Aybar's Stellar August... Nicandro Aybar drove in three RBI in Friday's 11-7 victory over the Winston-Salem Dash, his most RBI in a game since joining the Bowling Green Hot Rods on July 29. The 21-year-old is batting for a .351 AVG this month, good for third-best in the South Atlantic League.

Cermak's Charge... Outfielder Ryan Cermak leads all Hot Rods players with three home runs and eight RBI during this week's series. Cermak leads Bowling Green in runs scored (18), RBI (16), walks drawn (11), and homers (5) since rejoining the team on August 4.

Resetting the Record Books... The 2026 Hot Rods are up to a franchise-record 279 stolen bases this season with seven steals this series in Winston-Salem. The 279 steals surpasses the 2024 Hot Rods squad, who stole 262 bases.

King of Thieves... Infielder Tony Santa Maria logged his league-leading 52nd stolen base of the 2026 SAL season in Thursday's game. Santa Maria is one of just three South Atlantic League players to exceed 50 stolen bases in a single season since 2018.

Diaz Delivers... Outfielder Jhon Diaz became the first Hot Rods player to homer in three consecutive games since Dru Baker in August 2023. He begins Saturday's contest on a four-game RBI streak, his longest RBI streak since May 29 to June 5, 2025 with Bowling Green.

Flew Takes Flight... Nathan Flewelling returns to the line-up on Saturday night. The Tampa Bay Rays' No. 4 prospect has 21 home runs this season, tying 2018 Bowling Green backstop Ronaldo Hernandez for the most single-season home runs by a catcher in franchise history.

Harry's Hill... Rays' No. 21 prospect Trevor Harrison starts for the Hot Rods on Saturday. The right-hander has excelled against Winston-Salem, posting 13.1 innings without allowing an earned run in three career starts against the Dash. Harrison hurled eight strikeouts in his last game against Winston-Salem on July 19 at Bowling Green Ballpark.
