** to the mound tonight, looking to run the win streak to four (last, 9/7-9/12/19 in the IL Playoffs). Iowa will counter with RHP **Scott Effross**. The Clippers are 11-16 (.407) against right handers this year. Effross has never pitched against the Clippers in his career, having debuted in Triple-A just one week ago.

vs. the Cubs

Columbus has not played Iowa in the regular season since 1991, when the Cubs played in the American Association. From 1988-91, the two leagues played crossover games with the Clippers winning 11 of 21 against Iowa (also went 11-10 against Omaha and 11-10 against Nashville), including five of 10 at the first Sec Taylor Stadium in Des Moines (demolished and rebuilt after 1991 season).

Turning a Corner

After starting the season 5-1, the Clippers went 4-18 from 5/12-6/5 (worst 22G stretch since 4-18 from 6/13-7/4/09), but have rebounded to win each of the last three. The Clippers are hitting .325 (13x40) with runners in scoring position in the last three (.180, 34x189 in the 22G prior) and have attempted a sac bunt in each (successful twice; had two attempts, both unsuccessful, in previous 22G).

Offensive Offense

Columbus has posted five multi-run innings over the last 14 (since the 5th on Tuesday), equalling the number of multi-run innings produced in the previous 99, dating to 5/25 vs. Nashville. The Clippers have now had consecutive games with multiple multi-run innings for the first time since 5/13-5/14 vs. Omaha. When the Clippers put at least two crooked numbers on the board, they are 6-1.

Out of the Basement

After a brief stint at the bottom of the IL in run differential, the Clippers have moved up to 13th (-43). Each of the last two nights they have won after allowing the opponent to score at least four runs, improving to 3-17 (.150) in such games (Iowa now ranks last, 2-18). On Tuesday, the Clippers won their first game when getting out-homered (1-11), moving ahead of Memphis (now 1-13) in such games.

Cursed at the Top

Heading into Friday, Clipper leadoff hitters were hitting an IL-worst .198. **Oscar Mercado** went 3x4 that night, snapping a 12G streak in which the leadoff hitter did not have a multi-hit game (4x50 between multi-hit games) and has hit .429 (9x21) in his last 5G (leadoff now .231, 10th). However, the leadoff spot has the fewest runs scored in the IL (12), failing to have a multi-run game all season.

Double Time

Ernie Clement's double last night was his first XBH since his XBH streak was snapped at seven games on 5/27 (six doubles, one triple from 5/6-5/27). Of his 19 hits on the season, Clement has 9XBH, resulting in a .468SLG. However, not counted among those hits is a homer, as Clement is the only player in the IL (of 73) with at least 68PA and a .370+SLG that has yet to go deep.

Found a Hit

Daniel Johnson snapped an 18AB hitless streak (12K) last Thursday, but has followed up by going 5x25 (8K) since. After consecutive 2-hit games to start his Triple-A season, Johnson is slashing .165/.232/.359 over 25G with just two multi-hit games. He homered in three straight games from 5/21-5/23 in Toledo, but has failed to go yard in 14G since (58AB, one triple, five doubles).

Swinging Hard

The Clippers have two among the top three in the IL in strikeouts, as **Nolan Jones** ranks 2nd (45K) and **Daniel Johnson** is tied for 3rd (42K). While Johnson still ranks 72nd (.193) among the IL's 77 qualifiers, Jones has risen above .200 for the second time this year (went 0x14 in next 5G after only other day above .200, 5/28). Jones is slugging .466 in 17G since 5/21 (.156SLG in 13G to start year).

Bullpen is Back

Over the last five games, Clipper relievers have posted a 1.42ERA (19.0IP, 3ER) and on the whole of the roadtrip, they are sitting at a respectable 3.46 (26.0IP, 10ER). Removing 5/23's catastrophe in Toledo (5.0IP, 11ER, 3HR, 27BF), the bullpen has a 2.23ERA on the road (72.2IP, 18ER) and has allowed 1HR to 319BF (6.75ERA, 60.0IP, 45ER and 14HR to 279BF at home).

This Date in Clipper History

6/10/1985

The Clippers and Chiefs started what would become the longest game in franchise history, playing a 5:37 marathon that did not get completed until 6/12. In the 20th, after falling behind 7-4, **Bill Lindsey** drove in two with a double, then scored the game tying run before the game was suspended. The Clippers would go on to win 8-7 in 21 innings when the game was resumed, with Lindsey catching all 21 innings.

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 years since the move downtown, Huntington Park has ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game, totaling 2.25 per contest (1,763HR, 783 games). In 2019, HP averaged over three per game for the first time ever (seventh time averaging over a pair), as the Clippers surrendered a record 127HR and just missed out on triple digits themselves (97HR was second highest team total). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (948 to 906).

Record Destruction

The Clippers broke the established mark for homers in a season (182 in 1983) on 8/7/19 and finished with a total of 213 (most in the IL). From 5/14-6/2, they homered in 20 straight games (44HR total) and they had seven straight multi-HR games from 6/14-6/21 (22HR). On the mound, they broke the record for homers allowed (156 in 1998) on 7/31/19, giving up 198 for the year (2nd most in the IL).

Ain't Over 'Til It's Over

From 2014-19, no team had more come from behind victories than the 210 posted by Columbus and no team produced a better winning percentage when trailing than the .353 of the Clippers (Scranton/WB was 2nd in win percentage, .338, and wins, 192). This year has seen the Clippers go 4-19 (.174) in games in which they trail, tied for 11th.

Get What You Pay For

Columbus is the only team in the IL that has yet to play any free baseball this season, having played 71 straight games, including the postseason, since their last extra-inning rumble (7/31/19 vs. Louisville, an 11-8 loss in 11; only extra inning loss of the season, 8-1). Over the past 20 seasons, the longest the Clippers had previously gone between extras was 57 games from 8/12/08-5/17/09 (37 to start '09 season is longest stretch to begin in last 20 seasons). That streak ended with consecutive extra inning games.

Trending Downward

The current staff ERA of 5.42 is on pace to be the worst in franchise history (5.08, 1983) and anything over 4.71 will mark the fifth straight season in which the ERA has gotten worse. From 2011-16, the Clipper staff turned in a sub-4.00ERA five times in six seasons (zero such seasons from 1993-2010), including the best two ERAs of the past 32 years (3.33 in 2015 and 3.65 in 2016). The 7.00ERA at Huntington Park is by far the worst ever (5.29 in 2019, only time ERA has ever been over 5.00 at HP).

Doing Damage

In 2019, the Clippers ranked tied for 5th in the IL with 112RBI with the bases loaded, while carrying a .252 average (10th, 36x143, 4HR). In both 2017 and 2018, the Clippers led the IL in RBI with the bases loaded (243RBI total) and paced the circuit in grand slams (16 total, no other team had more than eight).

Free Swingers

After three straight seasons leading the IL in strikeouts, the Clipper lineup is threatening for a fourth, as they currently rank 5th (306K, 41 off the pace, St. Paul). The 2019 squad obliterated the franchise record, as they struck out 95 more times than the previous high (1,392; each of last three seasons rank among franchise's three worst, totalling 3,979K in 422G). While the record appears safe due to the truncated schedule, this year's version is averaging 9.87K per game.

That's More Like It

In 2019, the Clippers were 50-30 (.625) when playing errorless baseball, while turning in a 31-29 (.517) mark with at least one error. Contrary to logic, in 2018 they actually had a worse winning percentage when playing mistake free (.514), than when committing at least one error (.530). The Clipper defense finished 1st in 2019 (.983) after falling to 6th in the IL in 2018, ending a run of three consecutive seasons ranked among the top three (2015-17 resulted in the three best seasons in franchise history).

One On, No Out Success

When the leadoff batter of an inning reached base in 2019, the Clippers plated him nearly 60% of the time (over 51% only once in the last six seasons, 55% in 2016). Getting more than one base was a specialty of Clipper hitters, as they led the IL with 136XBH to lead off the inning, including 54HR (led the IL, had 28 leadoff homers in 2018). From 4/13-4/20/19, the Clippers hit 16 leadoff doubles over 72 innings, including four straight innings in a win at Louisville on 4/15/19.

Good Baseball

Andres Gimenez advanced a runner with a sac bunt on 6/8 at Iowa and the runner came around to score in the win (2-0 when advanced runner scores). During 2019, the Clippers struggled in the bunt department (12 successes), but when the advanced runners did score, they were 7-1. During 2018, Columbus was 23-2 in games in which a run was scored after a good bunt attempt (54 successes).

International Accolades

Bobby Bradley was named International League Player of the Month for May 2019, reaching base in 24 of 25 games during the month while hitting .302/.374/.740 with 12HR (led IL) and 28RBI. **Brandon Barnes**, **Eric Haase**, **Josh Smith** and **Asher Wojciechowski** were named to the 2019 IL All-Star Team and Bradley, Barnes and Haase were selected to the postseason squad.

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy makes his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's second year as a manager (first with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 42-65 (.393), 12-19 with Columbus (.387).

Returning Champion:

Though 5/26 marked Herget's International League debut, he had pitched in Huntington Park once before, as a member of the Memphis Redbirds against the Durham Bulls in the 2018 Triple-A National Championship (W, 14-5). Herget started and picked up the win for Memphis (5.1IP, 5H, 2R, 2ER, 0BB, 4K), outdueling future Clipper **Chih-Wei Hu** (2019).

That Was Fast:

Starting the season with Fargo-Moorhead in the American Association, Herget made only one start, on 5/19 vs. Cleburne (W, 7.0IP, 3H, 1R, 1ER, 1BB, 10K), before Cleveland signed him to a minor league deal on 5/25. While Herget became the first RedHawk to play for Columbus, six former Clippers have suited up for Fargo-Moorhead: **Jalal Leach**, **Mike Figga**, **Randall Simon**, **Donzell McDonald**, **Yurendell de Caster** and **Yhoxian Medina**.
