SPRINGDALE, AR – Left-hander **Anthony Veneziano** tied a career high with 10 strikeouts across 5.0 strong innings, but the Northwest Arkansas Naturals stranded the tying run on in the ninth inning and fell to the Corpus Christi Hooks, 5-4.

- Veneziano compiled his best start of the season, throwing 5.0 innings for the second straight start and fourth time in 2022. He allowed just one run on three hits and not only set his season-high, but tied a career-high with 10 strikeouts, a mark he set in July 2021 while pitching for Quad Cities (A+).
- The Naturals gave their starter early run support, as **Jake Means** blasted a three-run homer to left field in the second inning as part of a two-out rally, putting Northwest Arkansas up 3-0.
- Corpus Christi tagged Veneziano for a run in the third, then tied things up in the seventh on a two-run home run against reliever **Christian Cosby**, in his first appearance since being activated from the Injured List at the start of this week.
- The Hooks scored two more runs in the eighth inning off **Yefri Del Rosario**, then the Naturals countered in the bottom half with a solo home run to left field from **Logan Porter**, his fifth of the season and second hit of the game.
- Maikel Garcia** doubled with two outs in the ninth, his second hit of the day as well, but the Naturals could not bring the tying run across to force extras, as the Hooks took their third game of the series and the Naturals fell to 2-12 in one-run games this season, back to two games under .500.

THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

The Naturals are 7-6 all-time when playing on June 4

On June 4, 2019, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the Arkansas Travelers, 8-1 at Arvest Ballpark. After **Nick Heath** walked and stole second in the bottom of the first, **Khalil Lee** connected on his third home run of the season, a two-run shot that put the Naturals up 2-1, as they scored eight unanswered runs and held a lead the rest of the game. Shortstop **Taylor Featherston** and catcher **Meibrys Vilorio** each offered 3-for-4 days at the plate, with Featherston adding a solo home run in the eighth inning, the team's final run of the game.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 18 of the Naturals' 1828 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 10 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: **Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Noah Murdock, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave** and **Ángel Zerpa**.

GOING OUT ON A HIGH NOTE!

Prior to yesterday's game, left-hander Drew Parrish was named the Texas League's May Player of the Month, then subsequently promoted to Triple-A Omaha.

- In the month of May, Parrish started five games and went 3-1 with a 0.59 ERA (2 ER in 30.2 IP). He only allowed 15 hits and four walks, while striking out 29 opposing hitters. Among qualified Texas League pitchers last month, he pitched the most innings and had the lowest ERA and WHIP (0.62), while holding opponents to a .144 average.
- Parrish has made a league-best 10 starts before being called up, with a 4-3 record and 2.13 ERA (13 ER in 55.0 IP). He currently leads the Texas League in WHIP (0.82) and opponents' batting average (.160), as well as innings pitched, while ranking second in ERA and tied eighth in strikeouts (48).

EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring six runs or more, the Naturals are 21-4, while when scoring five runs or less, just 2-21.
- The Naturals are 17-5 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 6-20.
- The Naturals are 22-8 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 1-17 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 17-9, whereas 6-16 when the opponent scores first.

ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY

The Naturals are 2-12 in one-run games this season, meaning 12 of their 25 losses this season have been decided by just one run.

- Eight of the Naturals' last 12 losses have been by just a run.
- The Naturals have had the winning run at the plate in six losses this season (all one-run losses) and had the tying run at the plate or on base in 13 losses this season (including 10 of their one-run losses).

TUCKER BRADLEY: PROFESSIONAL HITTER

Tucker Bradley has acted as a second leadoff hitter for much of 2022 for Northwest Arkansas, batting 9th in the order for the first 34 games he's started of the 35 played, but that the bottom of the order is a spot he has thrived in.

- Bradley ranks among the top hitters in the Royals organization, with the fourth-highest batting average (.303) among qualified hitters in the system, also ranking fourth in slugging (.508) and fourth in OPS (.882), while fifth in on-base percentage (.374) ... he also ranks tied second in triples (3), ninth in hits (40) and total bases (67).
- Two of Tucker's five home runs this year have been grand slams, the first two of his pro career. He extended the Naturals' lead in the fifth inning on April 23 in Frisco with his first grand slam, then broke a scoreless tie to give the Naturals the lead in the fifth inning on May 13 vs. Wichita.

Yo, You WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?

Through 48 games, the Naturals have stolen *67 bases in 79 attempts* (average 1.40 steals/game, 84.81% success rate) and *pulled off a double steal 10 times*.

- 67 steals ranks third in the Texas League, fifth in Double-A and tied 26th in the Minors.
- Maikel Garcia's** 16 steals (in 18 attempts) ranks tied third in the Texas League and tied seventh in all of Double-A.

HE DID THE MONSTER (MICHAEL) MASHEY

Since the calendar flipped to May, second baseman **Michael Massey** has been one of the top hitters in the Texas League, as he hit at a .381 (37-for-97) average last month with a 1.016 OPS across 24 games, while recording a league-best 37 hits and ranking second with 29 runs batted in.

- On Sunday, Massey snapped a season-high seven-game hitting streak, with two or more hits in the first five games against Midland, but was named the league's Player of the Week for the second time this year.
- Michael has reached base in 37 of 45 games he's played this year, with already 18 multi-hit games, including seven in his last nine games.
- The second baseman is not just tied for the RBI lead in the Texas League, but all of Double-A too with 46 runs batted in, raking tied fourth in MiLB, while second in hits across the minors (63) ... among all Double-A hitters, Massey ranks second in hits and tied seventh in batting average (.333) ... he leads the Texas League lead in hits, ranks fifth in batting average, sixth in total bases (101), tied seventh in doubles (14) and tied ninth in extra-base hits (22).
- He is scattered all across the Royals' organizational leaders, ranking first in batting average and hits, tied first in doubles, second in runs batted in, extra-base hits, total bases, slugging percentage (.534), third in OPS (.914), tied third in home runs, third in on-base percentage (.380) and fourth in runs scored (32).
- Massey's turnaround at the plate truly began April 22, when he entered the day hitting just .213 and proceeded to homer in three consecutive games, April 22 to 24 in Frisco ... he went from having no home runs through the first 11 games of the season, to having eight in his last 33, leading the Naturals in homers.

GAR-SEE YA ON BASE

Shortstop **Maikel Garcia** has reached base in 42 of the 46 games he has played in this season, reaching base twice on 30 occasions, 16 multi-hit games.

- In 220 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 88 times (57 hits + 31 walks), for a .402 on-base percentage.
- Garcia has walked 31 times and struck out 37 times, a 0.84 K/BB rate.
- The shortstop places among the Texas League leaders in several categories, ranking tied third in steals (16), tied sixth in walks (31), seventh in hits (57) and tied eighth in runs scored (38) ... he ranks among the Double-A leader in steals (tied seventh), hits (tied ninth) and runs scored (tied ninth).
- His 14-game hitting streak between April 27 and May 12 is the longest on the Naturals this year and tied for the 15th-longest in club history ... it is also tied for the second-longest in the Texas League this season ... in those 14 games, he hit .397 (23-for-58) with six doubles and a .970 OPS.

PUSHIN (P)ORTER

Catcher **Logan Porter** has quietly flown under the radar as one of the top hitters in the Royals system so far in 2022.

- Among qualified Royals minor league hitters, Porter has the highest on-base percentage (.457), and ranks tied for first in batting average (.333) and OPS (.983) and third in slugging percentage (.526).
- Porter has reached base in 28 of 31 games he's played this season, with hits in 22 of 31 and 13 multi-hit games, nine of which came in May.
- In the month of May, Porter hit .343 (24-for-70) with a team-best 1.017 OPS and he had drove in 13 runs with 11 walks.

- May: LHP Drew Parrish ... started five games and went 3-1 with a 0.59 ERA (2 ER in 30.2 IP) ... only allowed 15 hits and four walks, while striking out 29 opposing hitters ... among qualified Texas League pitchers, threw the most innings and had the lowest ERA and WHIP (0.62), while holding opponents to a .144 average.

Players of the Week (2)

- April 25 to May 1: 2B Michael Massey ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.
- May 23 to May 29: 2B Michael Massey ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. He drove in nine runs as well, doubling three times with one home run, a go-ahead grand slam on May 24 and collected multiple hits in each of the first five games of the series.

Pitchers of the Week (2)

- May 2 to May 8: LHP Drew Parrish ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 7 @ Springfield ... held the Cardinals to just two hits and one walk while striking out four. He retired the first eight he faced and the final five, with five 1-2-3 frames.
- May 9 to May 15: LHP Drew Parrish ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 13 vs. Wichita ... held the Wind Surge to just three hits and no walks while striking out nine. Between the second and sixth innings, he retired 13 straight batters, retiring the side 1-2-3 in the first inning, as well as the third through sixth.

- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... In 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.

- Jirschle was originally selected by the Texas Rangers in the fifth round of the 1977 MLB Draft and played in 999 minor league games over 13-plus seasons in the Rangers and Royals systems.



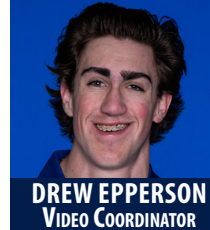
DANNY ACCOLA • CERTIFIED ATHLETIC TRAINER
