TODAY'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Oklahoma City Comets (Los Angeles Dodgers affiliate) are set for game one of their six-game series on Tuesday night. Last time out, the Express fell in the series finale to the Salt Lake Bees, 8-6, on Sunday at Dell Diamond. Salt Lake RF Josh Lowe opened the scoring with a three-run homer in the first. 3B Christian Moore's sacrifice fly in the second made it 4-0. Round Rock 2B Diego Castillo recorded an RBI double in the bottom of the frame and 3B Cody Freeman hit a solo homer, cutting the deficit to two. The Bees scored four unanswered for an 8-2 lead after seven complete. The E-Train tallied three in the eighth and one in the ninth but fell short by a final of 8-6.

WHERE WE STAND

After falling in the series finale, the Express split a series for the 1st time this season...are now 3-6-1 in series play...1-4-1 in series play at Dell Diamond...3-7 in series finales...are 11 G below .500 and 11.0 G behind first-place Sacramento.

CRIM DAWG

INF Blaine Crim has posted a 1.047 OPS with 9 RBI in 5 G back with the Express... is T-4th in the PCL with 44 RBI (35 with ABQ) and T-10th in home runs (9) this season...is 5th in Express history with 62 home runs, 2 shy of 4th place INF Mark Saccomanno (64)...3rd in Round Rock history with 256 RBI.

BRICKTOWN BLUES

Since 2023, the Express own a 13-23 record at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark, which marks the most losses and the lowest winning percentage (.361) of any PCL club in that span...their 5.72 ERA in Oklahoma City is the 2nd-highest in the league, behind Reno's 6.00 ERA...last series win in Oklahoma City came in 2022 when they won 4 out of 6 between August 9-14.

LIGHTS, CAMERON, ACTION

INF/OF Cam Cauley recorded his team-leading 52nd hit with a double on Sunday...also stole a bag for his 19th of the season, which ranks 2nd among Pacific Coast League base-stealers...19 stolen bases before June ties OF Kellen Strahm (2025) for 2nd most in Round Rock's Triple-A history, both trail OF Bubba Thompson's 22 stolen bases in 2022...is 1 of 3 PCL batters with 50+ base hits and 15+ stolen bases (also, OF Cole Carrigg and OF Henry Bolte).

GO, DIEGO, GO

INF Diego Castillo led the Express in numerous categories in the month of May including H (34) and RBI (20)...his 34 H in May were 3rd in the PCL...owns a 7-game hit streak and RBI streak...slashing .343/.431/.434 with 34 H (34-for-99), HR, 20 RBI, 16 BB and 2 SB since joining the Express on May 1st.

CAN'T TOUCH THIS

The Round Rock pitching staff finished May inducing the most whiffs in the PCL (542) with the lowest hard-hit rate (31.5%)...RHP David Davalillo led all pitchers (min. 50 PA) with his 14.3% hard-hit rate.

THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - WEDNESDAY, JUNE 2, 1982

35-year-old Nolan Ryan took the mound at Olympic Stadium and earned the win as the Houston Astros beat the Montreal Expos, 6-4. Ryan went 7.0 innings, allowing four hits, two earned runs, four walks and five strikeouts.

Alan Ashby helped wake up a struggling Houston offense with a 2-for-4 game that included a double, a home run and five RBIs. Ryan retired 17 of the final 18 Expos he faced and only came out after seven innings because of a pulled groin. "It got tight. I felt I should get out of there. My delivery was terrible tonight and I just couldn't get in any kind of groove," Ryan said postgame.

Ryan allowed an RBI single by Gary Carter in the first inning and a Terry Francona RBI single in the second, but that was all the damage Montreal could do against him. The Expos made it close on an Andre Dawson home run in the eighth and a sacrifice fly by John Milner in the ninth, but the Astros held on.

While Ryan owned a 4.74 ERA after this start, he went 11-5 over his final 22 starts of the season and posted a 2.61 ERA.

MANAGER KYLE MOORE
The 2026 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kyle Moore's first season with the E-Train. In 2025, Moore served as the bench coach for Triple-A Iowa of the Chicago Cubs organization. He previously served as the skipper in the Baltimore chain with Short-Season Aberdeen (2018), Low-A Delmarva (2019), High-A Aberdeen (2021) and Double-A Bowie (2022-23) - combining for a 321-286 (.529) record over five seasons. The 2019 Delmarva Shorebirds were named the 2019 MiLB Team of the Year, finishing with a 90-48 record, the most wins across all of MiLB that season.
A catcher in his playing days, Moore signed with the Orioles as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He played collegiately at University of Alabama after winning three high school state titles with Edgewood (Ala.) Academy. Moore transitioned to coaching in 2012 as a strength and conditioning coach with Delmarva.

PITCHING COACH DAVE BORKOWSKI
Former MLB pitcher Dave Borkowski (Boar-COW-ski) enters his fourth season on Round Rock's staff and 17th year in coaching. He will serve as the Express' pitching coach in 2026, reprising the role he held from 2023-24 after spending the 2025 campaign as the club's bullpen coach. Borkowski spent five seasons as a minor league instructor in the Los Angeles Dodgers' farm system.
His tenure also includes an 11-year stint as a minor league coach for the Houston Astros. Prior to joining the coaching ranks, Borkowski enjoyed a 15-year professional playing career that saw him post a 13-20 record and 5.87 ERA across seven MLB seasons with the Detroit Tigers (1999-2001), Baltimore Orioles (2004), and Houston (2006-08). He was originally selected by Detroit in the 11th round of the 1995 MLB Draft out of Sterling Heights (Mich.) High School.

BENCH COACH CHASE LAMBIN
Lambin enters his sixth year on the Express staff and will reprise his role as bench coach for the fifth straight year (beg. 2022). The 2026 campaign will mark Lambin's 12th in the Texas organization. He has previous stops as a hitting coach for High-A Down East (2019), Low-A Hickory (2018), Short-A Spokane (2017), and the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers (2016). He first joined the Rangers as a member of the Spokane coaching staff in 2015.
Lambin was selected by the New York Mets in the 34th round of the 2002 June draft out of the University of Louisiana at Lafayette and played in the Mets, Marlins, Nationals, Twins, and Royals organizations. He also has international experience, spending the 2009 season with Chiba Lotte in Japan. The versatile defender appeared at every position except catcher over the course of his career.

BULLPEN COACH JULIO VALDEZ
Valdez enters his seventh year in the organization and first as the Rangers' Triple-A pitching coach after serving in the same role with Double-A Frisco (2025), High-A Hickory (2024), Low-A Down East (2023), Rookie-level ACL Rangers (2022), and DSL Rangers (2020-21). During the canceled 2020 campaign, Valdez worked with pitchers at the Dominican Republic complex and Fall Developmental League in Arizona.
The Florida native played baseball at Alabama State University from 2012-16. He attended Lake Howell (Fla.) High School, where he posted a career 15-4 record and 2.20 ERA, and earned all-conference honors as a junior and senior. Valdez transitioned to an assistant coach role at Alabama State in 2017 before becoming Director of Pitching at the Texas Pitching Institute in El Paso, Texas. He spent two years at TPI before taking the same role at Baseball Rebellion in Durham, N.C., before joining the Rangers.

HITTING COACH MATT LAWSON
Former Rangers farmhand Matt Lawson returns for a fifth straight season as Round Rock's hitting coach. Lawson previously served as an assistant coach, hitting instructor, and recruiting coordinator at his alma mater, Missouri State University, from 2014-21. The Missouri native was selected by the Rangers in the 14th round of the 2007 MLB Draft and played seven professional seasons as an infielder in the Texas (2007-10), Seattle (2010), and Cleveland (2011-13) organizations. With Texas, he was named Short-A Spokane's team MVP as a rookie in 2007 and a league All-Star for High-A Bakersfield (2009) and Double-A Frisco (2010) before he was involved in the 2010 trade that brought Cliff Lee to the Rangers.
He holds a degree in psychology and a graduate degree in sports management.

DEVELOPMENT COACH KAWIKA EMSLEY-PAI
Emsley-Pai enters his sixth year in the Texas organization and returns to the Express as a development coach, this after beginning his Rangers tenure in the same role during the 2021 season. He has also served as Double-A Frisco's bench coach (2025) and was a development coach with Frisco (2023-24) and High-A Hickory (2022). He served as the Centralia (Wash.) College head coach and education advocate from 2019-21. Prior to his stint at Centralia, Emsley-Pai had a three-year stint as an education advocate at a maximum-security juvenile rehabilitation facility.
A former catcher in the minor leagues, Emsley-Pai spent six seasons with the Diamondbacks (2010) and Pirates (2011-15) organizations, topping out at Double-A Altoona in 2014. He was originally selected by Arizona in the 10th round of the 2010 June draft out of Lewis-Clark State College in Lewiston, Idaho after spending his freshman year at the University of Texas in 2008.

- He was originally inked to a minor league contract by the New York Mets on 1/15/21 and had a one-year stay in the NYM org. but did not see any game action... **had deal voided after 2 months.**
