**Lehigh Valley IronPigs RHP Mick Abel (3-8, 6.18) vs. Worcester Red Sox RHP Richard Fitts (6-5, 4.56)**

***We Resume Regular Programming*** – After an extraordinary day in the annals of WooSox history yesterday, the Worcester Red Sox return to some form of ordinary tonight when they play game two of their 6-game series against the Lehigh Valley IronPigs (AAA-Philadelphia) this evening at 6:45 pm. Yesterday the WooSox and their fandom welcome the top three ranked prospects in the Red Sox organization to Polar Park for the first time. While SS Marcelo Mayer (#1) did not play, OF Roman Anthony (#2) certainly made a strong first impression in his debut going 3-for-4 with a double, run scored, and several nice plays in CF while C Kyle Teel (#3) did not have a hit but was sharp behind the plate and was a perfect 3-for-3 in challenges using the ABS system for the first time ever. Anthony will lead-off again tonight and play LF while Teel will bat 5<sup>th</sup> as the DH. Mayer will not start as he continues to improve from hip soreness. The game can be seen live on NESN+ and heard on NASH 98.9 FM, The Pike 100.1 FM, and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network.

***20/20 Vision*** – Worcester has won 4 of their last 5 games and with a victory tonight they will return to the .500 mark in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half with a 20-20 record. The last time they were at .500 in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half came three and a half weeks ago when they were 10-10 on July 21.

***All for One*** – The WooSox have changed their fortunes around when it comes to 1-run games recently. Worcester has won their last four 1-run decisions since July 28 and are now 8-14 in 1-run affairs this season after dropping 14 of their first 18 1-run games.

***This Series*** - The WooSox are hosting the Lehigh Valley IronPigs for games tonight – Friday (all at 6:45 pm) and then over the weekend for games on Saturday at 4:05 pm and Sunday at 1:05 pm. This is one of just three homestands remaining for the WooSox this season (August 27 – September 1 vs. Toledo and September 10-15 vs. Syracuse the others). The Sox have 17 home games remaining and 19 road games left (including the resumption of a suspended game that will finish in Worcester on Sept. 10).

***What Have You Done For Me Lately*** – Worcester is 8-5 in their last 13 games after losing 7 of 8 games from July 20-27. The WooSox have won 6 of their last 10 home games dating back to July 12. Including tonight, 11 of their next 17 games will come at Polar Park through September 1.

***WooSox Batters Leading the Way*** – Worcester leads all 20 International League clubs in a host of team offensive categories. The WooSox lead the league with 651 runs scored, with 584 walks, with 80 hit batsmen (a new Red Sox Triple-A record), and with their .369 on-base pct.

***Runs in the Family*** – Worcester has the 4<sup>th</sup> best run differential in the league this season at +47 (651 runs scored and 604 runs allowed). Only Omaha (+110), Syracuse (+75), and Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (+67) are better.

***Welcome Back Casas*** - Boston Red Sox 1B **Triston Casas**, who will bat 3<sup>rd</sup> and play 1B again tonight, homered for the first time in his 9 rehab games last night going 2-for-4 with a double, HR, and 2 RBI. He began his injury rehab assignment with the WooSox on July 30 and in 9 games thus far he is hitting .294 (10-for-34) with 6 2B, 1 HR & 6 RBI. Casas, 24, has been on Boston's injured list since April 21 with torn cartilage in his left rib cage. He last played for the Red Sox on April 20<sup>th</sup> and in 22 games for the Sox this season he is batting .244 with 6 HR & 10 RBI.

***Hit Me With Your Best Shot*** – When Eddy Alvarez was hit by a pitch in Game 1 of Saturday's doubleheader at Syracuse he became the 80<sup>th</sup> WooSox player hit by a pitch this season which is a new Boston Red Sox Triple-A record. The WooSox are currently tied for 1<sup>st</sup> in the International League by being hit by pitch 80 times this season. The previous Red Sox Triple-A record for Most Hit by Pitch (by batters) had been 79 set by both the Pawtucket Red Sox in 2000 & tied by the Worcester Red Sox in 2022.

***August Moon*** – The WooSox are 6-5 thus far in August. They are batting .266 this month (91-for-342) with a 6.14 ERA (60 ER in 88 IP). Worcester has hit 12 HR and allowed 12 HR but they have been out-scored, 67-60 in August.

***Close But No Cigar*** - In games decided by one run or two runs this season, the WooSox are 15-29 (.341). When games are decided by 3 runs or more, the WooSox are 39-31 (.557).

***Road Hazard*** – Worcester is 25-32 on the road compared to 1-game over .500 mark at Polar Park this year with their 29-28 home record.

***Daydream Believers*** – Worcester has had more success this season in day games (25-22) than at night (29-38).

***Six Below*** – The WooSox are currently 6-games below .500 with their 54-60 overall record this season. On August 6 (at 50-59) - for only the second time in club-history - they had dropped to 9-games under. On July 27, for the first time this year and the first time in franchise-history, Worcester had fallen to 9-games under .500 (at 46-55). Worcester's low point last year was 6-games under .500 when they were 8-14 on April 26, 2023. Their low in 2022 was also 6-games below on May 15, 2022 at 15-21. And their low point in 2021 during their inaugural campaign was just 3-games under when they started 0-3. The Sox have been over .500 just once this season when they were 2-1 on March 31.

***Leading Lehigh*** – The WooSox – who lead the season-series over Lehigh Valley by a 9 games to 4 margin this year - have beaten the IronPigs 37 times in their last 58 meetings dating back to September 11, 2021. Worcester and Lehigh Valley began the 2024 season with a 3-game weekend series in Allentown, PA back from March 29-31 with the WooSox taking the series, 2 games to 1. Worcester went 5-1 at Polar Park vs. the Pigs from April 30 – May 5 winning games by scores of 12-5, 5-2, 4-2, 4-0, and 11-1 while Lehigh Valley's only victory during that series came on May 2, 7-1. The IronPigs took 2 of 3 from the Sox in Allentown from July 19-21

with the WooSox rolling, 14-3 in the opener before the IronPigs won the final two games, 4-3 in walk-off fashion and then 6-4 in the series finale. Worcester leads this current series thanks to their 4-3 victory last night.

**Stats vs. Lehigh Valley** – Sox pitchers are 9-4 with a 3.37 ERA vs. the IronPigs this season (43 ER in 115 IP) while WooSox batters are hitting .269 (115-for-428). Worcester has out-homered Lehigh Valley, 16-10 and out-scored the IronPigs, 77-44 in the 13 games.

**Where Things Stand** - The WooSox come into play today with a 19-20 record in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half and in 6<sup>th</sup>-place in the division, 3½ GB of Rochester who is atop the IL East with their 23-17 record. Columbus owns the best 2<sup>nd</sup> half record in the IL at 26-12.

**Series Matters** – Worcester is 7-8-6 in their first 21 series this season (7 wins, 8 losses, and 6 splits). Worcester finished 13-8-5 in their 26 series last season...13 winners, 8 losers, and 5 splits. The Sox went 8-3-2 in 13 series at Polar Park and 5-5-3 in 13 sets on the road.

**One is Such a Lonely Number** – Despite coming up winners in their last four 1-run games this season, the Sox are 8-14 in 1-run affairs on the season (still the worst mark in the league). Worcester is 7-15 in 2-run games this season. Last year the Sox went 21-24 in 1-run games and 13-10 in 2-run affairs.

**Second Half Adjustments** – The WooSox are 19-20 to begin the 2<sup>nd</sup> half of the season (the final 75 games from June 25 through September 22). Worcester went 35-40 during the 1<sup>st</sup> half good for 7<sup>th</sup>-place in the IL East and 11½-games in back of division champ Syracuse who went 46-28 and won the division. However, Omaha from the IL West had the best overall record in the first half and the Storm Chasers earned the one playoff spot as first half champs.

**Rankings** – Worcester is 7<sup>th</sup> in the IL in team batting with a .259 average while Lehigh Valley is 14<sup>th</sup> at .254. On the pitching side, the Sox are 16<sup>th</sup> in team ERA (5.16) while the IronPigs are 15<sup>th</sup> with a 5.15 ERA. Sox pitchers have allowed the 2<sup>nd</sup> fewest HR in the league (117) with only Nashville (114) giving up fewer. And Worcester is 3<sup>rd</sup> in the IL with 890 LOB.

**Streaks** – The WooSox suffered a season-high 6-game losing streak from May 22-28 which was Worcester's longest in over a year since a 6-game losing streak from April 9-14 of last season. Worcester's longest winning streak of this season was 4 in a row from April 14 (G2 of a doubleheader) – April 19.

**Comebacks and Last AB** – Worcester has 28 come-from-behind victories this season including 6 wins in their last at-bat of the game and 2 walk-offs. They have suffered 16 losses during the opponent's final at-bat.

**Goodbye to July** - The WooSox finished 10-13 in July after going 2-1 in March, 10-14 in April, 14-14 in May, and 12-13 in June. This July the WooSox batted .253 with 31 HR along with a 5.05 ERA while out-scoring the opposition, 129-122. Worcester's best offensive month was June (.284) and their best month on the mound was May (4.88).

**June Over** – The WooSox finished 12-13 in June. The team batted .284 in June with 30 HR – their best month of the year and the 3<sup>rd</sup> highest average in the league in June. Sox pitchers had a 4.99 ERA during the month with 26 HRA. Worcester out-scored their opponents, 160-137 in June.

**May Be or Might Be** - The WooSox rallied to win their final three games in May and finish the month even with a 14-14 record. Sox pitchers had a 4.88 ERA with 27 HRA in May while Sox batters hit .256 during the month with 42 HR.

**April Recap** - The WooSox finished 10-14 in April (after going 2-1 in March) while batting .244 with 22 HR. Sox pitchers were 10-14 with a 5.55 ERA with 25 HRA.

**A Winning Tradition** – The 2023 Worcester Red Sox went 79-68 to post a winning season for the third time in as many years of existence. Worcester finished with a 43-33 home record compared to 36-35 on the road last year. The 2021 WooSox went 74-54 during their abbreviated inaugural season while the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73.

**Finish Line** – In the overall International League Standings for the 2023 season, out of 20 IL teams, Worcester finished in 7<sup>th</sup>-place with a 79-68 overall record. In the 1<sup>st</sup> half standings last year, the WooSox went 39-36 while they improved to 40-32 in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half.

**You Need a Scorecard** – The 2023 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records as they made **271 player transactions** during the 2023 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used **79 different players** in 2023 (33 position players and 46 pitchers) to better the mark of 75 different players in 2022 (31 position players and 44 pitchers). Ironically, the 2021 WooSox set the previous mark of 72 different players (31 position players and 41 pitchers).

**Two Dozen to Go** - 25 different WooSox players were promoted to Boston during the 2023 season (not counting Red Sox rehabbing players) including Jarren Duran, Chris Murphy, Brandon Walter, David Hamilton, Wilyer Abreu, Ceddanne Rafaela, and many others.

**PORTLAND SEA DOGS (AA) UPDATE** – The 1<sup>st</sup>-place Portland Sea Dogs (25-12)/(61-45) won for the 16<sup>th</sup> time in their last 18 games last night thanks to a doubleheader sweep at Binghamton, 5-2 and 4-2.

In Game 1, Drew Ehrhard had a solo HR (#2) to tie the game in the 7<sup>th</sup> inning and added a 2-run triple in the 9<sup>th</sup> (extra) inning after Nathan Hickey's RBI double had given Portland the lead. Brendan Cellucci (5-2) was the winner with 4 scoreless innings of relief.

In the nightcap, Corey Rosier ripped an RBI double in the 3<sup>rd</sup> inning and an RBI single in the 7<sup>th</sup>. Theo Denlinger (3-3) was the winner with 3 shutout innings of relief.

**WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES** – The WooSox today added RHP **Brad Keller** following his optioned from Boston on Monday and then Keller signing a Minor League contract with the Red Sox.

**Keller**, 29, has recorded a 5.30 ERA (22 ER/37.1 IP) in 15 Major League games (two starts) this season for the Chicago White Sox (five games) and Boston (10 games). Signed by the Red Sox as a free agent on May 26, the right-hander also owns a 4.09 ERA (10 ER/22.0 IP) in seven games (five starts) with Worcester.

Worcester has used 71 players this season (31 position players and 40 pitchers). When Marcelo Mayer eventually makes his debut he will be player #72. The all-time Pawtucket/Worcester franchise-record is 79 players employed by the WooSox last year.

The WooSox have sent 20 different players to Boston since the season started (not counting rehab players). The list...INF David Hamilton, INF Romy Gonzalez, LHP Brennan Bernardino, INF/OF Bobby Dalbec, RHP Cooper Criswell, LHP Joe Jacques, LHP Cam Booser, C Tyler Heineman, RHP Zack Kelly, RHP Naoyuki Uwasawa, INF Enmanuel Valdez, INF/OF Jamie Westbrook, RHP Josh Winckowski, RHP Isaiah Campbell, LHP Bailey Horn, RHP Trey Wingenter, INF/OF Nick Sogard, RHP Brad Keller, RHP Chase Shugart, and C/INF Mickey Gasper. Those 20 do not include OF Rob Refsnyder, INF Vaughn Grissom, RHP Nick Pivetta, OF Tyler O'Neill, OF Masataka Yoshida, RHP Chris Martin, and OF Wilyer Abreu who were all injury rehab recalls from Worcester to Boston. Uwasawa, Dalbec, Heineman, Campbell, Westbrook, Grissom, and Keller are back with the WooSox, although Westbrook is currently designated for assignment. Jacques was claimed off waivers by Arizona and Wingenter claimed off waivers by the Cubs. The rest of those players are still with the Red Sox.
