1-0: The fourth season of Fredericksburg Nationals baseball started strong last night with a 4-2 win over the Delmarva Shorebirds on Opening Night. Tonight in game two, the Freddie's will go for the opening series win behind RHP Marc Davis, who makes his return to the mound after missing all of 2023 with Tommy John surgery. He'll face off against Delmarva righty Blake Money, who pitched for the LSU Tigers last season before being drafted by Baltimore in the 12th round last summer. Davis's last professional appearances came in 2022 for the FredNats, where he made nine appearances and had an ERA of 3.97.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Jarlin Susana had a strong opening start, allowing just one unearned run in three innings with four strikeouts and no walks. Bryan Polanco came in and pitched well in relief, going four innings and allowing just one run. The FredNats committed four errors on defense and didn't do much offensively in the first five innings, but exploded in the 6th inning for three runs and four hits to take the lead. The offense added an insurance run in the 8th, and Merrick Baldo and Thomas Schultz pitched scoreless innings in the 8th and 9th respectively to close the door on the first FredNat win of 2024.

EXPERIENCED BUNCH: 24 of the 29 players on the FredNats Opening Day roster have appeared in at least one game for Fredericksburg in the past, including every member of the pitching staff.

FAMILIAR FOE: For the third time in the four years of the team being in Fredericksburg, the opponent weekend opponent is the Delmarva Shorebirds. Fredericksburg went 14-9 last year against the Shorebirds, 17-7 in 2022, and 11-25 in the inaugural season in 2021, which adds up to a 43-41 record including last night against Delmarva since the move to Fredericksburg in 2020. Delmarva swept Fredericksburg on Opening Weekend in 2021, and the FredNats took two out of three games from Delmarva on Opening Weekend 2022 in Salisbury, MD.

PROSPECTS IN THE 'BURG: Three of the Nationals' Top-30 prospects will begin the season with Fredericksburg. All three spent time with the FredNats in 2023, and all three of those prospects are ranked in the Top-10 in the system. Elijah Green is ranked as the 6th-best prospect in the system according to MLB Pipeline, Cristhian Vaquero is the 9th-best, and Jarlin Susana is the 10th ranked prospect. All three are also in the Top-10 in the Baseball America prospect rankings.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 142-120 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Frelich, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Alabama native and Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee.

Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Sier begins his second year with the FredNats and Nationals as a whole in 2024 after previous stops at Macomb Community College (Michigan), and ZSP Sports. Frelich will remain in the Performance Analyst role that was created in 2023 after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers. Meyer begins his seventh season with Washington and second in Fredericksburg after he spent his first five seasons with the Nationals at the Spring Training facility in West Palm Beach, FL.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TONIGHT'S START: Marc Davis is set to make his first start since July of 2022. Davis had a promising start to his professional career, as the right-hander posted a 3.97 ERA out of the bullpen in '22, while earning a Carolina League Pitcher of the Week nod as well.

JUCO BANDIT: Davis played three seasons at Florida Southwestern State, a junior college located in Fort Myers, FL. With the Buccaneers, Marc worked primarily as a reliever; 34 of his 44 total appearances came out of the bullpen. He recorded a stellar 3.14 ERA to go along with a 1.41 WHIP for his collegiate career, while striking out a whopping 14.55 batters per nine innings.

TWO-WAY TALENT: Davis was recruited as a two-way player out of South Gwinnett High School. He impressed scouts at the plate on the travel circuit, with exit velocities north of 90 MPH as a teenager, and displayed excellent range as a shortstop. Of course, he also possessed a rocket arm, and ultimately chose to focus on the mound.

Sthele made four starts with FXBG last season after being drafted in the 12th round out of Texas.
