**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn and Aberdeen split Sunday's series-ending doubleheader...The IronBirds took the lid-lifter, 5-2, and the Cyclones rallied to win the finale, 6-4...DH **Douglas Hodo** provided the opening run for Aberdeen in Game 1 on a first-inning home run...The IronBirds scored four in the fifth to pull away...3B **Jacob Reimer** and 2B **D'Andre Smith** provided an RBI single and a solo home run in the sixth and seventh, respectively, to break up the shutout...RHP **Jawilme Ramirez** tossed 4.0 innings of one-run, two-hit ball in the loss...Aberdeen jumped out to a 4-0 lead through three innings in the nightcap before the Cyclones came back...Brooklyn scored two in the fourth and three in the fifth to take the lead for good...1B **Mateo Gil** went 3-for-4 with a double, a run scored, and three runs batted in...The 24-year-old drove in the go-ahead run with a single in the fifth...RF **Nick Morabito** posted a 2-for-4 game with two runs, a double, and a steal...RHP **Justin Lawson** hurled a career-high 4.0 innings of relief, allowing one unearned run, for his second win...RHP **Alan Perdomo** pitched a perfect seventh for his first High-A save.

**THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY:** On August 7, 2006, RHP **Jake Ruckle** struck out 10 hitters over 8.0 innings of four-hit shutout ball, as he and RHP **German Marte** (1.0 IP) combined on a five-hitter in a 3-0 win vs. Staten Island...In 2008, RHP **Chris Schwinden** punched out 12 over 7.0 innings of one-hit baseball...He, RHP **Yury Santana** (1.0 IP), and RHP **Stephen Clyne** (1.0) united on a one-hit shutout during a 2-0 win at Lowell...In 2010, LF **William Cherry** hit a game-tying solo home run in the bottom of the ninth before a sacrifice bunt and a throwing error off the bat of 2B **J.B. Brown** provided a walk-off, 3-2 win vs. Connecticut in 11 innings...In 2012, RHPs **Gabriel Ynoa** (7.0 IP) and **Paul Sewald** (2.0) combined on a four-hit shutout in a 1-0 win at Lowell...In 2014, RHP **Martires Arias** (6.0 IP), LHP **Brad Wieck** (2.0), and RHP **Mike Hepple** (1.0) united on a two-hit shutout in a 4-0 win at Mahoning Valley...In 2015, scheduled starting pitcher RHP **Dawrin Frias** was traded by the New York Mets to the Oakland Athletics to complete an earlier trade for LHP **Eric O'Flaherty**...Frias, assigned to Brooklyn's opponent, the Vermont Lake Monsters, is taken across the field by manager **Tom Gamboa** to be introduced to Vermont skipper **Aaron Nieckula** after the deal...In 2021, 1B **Jeremy Vasquez** provided a go-ahead solo home run in the bottom of the eighth in a 5-4 win vs. Hudson Valley.

**vs. HUDSON VALLEY:** The Cyclones return to Coney Island for their final six-game series of 2024 against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...The Renegades have six of New York-AL's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: INF **George Lombard Jr.** (6), LHP **Kyle Carr** (11), INF **Roc Riggio** (17), RHP **Cade Smith** (20), OF **Anthony Hall** (27), and OF **Jace Avina** (29)...Brooklyn and Hudson Valley split a home-and-home series (July 1-6) after the Cyclones took 4-of-6 from Hudson Valley on Coney Island (May 23-28)...Hudson Valley won 4-of-6 in Wappingers Falls (June 11-16)...On the year, the series is tied 9-9...Dating back to 2001, Brooklyn trails the all-time series, 149-153 (.493)

Minor Leaguers with at least 80.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is first in FIP (1.99), second in strikeout rate (36.0%), fifth in strikeout-to-walk rate (26.7%), and tied for sixth in strikeouts (124).

**OMAR-I-GONE:** OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton...The 24-year-old powered a walk-off solo home run in the bottom of the ninth vs. Rome on July 28 and has homered in six of his last 15 games since July 13 at Wilmington...Five of those six home runs have tied the game or provided Brooklyn the lead...Since the All-Star break, Omar is tied for the league lead in triples (2), tied for second in home runs (5), third in slugging (.640), tied for fourth in extra-base hits (8), fifth in total bases (32), ninth in runs scored (11), and tied for ninth in RBI (11)...Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still tied for fifth in the South Atlantic League for the year with 33 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer's** (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (70) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos is second in the South Atlantic League (70) and is sixth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (142).

**LONG ARM OF THE LAW:** RHP **Justin Lawson** tossed a career-high 4.0 innings to earn his second win in Game 2 of Sunday's doubleheader at Aberdeen...The 23-year-old allowed just two hits and one walk, striking out four...Lawson has not allowed an earned run in his last 10.0 innings dating back to July 21 vs. Jersey Shore...Since June 15 at Hudson Valley, the Winfield, La. native has composed a 2-2 record and a pristine 0.79 ERA (2 ER in 22.2 IP), earning two saves...No South Atlantic League reliever with 18.0 or more innings pitched since June 15 has a lower ERA than Lawson (0.79).

**JOLTIN' JEFFREY:** After a tough month of July, UTL **Jeffrey De Los Santos** is starting to flip the script in August...In his last eight games since July 26, the 21-year-old is hitting .280/.419/.520 with a .939 OPS, seven runs scored, three doubles, a home run, seven runs batted in, and five walks...De Los Santos has also reached base safely in six-straight games since July 28, posting a 1.043 OPS in that time.

**TAKING KELLUM 123:** OF **Kellum Clark** snapped out a 1-for-37 funk at the plate with a three-hit game on July 6 at Hudson Valley and has been on a tear offensively since...The 23-year-old has seven multi-hit efforts in his last 19 games...Since July 6, he has been hitting .348/.411/.394 with a .805 OPS, eight runs scored, three doubles, three runs batted in, and three stolen bases over the 19 games...Clark is second in the South Atlantic League in on-base percentage (.411) and batting average (.348) since that date, as well as tied for sixth in hits (23).

**SHUT IT:** Brooklyn has been no stranger to tossing shutouts...The Cyclones tied a franchise record with its 11th shutout win of the season on July 14's 5-0 win at Wilmington...The 11 shutout performances match the 2023 mark for the single-season record...The 11 shutouts are three behind Rome (14) for the most in the South Atlantic League...The Cyclones are also tied for eighth in all of Minor League Baseball in shutouts...Brooklyn has thrown consecutive shutouts three times this season...The Cyclones blanked the IronBirds, 2-0 and 4-0, on May 3 and 4 at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones then earned 7-0 and 3-0 wins at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen, respectively.

**IT'S A WALK-OFF:** For the third time in the homestand, the second time in the series, and the fourth time this season, the Cyclones walked off winners on Sunday afternoon vs. Rome...Down by two runs with one out in the ninth, 3B **Jeffrey De Los Santos** blasted a game-tying two-run home run before LF **Omar De Los Santos** followed with a walk-off solo shot in a 7-6 triumph...The back-to-back jacks marked just the second time Brooklyn had accomplished the feat in 2024...SS **William Lugo** and CF **Stanley Consuegra** clubbed consecutive home runs in the sixth inning on May 18 at Bowling Green...It was also Brooklyn's second walk-off home run of the season...3B **Nick Lorusso** smacked a game-ending solo home run in the bottom of the ninth in a 4-3 win vs. Asheville on April 14...The Cyclones also earned walk-off wins during the homestand on Friday, July 19, on C **Chris Suero's** game-winning bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Jersey Shore and, again, on Wednesday, July 24, courtesy of SS **Wilfredo Lara's** walk-off single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Rome...Since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones have suffered 18 walk-off losses, accumulating 15.13% of all defeats, including 26.47% of all road losses, while earning 11 walk-off wins...29 of Brooklyn's 233 games since the start of the 2023 season have ended in a walk-off (12.45%)...The Cyclones have also earned 22 wins in their last at-bat.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: INF **Jesús Báez** (10), RHP **Jonah Tong** (17), INF **Jacob Reimer** (22), RHP **Jack Wenninger** (27), and RHP **Calvin Ziegler** (30)...Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list and Ziegler is on the full-season IL...Plus six of the Top 30 per MLB: Reimer (14), Tong (18), Báez (20), Ziegler (21), OF **Nick Morabito** (23), and Wenninger (28).

**LET'S PLAY TWO:** After playing two doubleheaders from Opening Day until July 28, the Cyclones are scheduled to play their third doubleheader in the last week on Wednesday...Brooklyn and Aberdeen split a pair of double-dips last week...On Wednesday, The IronBirds won the opener in eight innings, 3-2, and the Cyclones won the nightcap in seven, 3-2, on Wednesday...On Sunday, Aberdeen took the lid-lifter, 5-2, before Brooklyn won the finale, 6-4...Brooklyn is 4-4 in doubleheader games this year and 1-1-2 in doubleheaders overall...In 2023, the Cyclones were 0-4-2 in doubleheaders overall and 2-10 in games.

**ROSTER MOVES:** INF **Kevin Villavicencio** returns to Brooklyn from Single-A St. Lucie, while INF **Mateo Gil** was transferred to Double-A Binghamton on Wednesday...RHP **Dakota Hawkins** rejoined the Cyclones from Double-A Binghamton on Monday, while RHP **Alfred Vega** was added from Single-A St. Lucie...Villavicencio started the season on Coney Island going 9-for-46 (.196) at the plate with a .474 OPS in 14 games...The 20-year-old slashed .218/.283/.291 with a .574 OPS in 63 games in St. Lucie adding a home run, 17 RBI, and 14 stolen bases...Gil was hitting .324/.324/.588 with a .912 OPS in his last nine games...The 24-year-old hit .232/.272/.409 with a .681 OPS, seven home runs, and 28 runs batted in over 57 games with the Cyclones this year...Hawkins jumped up to Binghamton on July 29 and made two appearances last week for the Rumble Ponies...The 24-year-old went 0-1 and allowed four runs in 4.0 innings, walking three and striking out three in the two outings (one start)...Vega made three appearances with St. Lucie after being assigned on July 20...The 23-year-old went 0-1 with a 20.25 ERA (6 ER in 2.2 IP), no walks, and five strikeouts...All six runs came in one appearance...Vega was signed by the New York Mets as a minor league free agent on June 3 after spending the first seven years of his career in the New York Yankees and Baltimore Orioles organizations...OF **Sebastian Castro** and RHP **Jimmy Loper** were also released from the Cyclones roster by the New York Mets on Monday.

**MORABITO BITE:** OF **Nick Morabito** has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season...The 21-year-old finished with his 30th multi-hit game of the year in the second game of Sunday's doubleheader and is currently riding a nine-game hitting streak since July 26, hitting .400/.432/.486 with a .918 OPS, six runs scored, a double, a triple, four RBI, and six stolen bases...Morabito has also reached base safely in 12 consecutive games since July 23, hitting .386/.460/.455 with a .915 OPS, seven runs scored, five RBI, and nine swiped bags...The McLean, Va. native is tied for eighth in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (47)...He is just one steal (36) away from tying OF **Omar De Los Santos'** single-season franchise record of 37, which was set last year...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito has led the league in hits (81), is second in stolen bases (36), fourth in batting average (.292), tied for sixth in runs scored (47), and seventh in on-base percentage (.370)...The former second-round selection is fourth in the SAL in stolen bases (36), sixth in batting average (.292), and seventh in on-base percentage (.370) for the season...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.315), stolen bases (47), on-base percentage (.409), and hits (112)...He is also tied for second in runs scored (61) and triples (4), third in total bases (141), fourth in OPS (.806), and tied for fifth in walks (49).

**THE TONG SONG:** RHP **Jonah Tong** has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the last few weeks...After earning the win in Game 2 last Wednesday, the 21-year-old is 3-2 with a 2.48 ERA (9 ER in 32.2 IP), allowing only 24 hits and 10 walks, while striking out 50 over his last seven starts since June 20...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native leads the circuit and is second among all High-A pitchers in strikeouts (88)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season

**LAST TIME OUT:** Took a no-decision in Game 1 of last Wednesday's doubleheader at Aberdeen...Permitted two runs on four hits over 4.0 innings...Walked three and struck out five...Tossed a wild pitch and charged with a balk...Threw 73 pitches and 44 strikes (60.27%)...Relieved by RHP **Ben Simon** to start the bottom of the fifth and Brooklyn trailing 2-1...Cyclones rallied to tie the game in the sixth on a RF **Jeffrey De Los Santos** single...Aberdeen would win the opener in extra innings, as SS **Carter Young** provided the walk-off sacrifice fly in the bottom of the eighth, 3-2...Brooklyn won the nightcap in seven, 3-2.

**PROSPECT RANKINGS:** Wenninger is ranked as the New York Mets' No. 27 prospect by *Baseball America* and No. 28 by MLB Pipeline.

**WELCOME TO BROOKLYN:** After allowing five runs on eight hits in a loss at Wilmington in his High-A debut on July 9, Wenninger has settled into his spot in the Cyclones rotation. Since pitching in relief on July 14 at Wilmington, Wenninger has a 1.50 ERA (2 ER in 12.0 IP) over his last three appearances (two starts), allowing eight hits, six walks, and striking out 11.

**FLORIDA STATE FIRE:** Wenninger was among the best pitchers in the Florida State League prior to joining the Cyclones on July 8...At the time of his promotion, the 22-year-old ranked second in the FSL in strikeouts (89)...Wenninger was also tied for fifth in innings pitched (71.2), seventh in WHIP (1.26), eighth in batting average against (.238), and ninth in ERA (5.02)...He was also first in xFIP (3.06), third in strikeout rate (28.7%) and strikeout-to-walk rate (21.3%), sixth in walk rate (7.4%).

**2023:** Wenninger signed with the Mets for \$225,000 on July 14...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 22...Tossed a scoreless inning of relief, striking out one, that day at the FCL Cardinals...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on September 5...Started vs. Daytona that day...Took a no-decision after allowing two runs on one hit, walking two, and striking out three, in 1.1 innings.

**ILLI-NOISE:** Wenninger had an outstanding final campaign at the University of Illinois, transferring in after spending his freshman season at Murray (Ky.) State University in 2021...During the 2023 season, the Barrington, Ill. native posted a 6-4 record with a 4.59 ERA (41 ER in 80.1 IP), 28 walks (8.30 BB%), and 76 strikeouts (22.55 K%) in 15 appearances (14 starts) for the Fighting Illini...Wenninger was All-Big Ten Second Team in 2023.

**MLB DRAFT LEAGUE:** Prior to being drafted by the New York Mets, Wenninger made three starts for the Williamsport (Pa.) Crosscutters in the MLB Draft League in 2023...The Crosscutters were a former foe of the Cyclones in the New York-Penn League...The 22-year-old accrued an 0-1 mark with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER in 11.0 IP), seven walks, and 19 strikeouts.

**FAMILY TREE:** Wenninger is far from the only member of his family to play collegiate baseball...Jack's grandfather, **Robert Eckl Sr.**, and his uncle, **Robert Eckl Jr.**, both played baseball at the University of Wisconsin...The Badgers' baseball program, however, was discontinued following the 1990-91 school year.
