TODAY'S HEADLINES

LAST GAME'S RESULT - A close game turned into a blowout on Thursday afternoon at Huntington Park as the St. Paul Saints lost 10-1 to the Columbus Clippers. An RBI single by Jermaine Palacios in the second tied the game at one. Columbus got a solo home run from Will Brennan in the fourth to make it 2-1. The game remained that way until the last two at bats for the Clippers when they scored eight runs.

TWO WEEK EXCURSIONS: The St. Paul Saints are taking off on their fourth, two-week roadtrip in franchise history. They have the Columbus Clippers (who swept them at Huntington Park at the beginning of the first two-week roadtrip from May 10-15) and then head to Buffalo for the first time in franchise history. They are hoping to repeat the first two-week roadtrip in franchise history as opposed to the last two.

AND AWAY THEY GO: If you're showing up to the ballpark for a Saints game this season, it's best not to be late. Over the last five games and nine of the last 10, either the Saints or their opponent has scored a run in the first inning. The last time the Saints went back-to-back games where neither they nor their opponent scored a run in the first was May 23 and Game 1 of the doubleheader on May 25, both against the Indianapolis Indians.

GET BY WITH A LITTLE HELP FROM MY FRIENDS: Toby Gardenhire nears a nice, round number of victories as the manager of the St. Paul Saints. He currently sits on 98 victories and is two wins shy of 100 at the helm of the Saints. He has had some help along the way as Defensive Coach Tyler Smarslok has been the acting manager the last seven games as Gardenhire has been on paternity leave. Smarslok has amassed five victories for Toby in that time. There is a possibility Smarslok could be at the helm for the 100th victory as Gardenhire is not scheduled to be back until the team heads to Buffalo next week.

S-CAVE-NGING FOR BASES: Jake Cave doubled on Thursday afternoon to extend his streak of reaching base safely to 34 consecutive games. During the streak, which began on May 3, he has extended the streak courtesy of a hit 25 times and a walk nine times. The last time he didn't reach base was a five inning game on April 30 against the Nashville Sounds when he went 0-2

CA-NO RUNS: On June 15, Yennier Cano made his first appearance since being optioned back to the Saints. Prior to leaving he had tied the franchise record for consecutive scoreless innings at 12.2 IP. His 1.0 scoreless inning on June 15 @ Columbus gave him the new franchise record of 13.2 consecutive scoreless innings. Starter Charlie Barnes tossed 12.2 consecutive scoreless innings from May 24-June 8, 2021

EXTRA EXTRA READ ALL ABOUT IT: The St. Paul Saints have played 62 games this season and have an extra base hit in all, but one game. The lone game they didn't collect an extra base hit was the game they were no-hit on April 13 vs. Indianapolis. They have just one extra base hit in 10 games.

BAT IT LIKE BECKHAM: Since joining the Saints on May 28, Tim Beckham hasn't stopped hitting. He has hit safely in all 10 games played, which includes eight multi-hit games. He has an RBI in nine of the 10 games, is hitting .488 with a .563 on base percentage, .780 slugging percentage, for a 1.343 OPS.

DOUBLE YOUR PLEASURE, DOUBLE YOUR FUN: The Saints collected two doubles on Thursday and now have 121 on the season. That is tied for the most in the International League, tied for second in Triple-A, only behind El Paso's 131, and tied for fifth in all of Minor League Baseball.

JUNE BOOM: The St. Paul Saints continue to destroy the baseball in June. After hitting just 19 home runs in April, tied for 60th in Minor League Baseball and 29 home runs in the month of May, tied for 40th in all of Minor League Baseball, they have clobbered 28 home runs in 15 June games, tied for fifth most among the 150 teams in Minor League and 30 Major League teams..

BODACIOUS BABY: At 11:25 p.m. on Wednesday, June 9 St. Paul Saints manager Toby Gardenhire, and his wife Sarah, had their first baby, Bodie Gardenhire. Bodie is 8 pounds, 10 ounces. Both Mom and baby are doing great. Toby will be away from the team while he tends to diaper duty, cleaning up spit up and letting Sara rest as much as possible. Defensive coach Tyler Smarslok has been the acting manager since Thursday and is 5-2.

ANYONE SEEN OUR CYCLE?: For the fourth time this season, Alex Kirilloff missed out on a cycle when he fell a triple shy on June 14 @ Columbus. The other three times he has finished a triple shy are: May 18 @ Omaha, May 26 vs. Indianapolis, and June 3 @ Iowa. Jake Cave finished a double shy of the cycle on June 8 vs. Rochester. Royce Lewis was a home run shy on April 16 vs. Indianapolis. Mark Contreras was a triple shy on April 10 @ Louisville. The Saints have never had a player hit for the cycle in either their Triple-A or Independent League franchise history.

NEW JACK CITY: The St. Paul Saints set a franchise record with eight home runs on Sunday, June 5 at Principal Park against the Iowa Cubs. Spencer Steer (3), Alex Kirilloff (2), Caleb Hamilton (2), and Tim Beckham (1) did the damage. The eight home runs were the most ever, Independent or Triple-A, by the Saints since 1993. It was also the most in Triple-A this season and tied for the second most in all of Minor League Baseball in 2021. Only the Tulsa Drillers nine home runs, on May 17 at Amarillo, are more.

TWINS UPDATE - The Minnesota Twins had Thursday off and return to action on Friday against the Arizona Diamondbacks at Chase Field.

LAST APPEARANCE: 6/10 vs. ROC...pitched 4.0 innings of relief allowing two runs on two hits, giving up one home run, while walking one and striking out two...did not receive a decision in a 6-4 Saints victory.

APPEARANCE PRIOR:

RYAN EXPRESS: It seemed like a rather obvious choice. After goign 12-1 with a 2.45 ERA in 22 games (15 starts) and 95 strikeouts in 99.0 IP in 2015 for Single-A Hickory, Ariel Jurado was named the Texas Rangers Minor League Pitcher of the Year. The award he received...the Nolan Ryan Minor League Pitcher of the Year.

ALL I DO IS WIN: In that 2015 season, Jurado went on an incredible run winning his first 12 consecutive decisions. He won his first five starts of the year and then after that four of his next six appearances (he pitched 5.0 of one run relief on June 14). The longest stretch he went without a win was three consecutive appearances from August 6-18. Jurado had an opportunity for a perfect season, but in his final appearance on September 2 at Delmarva he gave up five runs (two earned) in 3.0 innings of relief to take the loss.

YOUNG BUCK: On May 19, 2018, Jurado made his Major League debut with the Texas Rangers at the Chicago White Sox. At 22 years, 109 days old he became the youngest Ranger to make a start since Martin Pérez (22 years, 108 days) on July 21, 2013 vs. Baltimore. Jurado went 4.2 innings allowing four runs on six hits while walking two and striking out two taking the loss.

THE CY ERASURE: In his second Major League start Jurado went up against Cy Young Award winner Justin Verlander on July 28, 2018 at Houston. Jurado allowed one run on two hits in 6.0 IP while walking one and striking out two. The former Cy Young Award winner, who would also claim the award in 2019, allowed two runs on nine hits in 5.0 innings. Jurado outdueled Verlander to pick up his first Major League win while Verlander took the loss. He became the first pitcher in Rangers history to win a start within his first two Major League appearances when the opposing starter was a former Cy Young Award winner.

NEGATIVE LAUNCH ANGLE: Getting the ball in the air against Jurado is a difficult chore. His home runs per/9 innings has been at 0.51 or less in five of his seven professional seasons. In his career, his HR/9 IP is 0.66. He gets 1.73 ground ball outs per fly ball out throughout his career.

OFF TO A RUNNING START: While Ariel Jurade nearly had a perfect record in 2015, he did have a perfect record in his first season in professional baseball. He went 6-0 in 2013 in the Dominican Summer League. He won his fourth game of 2014, his first decision of the season. His first loss of his career came in the 21st game of his career on August 17, 2014 @ AZL Indians.
