Syracuse Mets RHP Justin Jarvis (1-2, 5.40) vs. Worcester Red Sox RHP Hunter Dobbins (0-2, 4.66)

The Final Four (at home) – The Worcester Red Sox – who have won 5 straight, 9 of 10, 19 of their last 24 games, and are 23-7 since August 7– look to continue their climb towards the top spot in the league when they play game four of their last home series of the season against the Syracuse Mets tonight at 6:05 pm at Polar Park. Tonight’s game is live on NESN and can be heard on NASH 98.9 FM as well as the rest of the WooSox Radio Network. 2nd-place Worcester, who has just four home games left (tonight & tomorrow both at 6:05 pm and Saturday at 4:05 pm & Sunday at 1:05 pm) in addition to six road games next week/weekend in Lehigh Valley, remained 2½ games behind Columbus for the best record in the International League as each club won last night. The WooSox and Clippers are battling for the one second half playoff spot that comes with the best overall 2nd half record in the league. Each team has 10 regular-season games remaining on the year.

Feeling High - The WooSox have reached season-highs of 13-games over .500 in the 2nd half (39-26) and 8-games above .500 overall on the season (74-66). They need just two wins in 10 tries to post a winning record for the fourth year in as many years of existence.

First and Ten – The WooSox have 10 games remaining and they are alone in 2nd-place in the 2nd-half among all 20 clubs in the International League. Worcester is 39-26 and just 2½-games behind Columbus who has the best 2nd half record in the entire league at 41-23. Columbus will play one less game than the WooSox in the 2nd half. Worcester is alone atop the IL East division by 2-games ahead of 2nd-place Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, but a division pennant does not mean a playoff spot as only one team (with the best 2nd half record) will earn a playoff spot opposite 1st half winner Omaha. The IL Playoffs will be a best two out of three series from September 24-26 in Omaha. The Triple-A National Championship Game (IL winner vs. PCL winner) will take place on September 28 in a little town called Vegas.

Remaining Schedules – Columbus hosts St. Paul for four more games and plays at Toledo for six games next week/weekend. Worcester hosts Syracuse for four more games and plays at Lehigh Valley for six games next week/weekend. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre hosts Lehigh Valley for four more games and then plays at Buffalo for six games. And Indianapolis hosts Rochester for four more games and then plays at St. Paul for six games to close out the regular-season that ends on Sunday, September 22.

What’s Left – As mentioned, the 74-66 WooSox have 10 games remaining to try to post their fourth consecutive winning season in four tries. Two more wins would clinch another winning campaign for the 2024 WooSox. Six victories would give the WooSox their most victories in a single-season. The 2021 WooSox went 74-54 during their abbreviated inaugural season, the 2022 WooSox went 75-73, and last season Worcester finished with a 79-68 record – the 79 victories a club-most.

Thank You Fans - It is Fan Appreciation Week/Weekend at Polar Park, presented by Bank of America. See more info on page 2 of these Game Notes for further details as the WooSox take this week and weekend to “thank” their loyal fans for another tremendous season as they get set to complete their fourth year together at Polar Park.

Runs in the Family – Worcester has the best run differential in the league overall this season at +129 (822 runs scored and 693 runs allowed). Omaha, the 1st half champion, is a +112. In the 2nd half alone, the WooSox also own the best run differential in the IL at +95 runs (the Sox have 399 runs vs. 304 against). Gwinnett is next at +85.

Throwback Thursday Guests - For their final Throwback Thursday of the season tonight, the WooSox tonight welcome a pair of former Boston Red Sox standouts...Red Sox Hall of Fame RHP **Derek Lowe** and Red Sox infielder/outfielder **Steve Lyons**. Both will be introduced on-field before the game tonight and will greet fans and sign autographs in the Sherwood's Diner on Summit St. behind the outfield...Lyons during the 2nd – 5th innings and Lowe during the 5th – 7th innings.

Derek Lowe was inducted into the Boston Red Sox Hall of Fame in 2018. Lowe appeared in 384 games (111 starts) for the Red Sox from 1997-2004, earning All-Star honors as both a reliever (2000) and as a starting pitcher (2002). He remains the only pitcher in MLB history to earn a series-clinching win in the Division Series, Championship Series, and World Series in a single postseason, having defeated the Anaheim Angels, New York Yankees, and St. Louis Cardinals in 2004 to help the Red Sox capture their first championship in 86 years. He began his career with the Seattle Mariners, but came to Boston midway through his first season in one of the most lopsided trades in baseball history on July 31, 1997 when he and Jason Varitek were dealt from Seattle to Boston for Heathcliff Slocumb. Lowe led the AL with 42 saves in 2000, and in 2002 he finished third in Cy Young Award voting after going 21-8 with a 2.58 ERA in 32 starts. Derek threw the 16th no-hitter in Red Sox history on April 27, 2002 against the Tampa Bay Devil Rays, walking only one batter in Boston's 10-0 victory at Fenway Park. He appeared in 17 postseason games (six starts).

Former Pawtucket Red Sox/Boston Red Sox infielder/outfielder and former NESN and MLB color analyst **Steve Lyons** is back at Polar Park for the second straight September tonight. Steve "Psycho" Lyons played for parts of 9 seasons in the majors with Boston (1985-86, 1991-93), the White Sox (1986-1990), and Atlanta & Montreal in 1992 and had a career average of .252 in 852 games with 19 HR & 196 RBI. A Tacoma, WA native, Lyons was Boston's 1st round selection in the 1981 June draft (#19 overall) out of Oregon State University. He helped lead the Pawtucket Red Sox to the 1984 Governors' Cup Championship and had a fine 1984 season with the PawSox hitting .268 with 17 HR, 62 RBU, and 35 stolen bases. After his playing career he worked as a color analyst for FOX Sports and for the LA Dodgers and Boston Red Sox. In 1995 he wrote a book called *PSYCHOanalysis* with a foreword by Stephen King.

WooSox Batters Leading the Way – Worcester leads all 20 International League clubs in a host of team offensive categories. The WooSox lead the league with 822 runs scored (Scranton/Wilkes-Barre is next with 789 runs scored). The Sox also lead the IL with 732 walks (Buffalo is 2nd with 642 walks). Worcester has the most hit batsmen at 93 (a new Red Sox Triple-A record). It all adds up to an impressive .371 on-base pct. as the WooSox are the only team in the IL with an OBP of over .360 (Scranton/WB is 2nd at .359).

Runs on Dunkin' – The WooSox – who lead the league with 822 runs scored on the season - have out-scored their opponents by a combined, 72-33 while winning 8 of their last 9 official games in September with their victories by scores of 11-6, 3-1, 7-0, 13-10, 12-2, 9-7, 8-4, and 7-0. During a 3-game winning streak from August 25-28, Worcester routed opponents by a total of 30-6 including wins by scores of 13-0, 12-2, and 5-4. While winning 12 of their last 16, the Sox are averaging 9.3 runs/game in those 12 victories (111 runs total).

Dancing in September – Worcester is off to a 8-1 start in September (although they have actually won 9 games this month with Tuesday's victory in the August 11th suspended game counting on their August record). WooSox batters are hitting .289 in September (86-for-298) while pitchers have posted a 3.35 ERA this month (29 ER in 78 IP). The WooSox have out-homered, 16-5 and out-scored their opponents, 72-33 thus far this month. Furthermore, Worcester has recorded victories by scores of 11-6, 13-10, 12-2, 9-7, 8-4, and 7-0 already this month.

A New High – Worcester is presently both a 2nd-half high of 13-games over .500 (now at 39-26) and an overall season-high of 8-games over .500 (now at 74-66). The WooSox have won 9 of 10 overall, 7 of 8 on the road, 10 of 14 at home, and have come up winners in 23 of their last 30 games since August 7. The WooSox have not been 8-games above .500 since they ended last season with a 79-68 record.

Five Guys – The WooSox have won 5 of 6 games during three of their last four series. They most recently finished off 5 victories in 6 tries in Rochester from September 2-8 including back-to-back wins last weekend (12-2 on Saturday and 9-7 in 10-innings on Sunday). In their last home series from August 27 – September 1, Worcester split a 6-game set vs. Toledo, but prior to that they won 5 of 6 in Norfolk from August 20-25 and then turned the similar trick vs. Lehigh Valley at home from August 13-18. Worcester's previous series from August 6-11 was actually completed on September 10 as the Sox eventually won 4 of 6 "in" Syracuse. Worcester is 10-8-7 in their first 25 series this season (10 wins, 8 losses, and 7 splits) and they have not lost a series since dropping 4 of 6 at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre from July 23-28 (seven series ago).

Road Work – Worcester has won 7 of their last 8 away games and they have won 11 of their last 13 on the road. They are also 15-4 on the road since July 28 to pull over .500 with their 36-34 away record. Worcester is 6-games over .500 at Polar Park with their 38-32 home record.

Pitching In – Since August 13, WooSox pitchers lead the International League with a 2.84 ERA (82 ER in 260 IP) with 11 saves. Worcester is 20-6 during this span.

Rankings – Worcester is 5th in the IL in team batting with a .261 average while Syracuse is 16th at .248. On the pitching side, the Sox are 7th in team ERA (4.79) while the Mets are 14th with a 5.01 ERA. Sox pitchers have allowed the fewest HR in the league (134). And Worcester is 2nd in the IL with 1085 LOB behind only Gwinnett (1107 LOB).

Hit Me With Your Best Shot – When Eddy Alvarez was hit by a pitch in Game 1 of the August 10 doubleheader at Syracuse he became the 80th WooSox player hit by a pitch this season which is a new Boston Red Sox Triple-A record. The previous Red Sox Triple-A record for Most Hit by Pitch (by batters) had been 79 set by both the Pawtucket Red Sox in 2000 & tied by the Worcester Red Sox in 2022. Worcester now has 93 HB on the year.

This Season vs. Syracuse – The WooSox are 11-9 vs. Syracuse this season (finishing 8-7 in Syracuse and going 3-2 at Polar Park thus far). The Sox dropped 4 of 6 in their first series at Syracuse this season back from April 8-14, won 2 of 3 during their next visit from July 1-3, and Worcester ultimately won 4 games to 2 in their 6-game set in Syracuse from August 6-11.

Stats vs. the Mets – Worcester is 11-9 vs. Syracuse this season as pitchers have posted a 4.36 ERA (79 ER in 163 IP) with 25 HRA while Sox batters are hitting .250 (160-for-640) with 27 HR. The WooSox have out-scored the Mets, 118-88 in the first 20 games.

Last Season vs. Syracuse - The WooSox won the season-series over Syracuse last year by a 14-7 margin. The Sox went 10-5 at home vs. the Mets and were 4-2 here in Syracuse. Pawtucket/Worcester leads the all-time series over Syracuse by a 479-462 count.

Highs and Lows – The WooSox (now 74-66 overall) have reached a season-high 8-games over .500 for the first time since they ended last year with a 79-68 record. On August 6 (at 50-59) - for only the second time in club-history - they had dropped to 9-games under. On July 27, for the first time this year and the first time in franchise-history, Worcester had fallen to 9-games under .500 (at 46-55).

Streaks – Worcester’s 7-game winning streak from August 16-23 was their season-high and tied the second longest winning streak in WooSox franchise history. The Sox had one other 7-game winning streak and that came during their inaugural 2021 season (from June 8-15, 2021). The WooSox club record for longest winning streak is 8-games from August 31 – September 8, 2021. The Sox suffered a season-high 6-game losing streak from May 22-28 which was Worcester’s longest in over a year since a 6-game losing streak from April 9-14 of last season.

One of a Kind – Worcester had won six straight 1-run decisions between July 28 and August 28, but they have dropped their last two 1-run decisions and are now 10-16 in 1-run affairs this season. They began the year 4-14 in 1-run games.

Close Encounters - In games decided by one run or two runs this season, the WooSox are 21-32 (.396). When games are decided by 3 runs or more, the WooSox are 53-34 (.609).

Daydream Believers – Worcester has had more success this season in day games (33-23) than at night (41-43).

Series Matters – Worcester is 10-8-7 in their first 25 series this season (10 wins, 8 losses, and 7 splits). The WooSox are 4-3-5 in their 12 home series compared to 6-5-2 in their 13 road sets. Worcester finished 13-8-5 in their 26 series last season...13 winners, 8 losers, and 5 splits. The Sox went 8-3-2 in 13 series at Polar Park and 5-5-3 in 13 sets on the road.

Comebacks and Last AB – Worcester has 39 come-from-behind victories this season including 9 wins in their last at-bat of the game and 2 walk-offs. They have suffered 17 losses during the opponent’s final at-bat.

Second Half Adjustments – The WooSox are 39-26 in the 2nd half of the season (the final 75 games from June 25 through September 22). Worcester went 35-40 during the 1st half good for 7th-place in the IL East and 11½-games in back of division champ Syracuse who went 46-28 and won the division. However, Omaha from the IL West had the best overall record in the first half and the Storm Chasers earned the one playoff spot as first half champs.

No Dogs in August – The final WooSox record for August is 18-10 as the Sox set a new Worcester club-record for most wins in a single month.

Monthly Dividends – As mentioned above, with a 18-10 record in August, the WooSox established a new club-record for most wins in a single month. Worcester had won 16 games in a month four other times in their nearly four years of existence...they went 16-7 in September of 2021 (their best month ever), 16-10 in June of 2022, 16-9 in June of 2023, and 16-11 in August of 2023. This season the Sox have gone 2-1 in March, 10-14 in April, 14-14 in May, 12-13 in June, and 10-13 in July, and 18-10 mark in August.

August Moon – The WooSox batted .261 in August (234-for-897) with a 4.29 ERA (114 ER in 239 IP). Worcester hit 28 HR and allowed 24 HR and they out-scored the opposition, 159-123 while going 18-10 during the month of August.

Goodbye to July - The WooSox finished 10-13 in July after going 2-1 in March, 10-14 in April, 14-14 in May, and 12-13 in June. This July the WooSox batted .253 with 31 HR along with a 5.05 ERA while out-scoring the opposition, 129-122. Worcester’s best offensive month was June (.284) and their best month on the mound was May (4.88).

June Over – The WooSox finished 12-13 in June. The team batted .284 in June with 30 HR – their best month of the year and the 3rd highest average in the league in June. Sox pitchers had a 4.99 ERA during the month with 26 HRA. Worcester out-scored their opponents, 160-137 in June.

May Be or Might Be - The WooSox rallied to win their final three games in May and finish the month even with a 14-14 record. Sox pitchers had a 4.88 ERA with 27 HRA in May while Sox batters hit .256 during the month with 42 HR.

April Recap - The WooSox finished 10-14 in April (after going 2-1 in March) while batting .244 with 22 HR. Sox pitchers were 10-14 with a 5.55 ERA with 25 HRA.

A Winning Tradition – The 2023 Worcester Red Sox went 79-68 to post a winning season for the third time in as many years of existence. Worcester finished with a 43-33 home record compared to 36-35 on the road last year. The 2021 WooSox went 74-54 during their abbreviated inaugural season while the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73.

You Need a Scorecard – The 2023 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records as they made **271 player transactions** during the 2023 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used **79 different players** in 2023 (33 position players and 46 pitchers) to better the mark of 75 different players in 2022 (31 position players and 44 pitchers). Ironically, the 2021 WooSox set the previous mark of 72 different players (31 position players and 41 pitchers).

Two Dozen to Go - 25 different WooSox players were promoted to Boston during the 2023 season (not counting Red Sox rehabbing players) including Jarren Duran, Chris Murphy, Brandon Walter, David Hamilton, Wilyer Abreu, Ceddanne Rafaela, and many others.

PORTLAND SEA DOGS (AA) UPDATE – The Portland Sea Dogs (40-25)/(76-58) lost their second straight to the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, 8-4 last night in game two of their regular-season-ending 6-game series in Portland. The Sea Dogs dropped into 2nd-place and now trail Somerset by a ½-gam in the Eastern League Northeast Division. Each team has four games remaining as Somerset hosts New Hampshire this week/weekend. Somerset had a game canceled so they will play one less game than the Sea Dogs. The 2nd half division champ will face Hartford in the first round of the playoffs beginning September 17.

Elih Marrero smoked his sixth homer (a 2-run shot) in a multi-hit night. Blaze Jordan recorded his second multi-hit night of the series going two-for-four with an RBI while notching his fourth consecutive multi-hit game. Ahbram Liendo went three-for-three with an RBI and a walk. RHP Blake Wehunt (0-1, 9.00 ERA) was the loser after pitching 5.0 innings allowing five runs on eight hits.

WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES – The Worcester Red Sox today added INF/OF **Tyler Miller** who was transferred from Double-A Portland. The WooSox placed RHP **Alex Speas** on the development list to make room for Miller. Including today, the WooSox have made 71 player transactions in the last 32 days.

Worcester has used 77 players this season (33 position players and 44 pitchers). Tyler Miller will be #78 when he makes his debut tonight as the WooSox first baseman. RHP Jose Adames would be #79 if/when he makes his 2024 WooSox debut. The all-time Pawtucket/Worcester franchise-record is 79 players employed by the WooSox last year.

WooSox to BoSox - The WooSox have sent 25 different players to Boston since the season started (not counting rehab players). The list...INF David Hamilton, INF Romy Gonzalez, LHP Brennan Bernardino, INF/OF Bobby Dalbec, RHP Cooper Criswell, LHP Joe Jacques, LHP Cam Booser, C Tyler Heineman, RHP Zack Kelly, RHP Naoyuki Uwasawa, INF Enmanuel Valdez, INF/OF Jamie Westbrook, RHP Josh Winckowski, RHP Isaiah Campbell, LHP Bailey Horn, RHP Trey Wingenter, INF/OF Nick Sogard, RHP Brad Keller, RHP Chase Shugart, C/INF Mickey Gasper, RHP Greg Weissert, LHP Joely Rodriguez, LHP Rich Hill, RHP Luis Guerrero, and RHP Richard Fitts. Those 25 do not include OF Rob Refsnyder, INF Vaughn Grissom, RHP Nick Pivetta, OF Tyler O’Neill, OF Masataka Yoshida, RHP Chris Martin, OF Wilyer Abreu, 1B Triston Casas, and INF Trevor Story who were all injury rehab recalls from Worcester to Boston. Uwasawa, Heineman, Westbrook, Grissom, Horn, Keller, Gasper, Shugart, and Dalbec are all back with the WooSox. Campbell is on Boston’s 60-day injured list, Hill was released, Rodriguez elected free agency, Jacques was claimed off waivers by Arizona, and Wingenter claimed off waivers by the Cubs. The rest of those players are still with the Red Sox although Booser is currently on an injury rehab assignment with Double-A Portland.

Sea Dog to Woofsters – INF/OF Tyler Miller is the 19th different player promoted from Double-A Portland to Triple-A Worcester this season. The list: OF Tyler McDonough (April 2 & July 31), RHP Cody Scroggins (April 16), LHP Brendan Cellucci (April 24), RHP Robert Kwiatkowski (April 28), RHP Ryan Zeferjahn (May 2), LHP Zach Penrod (May 26), C Mickey Gasper (June 4), OF Matthew Lugo (June 4), INF Nick Yorke (June 5), INF/OF Karson Simas (June 6), RHP Wyatt Olds (July 23), OF Corey Rosier (August 3), INF Marcelo Mayer (August 13), OF Roman Anthony (August 13), C Kyle Teel (August 13), INF/OF Kristian Campbell (August 20), RHP Hunter Dobbins (August 22 – although he went on the WooSox development list before being reinstated on August 30), RHP Jacob Webb (September 7), and INF/OF Tyler Miller (September 12).
