TURNING OVER A NEW MONTH: INF/OF **Ryan McBroom** hit his 15th home run of the season to tie for the league lead and OF **Bubba Starling** hit three doubles, but the Omaha Storm Chasers could not overcome an early 5-0 deficit and lost to the St. Paul Saints, 7-4, in the final game in the month of June. It was Omaha's third straight loss, tying the longest losing streak of the season from 5/19-5/21. The Chasers are now 3-5 on the current road trip and 13-12 in 25 road games overall while posting a 19-5 record at Werner Park.

LEADING THE PACK: Despite the three-game losing streak, the Storm Chasers hold a 5.0-game lead in the Triple-A East Midwest Division over the second-place Toledo Mud Hens (DET). Omaha last lost three straight games from 5/19-5/21 @ IOW, falling to 8-7 overall following that streak. Omaha has not had a record below .500 all season and spent one day with a .500 record this season, finishing 1-1 on 5/5 through the first two games of the season. The Chasers were a season-high 18.0-games over .500 on June 26, following a 13-2 win @ IOW.

JOYOUS JUNE: After going 16-7 in May, the Storm Chasers went 16-10 in June to remain in first place in the Triple-A East Midwest Division. It's the 17th time since 2011 that Omaha has won at least 16 games in a single month. Omaha held sole possession of first place for the entire month of June and has been in sole possession of first place since May 26 (36 days). Omaha is on pace to finish the 2021 season with a 78-42 record, which would be the most wins for the Chasers since 2015 (80-64) and break the franchise record for winning percentage (.653). The inaugural 1969 Omaha Royals have the best winning percentage in franchise history at .607 (85-55). In 26 games in June, the Chasers offense hit .280/.342/.540, averaged 6.7 runs/game, and hit 59 home runs in June. Omaha's 59 home runs in June were tied with the Reno Aces for the most home runs in June in affiliated baseball (MLB and MiLB). On the mound, the Chasers posted a team ERA of 5.35 with a starting pitching ERA of 6.12 and a bullpen ERA of 4.69.

HISTORIC HOMER PACE: The Storm Chasers lead Triple-A East and all of Minor League Baseball with 95 home runs in 49 games, averaging just under two home runs per game. Omaha is on pace to hit 232 home runs in the 120-game season, which would break the franchise record of 231 set in 1999 (141 games). The 1999 Omaha Golden Spikes' 231 home runs in a season was a modern Pacific Coast League record until 2019, when El Paso hit 258 home runs in 140 games. If the 2021 season included all 142 initially-scheduled games, Omaha would be on pace for 275 homers. The Sacramento Solons hit 305 home runs in 1974 while playing home games in a converted football stadium with a left-field fence located 233 feet from home plate. Omaha's 95 homers are also more than 13 teams in Major League Baseball. The Chasers have at least one home run in 41 of 49 games this season, notching a 29-12 record when hitting at least one home run. Omaha has recorded 23 multi-homer games, including three four-homer games, five five-homer games, and one seven-homer game.

McBROOM GOES THE DYNAMITE: INF/OF **Ryan McBroom** hit his 15th home run of the season on 6/30 @ STP, snapping a season-long seven-game stretch without a home run. He is currently tied with Worcester's Jarren Durran for the league lead in home runs. After hitting .218 (19-for-87) with seven home runs in 14 games in May, McBroom is batting .301 (28-for-93) with eight home runs in 25 games in June. He has hit cleanup in 40 of Omaha's 49 games.

OLIVARES' ODYSSEY: OF **Edward Olivares** was recalled on Wednesday, marking the fourth time in the last month that Olivares has been recalled. He was initially recalled on 5/30, then optioned on 6/3, recalled again on 6/6, optioned again on 6/9, recalled once more on 6/14, and optioned back to Omaha on 6/17 before his latest promotion. Olivares currently leads Triple-A East in average (.366), ranks third in on-base percentage (.433), and fourth in slugging percentage (.597). In nine games with Kansas City, Olivares has gone 7-for-26 (.269).

FOR OMAHA: LHP **Marcelo Martinez** makes his third start with Omaha and his third career Triple-A start. He allowed one run on two hits in 5.0 innings, striking out six and walking one on 6/25 @ IOW in a game the Chasers lost, 4-3. Martinez gave up a career-high eight runs on nine hits in his Triple-A debut on 6/19 vs. LOU, failing to record an out in the third inning. Martinez, who signed with Kansas City as an international free agent in March of 2018, recorded a 5.33 ERA in his six starts with Double-A Northwest Arkansas, striking out 31 and walking 11. In his last two Double-A starts, Martinez struck out 17, walked 3, and allowed two runs on four hits over 10.0 innings, including a 6.0-inning, nine-strikeout start on 6/1 vs. TUL that helped him earn Double-A Central Pitcher of the Week honors.

FOR ST. PAUL: RHP **Michael Pineda** makes a rehab start for the St. Paul Saints, pitching for the first time since June 13. He was placed on the 10-day Injured List on June 14 with right elbow inflammation. Pineda has a 3.70 ERA in 11 starts for the Minnesota Twins this season, striking out 51 and walking 15 in 56.0 innings. In three starts in June, he posted a 7.94 ERA in 11.1 innings, failing to complete more than 4.1 innings in any of his three outings. The 32-year-old made his Major League debut and was named an All-Star in 2011 with the Seattle, spent four seasons with New York (AL), and is in his third season with Minnesota.

- Held Iowa to one run on two hits in 5.0 innings with six strikeouts on 6/25 @ IOW
- Gave up career-high eight runs on nine hits in Triple-A debut on 6/19 vs. LOU, exiting game with no outs in the third inning after allowing the first five batters to reach on leadoff walk and four straight hits, including a three-run homer
- Named Double-A Central Pitcher of the Week for June 1-7 after striking out nine batters without issuing a walk on 6/1 vs. TUL and pitching 1.1 scoreless innings on 6/6 vs. TUL before rain suspended the game
- Began the 2019 season with Low-A Lexington, making two relief appearances and recording 10 strikeouts in 9.0 innings before earning a promotion to High-A Wilmington
- Made 25 appearances (21 starts) with Wilmington, posting a 4.23 ERA in 121.1 innings with 108 strikeouts
- His combined 130.1 innings and 118 strikeouts in 2019 were both career bests
- Named Burlington's Pitcher of the Year in 2018, his first professional season after leading the Appalachian League in ERA (2.68), strikeouts (71), K/9 (11.2), batting average against (.216), and WHIP (1.00)
