YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost their third straight game, falling to the Altoona Curve, 7-5. **Frankie Tostado** gave Richmond a 1-0 lead in the first inning. Altoona pulled ahead with three runs in the bottom of the first. **Mike Gigliotti** picked up a sac fly in the second and Tostado hit a solo homer to tie the score in the third. **Shane Matheny** hit an RBI single to move the Flying Squirrels ahead, 4-3. Blake Sabol hit an RBI double in the third to tie the score and Andres Alvarez put the Curve ahead, 5-4, with a solo homer in the sixth. **Tyler Fitzgerald** tied the game in the seventh with a sac fly. Liover Peguero and Sabol picked up RBI hits in the bottom of the seventh to put Altoona in the lead, 7-5.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. The two teams met for a six-game series in Richmond from April 12-17, the first home series of the year for the Flying Squirrels. Richmond won four games in that set, taking the decisive finale with a walk-off grand slam in the 10th inning by **Will Wilson**. The Flying Squirrels and Curve will face off for another six-game series in Altoona from July 12-17.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost three straight games since Sunday. Last week, they won four-of-six at Harrisburg. The Flying Squirrels have won four series, lost one and split one this year. They won the season-opening set at Bowie from April 8-10, won their first home series against Altoona from April 12-17, lost a series at Erie from April 20-24, won five-of-six against the Baysox at home from April 26-May 1, split a home series against the RubberDucks from May 3-8 and won last week's road series against the Senators. Richmond is tied for first place in the Southwest Division with Akron.

THE CURVE have won two straight after going 5-11 over their last 16 games since April 28. On the year, the Curve have won one series, lost four series and split one series. Last week, they dropped four-of-six at home against the Patriots. Altoona's roster includes 12 of MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects, including Nick Gonzalez (1), Henry Davis (2), Quinn Priester (4 - on IL), Liover Peguero (6), Matt Frazier (10), Mike Burrows (11), Carmen Mlodzinski (14), Kyle Nicolas (18), Jared Triolo (19), Tucapita Marcano (24), Tahnaj Thomas (28) and Luis Ortiz (30). In the Eastern League, Liover Peguero is ranked second in batting average (.323), tied for fifth in RBIs (23), sixth in SLG (.528), tied for first in hits (41), tied for second in doubles (11), tied for second in triples (3), tied for first in extra-base hits (17), second in total bases (67) and tied for ninth in stolen bases (8). Blake Sabol is third in batting average (.320), eighth in OBP (.394), fourth in SLG (.546) and fifth in OPS (.940). Mike Burrows is sixth in ERA (2.35), seventh in BAA (.188), ninth in WHIP (0.98) and tied for first in winning percentage (1.000). Colin Selby is tied for third in saves (5)

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Jake Dahlberg** makes his eighth start of the season. Last time out, he allowed four runs over 5.1 innings in a no-decision at Harrisburg on Friday. He last faced the Curve on April 14 at The Diamond, allowing three runs over four innings. Dahlberg enters the day ranked seventh in the league in innings pitched (35.2) and tied for sixth in winning percentage (.667). Dahlberg spent parts of three seasons with the independent Chicago Dogs before signing with the Giants during the 2021 season. He joined the High-A Eugene Emeralds in July and made 10 starts, going 2-5 with a 6.60 ERA. He closed the year with two outings with Triple-A Sacramento and tossed 9.0 scoreless innings. After being named Horizon League Pitcher of the Year twice at the University of Illinois-Chicago, he was selected in the 21st round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the St. Louis Cardinals. **For more on Dahlberg, see page two.**

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Carmen Mlodzinski makes his seventh start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on May 7 at Erie and worked a season-low three innings, allowing one run. He was placed on the 7-day IL on May 12 and reinstated today. Mlodzinski faced the Flying Squirrels on April 14 at The Diamond and allowed two runs over four innings with five strikeouts. Over his last three starts since April 26, Mlodzinski has gone 0-1 with a 2.25 ERA (3 ER/12.0 IP). He was selected with the 31st-overall pick in the 2020 MLB Draft by the Pirates out of the University of South Carolina. In his first professional season last year, Mlodzinski went 2-3 with a 3.93 ERA in 14 starts for High-A Greensboro. He also made one appearance for Triple-A Indianapolis. Mlodzinski is ranked by MLB.com as the Pirates' No. 14 prospect.

LOPSIDED: On the year, the Flying Squirrels have the worst run differential in the Southwest Division at -10 runs. In their last eight losses dating back to April 27, the Flying Squirrels have fallen by an average of 7.1 runs. Of those eight losses, three have been by 10-or-more runs, including a 10-0 shutout to the Baysox on April 27, a 12-1 loss at Harrisburg on Sunday and a 12-2 loss at Altoona on Tuesday. Richmond has scored two-or-less runs in six of their last eight losses, with the only exceptions being a 10-3 loss on May 7 to Akron and a 7-5 loss at Altoona on Wednesday. On the other hand, the Flying Squirrels' last 11 wins in the same time frame have come by an average of 2.8 runs, including four one-run games.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,057). Richmond is 11th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 45 home runs this season, which is second in the Eastern League behind Somerset (47). **Sean Roby** is second in the league with nine homers on the season, with seven coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 177 home runs.

MARTY PARTY: Over his last six games played since Wednesday, **Brandon Martorano** has hit .364 (8-for-22) with three homers, two doubles, a triple and nine RBIs. Last Wednesday, he clubbed the second grand slam of his career. He returned to the lineup on Friday and lifted the Flying Squirrels to a 6-5 win in extras with a sac fly in the 10th inning. On Saturday, he homered twice for the first time in his career, knocking a go-ahead, three-run homer in the sixth and a solo shot for an insurance run in the ninth inning.

SHANE TRAIN: Last Thursday, **Shane Matheny** hit a pair of solo homers, his second two-homer game of the season and the third of his professional career. He hit two home runs against the Baysox at The Diamond on May 1. He also had a two-homer game on August 25, 2019 with High-A San Jose at Stockton, part of his career-best 10 homers that season. This year, Matheny has hit five home runs, already surpassing his season total of four from 2021 with the Flying Squirrels. This season, Matheny is ranked seventh in the Eastern League in OBP (.398) and seventh in OPS (.904). He is also ranked sixth in the league in wOBA (.404) and wRC+ (154). Over his last seven games since May 11, Matheny is batting .346 (9-for-26) with two homers, two doubles and four RBIs.

ROBUST: **Sean Roby** is second in the Eastern League with nine home runs on the season. With his two-run homer on April 29, Roby tied the franchise record for the most home runs in a calendar month, evening **Jarret Parker's** record of eight from May 2013. Seven of Roby's home runs have come at The Diamond, which ties him for the fifth-most homers in a season at home in franchise history. He snapped an eight-game stretch without a homer with his solo shot on Friday night at Harrisburg. For the season, Roby has hit five of his nine homers against the Curve.

TOASTY: **Frankie Tostado** is batting .369 (31-for-84) with four homers, four doubles and 14 RBIs over his last 21 games since April 22. From April 22-May 4, he posted a 10-game hitting streak, which was tied for the longest in the league this year at the time. Last Wednesday, he tied a career high with four hits against the Senators. He is currently riding a seven-game hitting streak since May 10, during which he is batting .414 (12-for-29) with two homers, one double and five RBIs. Tostado is ranked first in the Eastern League in batting average (.336) and tied for first in hits (41).

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Frankie Tostado** is ranked first in the Eastern League in batting average (.336), tied first in his (41) and tied for fourth in total bases (64). **Sean Roby** is second in home runs (9), ninth in SLG (.523) and tied for eighth in total bases (57). **Shane Matheny** is seventh in OBP (.398) and seventh in OPS (.904). **Mike Gigliotti** is tied for seventh in stolen bases (9). **Ryan Walker** is first in wins (6) and **Solomon Bates** is tied for second (4). **Chris Wright** is tied for fifth in saves (4). **Jake Dahlberg** is seventh in inning pitched (35.2) and **Kai-Wei Teng** is tied for ninth (33.2).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-40 Giants prospects, including **Will Wilson** (14), **R.J. Dabovich** (17), **Tyler Fitzgerald** (34), **Diego Rincones** (36) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (40). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Dabovich (17), Wilson (22) and **Brett Auerbach** (28).
