CARDS DROP 2nd STRAIGHT 6-1 DEICISON TO WIND SURGE: For the 2nd straight game the Cardinals tied a season low with just 3 hits in a 6-1 loss to the Wichita Wind Surge on Saturday evening at Riverfront Stadium. Leonardo Bernal picked up his first Double-A hit and went 2-for-4 on the evening and Nathan Church drove in the only run for Springfield with an RBI groundout in the 8th inning. The Wind Surge took advantage of an error to score 5 runs in the bottom of the 5th inning. Max Rajcic tied a career high with 9 strikeouts in his 22nd start of the season for the Cardinals.



DPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Pierson Ohl** makes his 13th start (19th appearance) of the season for Wichita...Pitched in relief in the series opener on Tuesday night and surrendered 3 ER on 5 H over 4.0 IP in Wichita's 4-3 win...In 4 relief appearances in August went 0-2 with an 8.53 ERA...Making his first start since June 25...Was on the Injured List from June 27-August 9...In 3 appearances (2 starts) against the Cardinals is 0-2 wiht a 7.80 ERA...Springfield hitters are batting .313 against him...Split the 2023 season between High-A Cedar Rapids and Wichita going a combined 9-7 with a 3.32 ERA, striking out 115 while walking just 18 batters in 127.1 IP over 24 apperances (21 starts)...Went 2-1 with a 3.52 ERA in 3 starts against the Cardinals last season...Spent the 2022 season with Low-A Fort Myers going 6-7 wiht a 3.53 ERA...Selected by the Twins in the 14th round of the 2021 draft out of Grand Canyon...Went 10-2 weith a 2.60 ERA while notching 7 CG in 15 starts as a junior at GCU...Named WAC Pitcher of the Year and WAC Tournament MVP...2nd team All-American by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper, GCU's first Division I All-American...24 years old

CARDS WRAP UP SEASON SERIES WITH WIND SURGE IN SIX-GAME SERIES: With just 3 weeks left in the regular season, the Springfield Cardinals head to the Sunflower State for a six-game series against the Wichita Wind Surge (Double-A, Minnesota Twins) at Riverfront Stadium. The Cardinals won 5 of 6 in Wichita in their first series in Kansas from May 28-June 2.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

ON PACE...: With 16 games remaining in the 2024 regular season, the Cardinals are on pace for several team and individual franchise records:

- » Springfield is on pace to win 79 games this season, which would eclipse the franchise record of 77 (2012 & 2017).
- The Cardinals have tied the franchise record for road wins in a season with their 38th on Thursday night, matching the record set in 2008.
- The current strikeout pace for the Cardinals pitching staff is 1,279, which would surpass the 2019 franchise record of 1,263.
- » With an average of .333, Bryan Torres is 12 points ahead of the Spring-field record held by Tyler Minges who hit .324 in 2005
- » With 24 saves, Matt Svanson is within 3 of the franchise record of 27 (Mark Worrell, 2006 & Chris Perez, 2007)

LONG, HOT SUMMER: The Cardinals are 33-17 since July 1, the best record in the Texas League during that time and tied for the 2nd-best in Double-A behind with the Akron Rubber Ducks (CLE) the Tennessee Smokies (CHC) who are 35-14. Springfield since the calendar flipped to July is 5-1-2 in series and has the best batting average below Triple-A at .273. The Cardinals have an ERA during that time of 3.80, which is 3rd-best in the Texas League. Through the end of June Springfield sported a 4.75 ERA.

RDAD WARRIDRS: For the duration of the 2024 season to this point, the Cardinals have been the best road team in Double-A. Springfield is 38-23 (.623) away from Hammons Field this season, a half-game better than the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (NYM) who are 37-23. The Cards have the best road mark in the Texas League by a wide margin; Frisco is 2nd-best with a record of 35-28 away from Riders Field.

CARDIAC CARDS: Over their last 17 games, the Cardinals have saved their best work for late in games. Despite trailing in the 7th inning or later in 9 out of 17 of those contests, Springfield is 12-5 during that time. The Cards have outscored their opponents 34-10 in the 8th inning or later.

HOLDING 'EM DOWN IN AUGUST: The later into the 2024 season, the better numbers the Cardinal pitching staff has put up. August has been the best month for Springfield hurlers to date, as the Cards are 3rd in the Texas League with a 3.37 ERA.

FOR STARTERS: Springfield's starters since August 1 have the 2nd-best ERA in the Texas League at 2.66, trailing only Midland (2.29). Over their last 11 games since the series opener against the Drillers last Tuesday at Hammons Field the Cardinals' rotation leads the circuit with a 2.34 ERA.

LOOKING FOR THE BIG HIT: Over their last 6 games, the Cardinals have scuffled with runners in scoring position. The Cards are 10-for-66 (.152) over since last Sunday and have scored just 16 runs during that time and has a record of 2-4.

MONTH OF TORRES: Among qualified hitters in the Texas League, nobody had a better month of August than Cardinals INF/OF Bryan Torres. Despite going 0-for-7 in his last two gaames, Torres is batted .418 in 23 games in the month with 8 2B, a home run and 12 RBI while compiling a .491 OBP and 1.029 OPS. He recorded multiple hits in 11 of his last 16 games and is a scorching-hot .471 (32-for-68) since August 10. The Texas League Player of the Week for August 12-18, Torres leads the league in hitting (.330), OBP (.418), hits (135) and is tied with Javier Vaz (NWA) in runs (73).

SLAM THE DOOR: Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. **Svanson** is a perfect 24-for-24 and his 46 appearances lead all of Double-A while his 24 saves is 2nd in MiLB. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 24.2 IP (0.36 ERA) and is 14-for-14 in save opportunities. **Svanson** has allowed just one unearned run over his last 19 appearances, allowing just 14 H with 19 K over 23.2 IP. The Cardinals are 51-1 when leading after 8 innings this season.
