






Visalia Rawhide (36-79)

LAST NIGHT'S GAME: The Quakes kicked off their final series of the season with a 5-3 win over the Visalia Rawhide. Rancho strung together three doubles in the opening frame to score a pair of runs, and took an early 2-0 lead. The Rawhide quickly cut the lead in half, as they pushed a run across with a two-out single off of starter Huei-Sheng Lin. The Quakes would increase their lead with three more runs in the bottom of the second. Rancho got an RBI double from Edwin Mateo, and held a 5-1 advantage after two. The Quakes offense was held scoreless for the remainder of the contest, and the Rawhide started to play their way back into the ballgame. With a solo home run from Neyfy Castillo in the sixth, and a run in the seventh, the Rawhide were down just two runs going into the eighth. The Quakes turned to relievers Ryan Sublette and Daniel Cruz to get the final six outs and secure the 5-3 victory.

YEINER FERNANDEZ: After playing in his first four games with the Quakes, Yeiner Fernandez has shown absurd production at the plate. Fernandez has tallied ten hits in just his first 18 at-bats. Fernandez has also produced multiple hits in each game he has played. Fernandez has also knocked in five RBIs and currently boasts a gaudy batting average of .556 through his first four starts. The 18-year-old catcher has quickly thrust himself into a key role in the batting order, and will look to close the season on fire.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK: The Quakes have now gone back-to-back with the Player of the Week award for these past two weeks. Jose Ramos has received the honor for his impressive series against the Inland Empire 66ers. Jose Ramos played in all six games of the series, and tallied 11 hits. Ramos put up a batting average for the week of .407 with three home runs, and ten runs batted in. Two of Ramos' home runs came in the same game, and the second one was a game-tying blast in the top of the ninth inning. Sam McWilliams won the award last week, and now Ramos has received his first Player of the Week award since joining the team in July.

QUAKES LOOKING FOR REVENGE: The Quakes have swept the Rawhide this season back in July. However, the Rawhide took the last series against Rancho four games to two. The Quakes will look to end the season with a series victory against a Rawhide team that has had a lot of turnover with the addition of multiple draft picks from the 2021 draft. The Rawhide are coming into the final series of the season riding high after a series win against the Lake Elsinore Storm.

SOUTH CHAMPS: The Quakes' 10-0 win over Inland Empire on Sunday night in San Bernardino clinched the 2021 South Division Pennant. Although this will be the first time since 2014 that the Quakes will miss the playoffs, winning the South Division is still a solid accomplishment to cap the 2021 campaign. Due to Covid-19, the 2021 playoffs were modified and will only feature a champion-ship series between the teams with the two best records, regardless of division, meaning San Jose and Fresno will meet for the pennant at the conclusion of the regular season in a best-of-five. The playoffs will return to four teams in 2022.

ROSTER MOVES: Relief pitcher Carlos Alejo was called up to Great Lakes of the high-A Central League on Tuesday. Alejo was 2-3 for the Quakes with a 6.03 ERA, but was important to them at the back of the bullpen, as he converted eight of nine save opportunities. This leaves the Quakes' roster at 29, but there are expected to be additional moves that will affect the pitching staff this week.

DODGERS UPDATE: The Dodgers took home an 8-4 win last night against their divisional opponent, the Arizona Diamondbacks The Dodgers now sit at 93-53, 40 games above the .500 mark. However, the Giants have won nine in a row after a 6-1 victory over the San Diego Padres. The Dodgers have secured a playoff spot, but the question still remains of who will win the division, and which of these two teams will have to fight for their playoff lives in the wildcard game.

JIMMY LEWIS: The Quakes will send Jimmy Lewis to the mound for his final start of the season. Lewis will take one more crack at securing that elusive first win of the season. The Rawhide are responsible for handing Jimmy Lewis two of his three losses on the season. Lewis has struggled in his three starts against Visalia, as he has given up seven earned runs over just three innings. Lewis has only gotten out of the first inning once against the Rawhide in his three starts.

JOE ELBIS: The Visalia Rawhide look to Joe Elbis to start game two of the series tonight. Elbis, has only made two starts this season since joining the Rawhide from the Arizona Complex League. Elbis has worked at least four innings in each of his two starts, including his last start against the Storm. Elbis went five innings and allowed one run on just three hits in that last start, and will look for his first win as a member of the Rawhide tonight.
