Welcome Back
The Fightin Phils begin the 2026 season on the road at the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. It is the only series of the season between the two teams, with Thursday being the first-of-three games, with all at 717 Credit Union Park in Akron. The Fightin Phils dropped five-of-six games to the RubberDucks in 2025, with all contests being played at FirstEnergy Stadium.

A Look Back
The Fightin Phils wrapped up the 2025 season with a 55-81 overall record, which included a 25-42 mark in the first half and 30-39 record in the second half of the season. It was Reading's second-fewest wins in a full-season in franchise history (53 wins in 2008). Despite the pedestrian record, there were still a ton of accomplishment on the field for Reading. In total, 19 players from the '25 R-Phils were promoted to Triple-A Lehigh Valley during the season. While no 2025 Fightin Phils made their big-league debuts last season, Otto Kemp ('24), Mick Abel ('22-23) and Robinson Pina ('24) all cracked the major leagues for the first time last year. On the individual side, Felix Reyes was named Eastern League MVP after capturing the league batting title with a .335 average and Aidan Miller paced the Eastern League with 52 stolen bases on the season. Reyes began the season with Lehigh Valley and Miller is set to be on the IronPigs' roster once he returns from the injured list.

Back at the Helm
Al Pedrique returns to Reading for his fourth season as the Fightin Phils' manager. Over his first three years, Pedrique has guided the Fightin Phils to 173 wins, which is good for ninth-most in franchise history. He also becomes just the fifth manager in team history to manage for four seasons or more, joining the likes of Reading legends Dusty Wathan, Bill Dancy, Gregg Legg and Don McCormack. Following the season, Pedrique was named the winner of the Phillies' John Vukovich Award, given annually by the Phillies to the instructor in their organization who embodies the characteristics of the award's namesake: loyalty, dedication, competitiveness, knowledge, honesty and a terrific work ethic.

Rounding Out the Coaching Staff
Marty Malloy makes the jump to Double-A and will serve as Reading's bench coach following a five-year run as the manager for Single-A Clearwater. Familiar face Brad Bergesen is back for his fourth season as the teams' pitching coach and he will be joined by Assistant Pitching Coach Alex Harter, making his Reading and Phillies' debut this season. Former big-league hitting coach Jeff Livesey takes over as the teams' hitting coach following a stint with the Harrisburg Senators in Washington's organization. The coaching staff rounds out with Position Coach Nerluis Martinez, in his sixth season with the Phillies and second in Reading.

Prospects on Prospects
Six of the Phillies top-30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline, are featured on Reading's Opening Roster. Headling the group are No. 6 Aroon Escobar and No. 7 Dante Nori; the latter of which is coming off an impressive run with Team Italy in the World Baseball Classic. The rest of the group includes returned Carson DeMartini (18), Alex McFarlane (19), Kehden Hettiger (28) and Bryan Rincon (29). Rincon will be making his Double-A debut tonight. McFarlane was added to the Phillies 40-man roster this past offseason and is the only 40-man player on Reading's active opening day roster.

Fightin to the Big Leagues
Two former Fightin Phils made their major league debuts this past week with the Philadelphia Phillies in Justin Crawford and Andrew Painer. Crawford, who spent the back-half of 2024 with Reading, is hitting .412 through five games so far, which included a walk-off single on Wednesday afternoon. Painter, a 2022 R-Phil, struck out eight over 5.1 innings in a win on Tuesday night. Other Fightin Phils alums on the Phillies roster include: Aaron Nola ('14-15), Alec Bohm ('19), Bryner Stott ('21) and Otto Kemp ('24). Former R-Phils on Triple-A Lehigh Valley's roster feature: Jean Cabrera ('24-25), Seth Johnson ('24), Griff McGarry ('22-23, '25), Andrew Walling ('24-25), Paul McIntosh ('25), Caleb Ricketts ('24-25), Robert Moore ('24-25), Cade Fergus ('24-25) and Felix Reyes ('25).

Celebrating 60 Seasons
2026 will mark this 60th season of affiliation between the Reading Fightin Phils and Philadelphia Phillies, a longstanding relationship that dates back to 1967. The R-Phils are tied with the Lakeland Flying Tigers, Single-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, for the longest affiliation in all of Minor League Baseball.

Quack Quack
Akron is coming off an impressive 2025 season, which saw the RubberDucks finish with a 77-60 record. Despite finishing with the second-best overall record in the Eastern League's Southwest Division, Akron did not qualify for the playoffs as they failed to capture the division crown in either half of the season. According to MLB Pipeline, Akron's roster has six of Cleveland's top-30 prospects: Angel Genao (3), Ralphy Velasquez (4), Khai Stephen (6), Alfonsin Rosario (15), Jacob Cozart (19) and Josh Hartle (26).

On the Mound for Akron
Righty, and Guardians' No. 6 prospect, Khal Stephen makes the Opening Night start for the RubberDucks. Stephen split his first pro season in 2025 between the Blue Jays and Guardians organizations, which included stops with Dunedin (A), Vancouver (A+), New Hampshire (AA) and Akron. In total, he went 9-2, with a 2.53 ERA over 22 appearances and 21 starts. Stephen struck out 110 over 103.0 IP. He was traded from Toronto to Cleveland on July 31, 2025, in a deal that sent Shane Bieber to Toronto. The 23-year old was drafted by the Blue Jays in the second round of the 2024 draft out of Mississippi State. Stephen pitched at Purdue in 2022 and '23, then finished his college career with Mississippi State in 2024.
