**FOR STARTERS:** The Rocket City Trash Pandas continue a road series with game two of a six-game series, The Rickwood Classic, against the Chicago White Sox affiliate Birmingham Barons at Rickwood Field ... The clubs will meet 24 times this season, and this is the second of four series against the Barons in 2025, with the Pandas hosting the Barons from July 29 to August 3 at Toyota Field and Rocket City making a return trip to Birmingham on August 19-24 ... Rocket City is coming off of a 4-2 series win over the Biloxi Shuckers at Toyota Field ... The Trash Pandas are 56-54 all-time against the Barons and 3-4 this season.

**THE RICKWOOD CLASSIC:** For the first time, the Rocket City Trash Pandas will play in the Rickwood Classic at the oldest ballpark in America, Rickwood Field. The annual game went on from 1996 to 2019, with the classic returning in 2024. The Barons, along with the Friends of Rickwood, created a special baseball game that celebrates and honors legendary teams, players, and eras of Black Barons, A's, and Barons history.

**RCTP UNIFORMS:** In the late 1940s and early 1950s, Huntsville was home to a Negro League minor league team known as the Huntsville Stars, and the uniforms Rocket City wears today salutes them. This team provided opportunities for African American players during an era when segregation barred them from Major League Baseball. Some of the more prominent players to don a Huntsville Stars Negro League uniform were **Otha Bailey, Carl Holden and Eugene Scruggs**. The modern-day Huntsville Stars played in the Rickwood Classic against the Barons in 1999 (lost 5-4), and 2003 (lost 5-1, rain-shortened), and 2004 (won 8-6). **TRASH PANDAS WIN IN EXTRAS TO START ROAD TRIP:** The Trash Pandas secured a thrilling 3-2 victory over the Birmingham Barons in 10 innings on Tuesday night, starting their six-game road series on a high note. Birmingham initially took the lead with a run in the first inning, but the Pandas quickly responded in the second, scoring two runs to go up 2-1. After a tense game with limited baserunners, the Barons tied the game in the eighth. In extra innings, the Pandas regained the lead with a run and held on to win, thanks to another strong performance from reliever **Jared Southard**, who pitched the final two innings to earn the win. **Nelson Rada** extended his on-base streak to 12 games, while Joe Redfield shined with two hits and two RBIs, including the game winner in the 10th.

**YOU BETTER GRAB A NEW ROSTER:** The Angels made six roster moves impacting the Trash Pandas roster on Monday and Tuesday. On Monday, LHP **Sam Aldegheri** was recalled by the Angels, and joined the club in Boston. INF **Travis Blankenhorn** was sent on a rehab assignment to the ACL Angels. On Tuesday, the Angels released INF **Sonny Dichiara**, and placed C **Jaxx Groshans** on the Development List. The Angels signed INF **Evan Edwards** and assigned him to Rocket City, and transferred the recently signed, and former White Sox prospect **Oscar Colas** to Rocket City.

**ROCKET ARMS:** During last week's 4-2 series win over the Shuckers at Toyota Field, the pitching staff posted a 1.98 ERA, plus struck out 50 to only 16 walks, and second best WHIP in Double-A baseball, 0.88.

**TOPPING THE LEAGUE IN ATTENDANCE:** The Trash Pandas have led the Southern League in attendance in each of the team's first four seasons, and there are no signs of it slowing down. Through the first two months, and despite two brand new ballparks, Rocket City leads the league by averaging 4,424 fans per game.

**JERSEY-PALOOZA:** The Trash Pandas are amid an eight-game stretch in which they will wear different jerseys in each game, including last week's six-game homestand against Biloxi and the first two games in Birmingham. On Wednesday, May 28, they sported the home white jersey. On Thursday, May 29, they wore a camo jersey for the first game and a throwback pinstripe jersey for the nightcap. On Friday, May 30, the team showcased the Oat Milk jersey. Saturday, May 31, featured a Harry Potter-themed jersey, and on Sunday, June 1, donned their Copa identity as the Lunáticos de Rocket City. In game one of the series in Birmingham, they sported the Halo Blue tops and will wear Huntsville Stars Negro Minor League jerseys for the Rickwood Classic.

**19 AND "RADA-CALLY" GIFTED:** CF **Nelson Rada**, the youngest player in the Southern League at 19 years and 8 months, leads all of Double-A with 25 stolen bases this season, including 19 in May. **Rada ranks among the league leaders** in stolen bases (1st, 25), OBP (1st, .412), batting average (5th, .287), walks (4th, 32), and hits (9th, 48).

**STREAKING...** Rada has reached base safely in 12-straight games, batting .359 (14-for-39), with five runs, eight steals, eight walks, and posted a .479 OBP since May 21 ... He's also been on base in 20 of 21 games since May 10, batting .343 (24-for-70), with .471 OBP.

**MAY WAS A GOOD MONTH FOR BROWN AND RADA:** Over 26 games in May, **Sam Brown** finished 4th in the league in batting at .301 (28-for-93), with eight extra-base hits, and 14 RBIs, and **Nelson Rada** finished 2nd in batting at .325 (27-for-83), and 2nd in OBP (.467) this month. Rada led all of Double-A and was 3rd in MiLB with 19 stolen bases.

**WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU:** Rocket City's Player of the Month in May, **Sam Brown** has reached base safely in 34 of his last 39 games since April 18, posting a .308 batting average (41-for-133), 2nd in the Southern in batting over that time. **Brown ranks among the league leaders** in batting average (10th, .272), and OBP (8th, .372).

**THE "GUZ" IS LOOSE AGAIN:** Since May 12, **Denzer Guzman** is T-4th in the Southern League with 11 RBI, recording four doubles and a home run on May 22 at Chattanooga. The 21-year-old now **ranks among the Southern League leaders** in RBI (T-6th, 26), doubles (T-5th, 10), and extra-base hits (T-7th, 15).

**PUTTING THE HURT ON 'EM:** Starter **Joel Hurtado** leads the club with five quality starts and **leads the Southern League** with 54.2 innings pitched. He also **ranks among the Southern League leaders** in starts (T-1st, 10), wins (T-6th, 4), ERA (9th, 3.29), and WHIP (10th, 1.26).

**JARED'S ERA IS GOING SOUTH(ARD):** Trash Pandas reliever **Jared Southard** made his league leading 19th appearance on Tuesday night, and recorded his first Double-A win. The right-hander out of Texas hasn't allowed just one baserunner over his last five outings, and 6.2 innings pitched, no walks, and nine strikeouts.

### ADDITIONAL NOTES (CONT)

**RICKWOOD CLASSIC:** Last season, the Rickwood Classic returned for the first time since 2019. On June 20, the St. Louis Cardinals faced the San Francisco Giants in the first Major League Baseball regular-season game ever played in Alabama. The Cardinals won the game 6-5. Both teams wore throwback uniforms to honor the Negro Leagues, with the Giants donning San Francisco Sea Lions jerseys and the Cardinals wearing St. Louis Stars uniforms. The game also featured the first all-Black umpiring crew in MLB history. The event was broadcast nationally on FOX, bringing widespread attention to the rich history of Rickwood Field and the Negro Leagues. In addition to the MLB game, the Birmingham Barons hosted the Montgomery Biscuits in a Minor League Baseball (MiLB) game at Rickwood Field on June 18, 2024. The Barons played as the Birmingham Black Barons, and the Biscuits played as the Montgomery Gray Sox, paying homage to their Negro League predecessors. The Biscuits won the game 6-5. Rickwood Field, the oldest ballpark in America, opened in 1910 and is the oldest professional baseball park in the United States. It served as the home field for the Birmingham Barons and the Birmingham Black Barons, featuring legendary players like Willie Mays, who began his professional career there at age 17 in 1948. The field has been preserved and restored over the years, maintaining its historical significance.

**HOMECOMING FOR MITCH DALY:** On May 20, the Trash Pandas added INF Mitch Daly, who attended Madison's Bob Jones High School (2.6 miles from Toyota Field). He was a four-year starter at shortstop and ranked as the top shortstop in Alabama, signing with Texas and eventually finishing his college career at Kentucky. Daly moved eight times as a kid, was born in Fort Hood, TX, and was the son of a four-star General in the United States Army. Edward Daly. Mitch logged his first ever hit at Toyota Field on May 28.

**PROSPECTS WITH A HALO:** The Trash Pandas roster features four of the Angels' top 10 prospects and nine of the top 25; included in the top 10 are RHP **George Klassen** (3), LHP **Sam Aldegheri** (5), OF **Nelson Rada** (6), and INF **Denzer Guzman** (9). The other members of the roster included in the Top-30 include LHP **Samy Natera Jr.** (16), RHP **Walbert Ureña** (17), RHP **Joel Hurtado** (19), RHP **Camden Minacci** (20), and INF **Cole Fontenelle** (23).

**C-MO TO TRIPLE-A:** The LA Angel's top prospect and eighth-overall pick in the 2024 draft, **Christian Moore**, was promoted to Triple-A Salt Lake on May 20. The former All-American at Tennessee heads west riding a seven-game hitting streak and has been on base in 16 of his last 17 games, batting .302 (19-for-63).

**PANDAS ADD VETERAN ARMS:** On May 7 the Trash Pandas added a pair of right-handed pitchers in 28-year-old **Jordan Holloway** and 31-year-old **Sean Poppen**. Both were signed in April and have combined for 78 MLB appearances since 2019. Holloway appeared in 15 games for Miami in 2021-22, and Poppen pitched in 63 MLB games for the Twins, Pirates, Rays, and Diamondbacks. He also pitched in the Southern League for Pensacola in 2018 and Chattanooga in 2019, while they were affiliated with the Twins. On May 10, the Trash Pandas added LHP **José Quijada**, who hadn't pitched since spring training. Over four-plus years of MLB service, he holds a career 4.64 ERA in 140 games for both the Marlins and the Angels, with 172 strikeouts, 84 walks over 128.0 innings pitched. He was claimed off waivers by the Angels on February 10, 2020, after being designated for assignment by the Marlins on February 3, 2020. He has since served as a bullpen arm for the Halos. His 2023 season was cut short due to an elbow injury that required Tommy John surgery. After recovering, he returned in 2024, not allowing a run in 17 of 22 outings for the Angels, including a streak of 12 consecutive scoreless appearances (11.0 innings) between August 14 and September 18.

**MLB EXPERIENCE:** The Trash Pandas boast seven players on the roster with Major League experience after the recent additions. **Sam Aldegheri** made his MLB debut on August 30, 2024, for the Angels, vs. Seattle, and made three starts for the Angels over the remainder of the season. **Kelvin Cáceres** made his debut for the Angels on September 27, 2023, vs. Texas, and appeared in two total games that season. **Jesus Cruz** made his MLB debut for on August 18, 2020 for the Cardinals, and has appeared in eight games between the Cardinals (20) and Braves (22). **Jordan Holloway** made his MLB debut on July 26, 2020, for the Marlins, and appeared in 15 games (4 starts) for Miami from 2020-2023, posting a 3.29 ERA. **Sean Poppen** made his MLB debut on June 19, 2019, for the Twins and has appeared in 63 games for the Twins (10), Pirates (3), Rays (1), and Diamondbacks (49) since 2019, posting a 5.08 career ERA. **José Quijada** made his MLB debut for the Marlins on April 24, 2019, against Cleveland, and has appeared in 140 games for the Marlins (34) and Angels (106) since 2019, logging a 4.64 ERA and eight saves. The only position player with MLB experience is **Travis Blankenhorn**, who made his MLB debut on September 15, 2020, for the Twins against the White Sox. Overall, he's played in 49 career games for the Twins (2), Mets (24), and Nationals (23) since 2020.

**FIRST SERIES WIN:** The series win in Knoxville, April 29-May 4, marked the first series win of the season, and the first series win since June 25-30 at Chattanooga, winning four of six.

**APRIL IS IN THE BOOKS:** The Trash Pandas finished April with a 6-16 record, the lowest win total in April and a whole month in club history. The .250 winning percentage was the second-lowest in club history, trailing the .133 win percentage after a 2-13 September in 2023. Rocket City finished last in the Southern League with a .201 team batting average and 4.58 ERA as a pitching staff.

**THE YOUNG GUNS:** The Trash Pandas have three of the nine youngest players in the Southern League. For the second-straight year, OF **Nelson Rada** is the youngest player in the Southern League at 19.6 years old (8/24/05). INF **Denzer Guzman** is the eighth-youngest at 21.2 years old (2/8/04), and RHP **Walbert Ureña** is the ninth-youngest, just 14 days older than Guzman, born on 1/25/04 at 21.2 years old (1/25/04). Rada had a fantastic spring with the Angels, batting .333 over 11 games, a .370 on-base percentage, and six RBI. The Venezuela native spent the 2024 season in Rocket City, hitting .234 with 13 extra-base hits in 123 games. The 19-year-old was seventh in the Southern League with 35 stolen bases as the youngest player in the league. Guzman was promoted to Rocket City on May 7, collecting six home runs, nine doubles, and 30 RBI in 83 games. The 21-year-old from the Dominican Republic had his season highlighted with a walk-off grand slam on May 25, leading the Trash Pandas to a win over Montgomery.

**DARRELL-HICKS, QUERO, AND FERMIN LAUNCHED TO THE LEAGUE:** The Los Angeles Angels called up right-handed reliever **José Fermin** from Rocket City, becoming the 39th player promoted from Rocket City to the Majors. Fermin, third this season, and 13th to bypass Triple-A. Fermin was 3-0 record and a 1.13 ERA in six relief appearances this season, and was the first Southern League pitcher to earn three wins. A native of the Dominican Republic, he began his professional career in 2024 and advanced through the Angels' minor league system. The Chicago White Sox promoted **Edgar Quero** from Triple-A Charlotte, and he made his MLB debut on April 17 vs. Oakland. He picked up his first hit on April 18 at Boston. Quero, a 22-year-old switch-hitting catcher from Cienfuegos, Cuba, was acquired by the White Sox in a 2023 trade with the Los Angeles Angels involving pitchers Lucas Giolito and Reynaldo López. Quero skipped High-A and joined Rocket City in 2023. In 60 games, he posted a .242 batting average with 2 home runs, 32 RBIs, and 35 runs scored. His on-base percentage stood out at .378, thanks to 45 walks ... Former Trash Pandas pitcher **Michael Darrell-Hicks** had his contract selected by the Angels on April 6 but was optioned back to Triple-A Salt Lake on April 7. The Angels recalled Darrell-Hicks again on April 11 from Triple-A Salt Lake and made his debut that day against the Houston Astros. In his debut appearance, he pitched one inning, allowing four earned runs on three hits and issuing three walks ... He was 6-4 with a 1.73 ERA over 30 relief outings in 2024 for the Trash Pandas, earning eight saves in ten chances and 46 strikeouts to eight walks over 41.2 innings. Overall, Darrell-Hicks had a 6-7 record in Rocket City over 33 games and three starts, striking out 58 and walking 13 over 53.2 innings in 2023 and 2024.

**FONTENELLE'S CYCLE:** Not only was Cole Fontenelle's cycle on April 8 vs. Knoxville the first in Trash Pandas history, but it was the first in the Southern League since former Smokies star Moises Ballesteros did it on June 15, 2024, at Biloxi. Fontenelle led off each at-bat, which has only been done once in MLB history, by Todd Helton in 1999 against the Florida Marlins. The last LA Angels' minor league player to hit for the cycle was José Rojas, who hit for the cycle on May 11, 2018, while playing for the Double-A Mobile BayBears. Rojas completed his cycle with a grand slam in the eighth inning, leading the BayBears to a 14-3 win over the Mississippi Braves at Trustmark Park.

**SCHEDULE UPDATE:** The Sunday, April 6, game against the Chattanooga Lookouts that was postponed by inclement weather will be made up as part of a Wednesday, June 18, doubleheader when the Lookouts are back in Madison. The series will stretch from June 17 to 22 and now feature seven games in six days. Both games will be seven innings, with game one starting at 4:05 pm and game two starting roughly 45 minutes after the completion of game one.
