Last Night: Lugnuts 6, Fish Fry's 4. **Pedro Pineda** and **Myles Naylor** homered for a second straight day and Naylor added an RBI triple, but **Jackson Humphries** struck out ten in five innings and **Tommy Hawke** and **Dean Curley** each went deep to help Lake County prevail

On the Air: Adam Jaksa and Jesse Goldberg-Strassler, locked in to the final day of the MLB Draft, deliver the call on mlb.streamguys1.com/lansing.

On Deck: The Lugnuts head into the All-Star Break, Monday through Thursday. The next home game is five days away, beginning a three-game mini-series July 17 through July 19 against the Fort Wayne TinCaps, which opens a stretch of nine home games in ten days.

Slump Busted: 1B **C.J. Pittaro** went 1-for-3 with two walks yesterday, ending an 0-for-20 schneid and collecting his first base hit since June 28, the Lugnuts' last home game.

Smiles for Myles: INF/OF **Myles Naylor** drew three walks yesterday, giving him eight walks in 10 games against Lake County this year. Naylor is slashing .353/.477/.618 vs. Captains pitching, with one double, one triple, two homers and two steals.

Vote for Pedro: OF **Pedro Pineda** went 2-for-5 last night and is 13-for-34, .382, in 10 games in July, with a .475 OBP and .676 SLG.

Cooperstown Bound: A member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** went on to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

Pinch-Skipper: Lugnuts manager **Javier Godard** takes his annual break this week – each member of the coaching staff gets one week off during the year – and is replaced as interim manager by **Tim Esmay** ("Ez-may") the Athletics' quality control and field coordinator. Esmay formerly served as the head coach at Arizona State University, taking the Sun Devils to four NCAA Regionals, two Super Regionals and the 2010 College World Series, then managed Winston-Salem in 2015, Great Falls from 2017-2019, and the Arizona Complex League A's in 2024-2025.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster has four players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of A's prospects: No. 15 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 17 (**Zane Taylor**), No. 22 (**Nate Nankil**) and No. 29 (**Nathan Dettmer**). Baseball America's re-ranking of A's prospects placed Echavarria at No. 16, Zane Taylor at No. 18 and **Nathan Dettmer** at No. 21.

Lugnut All-Stars: Among the 2026 MLB All-Stars are 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** (Toronto Blue Jays first baseman, A.L. All-Star starter at first base, who announced he will sit out the ASG, replaced by the A's **Nick Kurtz** in the starting lineup); 2019 Nut **Otto López** (Miami Marlins shortstop, N.L. reserve); and 2022 Nut **Mason Miller** (San Diego Padres closer).

Lugnut Future Star: 2025 Lugnuts shortstop **Leo De Vries** is the leadoff hitter today for the American League All-Star Futures Game squad, teammates with the fellow Athletics prospect / Midland RockHounds southpaw **Jamie Arnold**. De Vries competed in the Futures Game last year, too, when he was in the Padres' organization... and struck out on three pitches against fellow 2025 Lugnut **Gage Jump**.

Lugnut League Leaders:

- **Zane Taylor** leads the MWL in ERA (3.43), ranks 3rd in innings (76), 2nd in WHIP (1.28) and 5th in opponent avg. (.244).
- **Samuel Dutton** is 4th in the league in innings (75 2/3), 5th in ERA (4.76) and 9th in WHIP (1.50).
- **Steven Echavarria** is 5th in innings (75 1/3), 3rd in lowest average (.235), 5th in WHIP (1.39) and tied for 1st in starts (16).

Pitcher's Best Friend: The Lugnuts lead all of High-A with 86 doubles plays turned in 84 games.

JULY 12 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2015: Ryan McBroom had gone 5-for-5 at Dayton earlier in the season, on May 31st. On this day, he topped himself, going 6-for-6 to tie the franchise and Midwest League records, supplying three singles, two doubles and a home run, as well as a walk and four RBIs. But Argenis Aldazoro hit a walk-off RBI single in a three-run 13th to give the Dayton Dragons a 10-9 win at Fifth Third Field. The Dragons had previously rallied to tie the game in the 9th and 11th innings, with the Lugnuts blowing leads of 6-5, 7-6 and 9-7. In the bottom of the 9th, Paul Kronenfeld's RBI single brought in the tying run, but LF David Harris threw out Luis Gonzalez at the plate to force extras. What a game, even in defeat!

2018: Chavez Young hit a grand slam to erase a 6-2 deficit, and the Lugnuts defeated the Burlington Bees at Community Field, 11-8. Bees starter Oliver Ortega threw six wild pitches (one short of the league record) and struck out nine batters in 4 1/3 innings.

Last Time Out: Started the first game of this series, July 7, and suffered the loss after allowing six runs on five hits (including first-inning HRs from Dean Curley and Nolan Schubart) and four walks in 3 2/3 IP... 81 pitches, 45 strikes... Nuts lost, 8-5.

What a Year! As a senior at Westbrook Christian H.S., 1) threw four no-hitters, one a perfect game, as a senior, going 9-0, 0.40 ERA, 53 IP, 14 H, 5 BB, 117 K, and 2) batted .515 with .612 OBP, 4 HR, 39 RBI, leading Warriors to 2021 state title (first title in school history)... named Collegiate Baseball First Team All-American.

College - From Tiger to Tiger: Spent three years at LSU, one year at Auburn... ascended to Game 3 starter as true freshman at LSU in 2022, spent 2023 as reliever and was named SEC Academic Honor Roll (sport administration), majority reliever in 2024 (tossing 1 1/3 scoreless IP vs. Tennessee in SEC championship game)... transferred to AU for senior season and was named Second Team All-SEC (first Auburn player to earn All-SEC since 2018) and ABCA First Team All-Southeast Region... led Auburn in wins (7) and strikeouts (95), the most strikeouts for a Tiger since 2019... played with older brother Andrew at Auburn; Andrew had been at Birmingham-Southern for four years, forced to transfer when they shut their baseball program; he transferred in to Auburn for 2025 and blasting a home run in his only plate appearance of the year.
