### "FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

**I-CUBS HAND SAINTS SECOND STRAIGHT DEFEAT:** A game that was 2-1 headed to the bottom of the eighth turned on its head yesterday at Principal Park as Chase Strumpf hammered a grand slam to centerfield to help the I-Cubs navigate past the Saints for a second straight day game victory, a 6-2 final. Following singles from Ryan Fitzgerald to leadoff and Emmanuel Rodriguez two batters later, Armando Alvarez knocked in the first run of the ballgame with an RBI groundout in the Top 1st. Iowa took their first lead on Greg Allen's two-run homer in the fourth facing Jacob Bosio, who took the loss for St. Paul. After entering Wednesday with just three home runs allowed in the first 13 games of the season, the Saints pitching staff have now allowed 10 in the past two games. Mike Ford touched off for his second home run of the season on a first pitch back to leadoff the ninth, cutting the deficit to four before the bottom of the order all struck out.

**WEIRD AND WILD GRAB BAG:** 1) In his first start of the year in the leadoff spot, Saints shortstop Ryan Fitzgerald went 2-for-2 with 2 HBP in 4 PA yesterday, becoming the first Saint this season to reach in every plate appearance of a game. His performance marked the first time in Saints franchise history that a St. Paul batter reached in all of their plate appearances in a single contest with the aid of two HBP's. 2) RHP Alex Speas threw 18 pitches in a scoreless frame yesterday, marking the first time he has ever pitched in back-to-back games in 130 career relief appearances (also threw five pitches and faced one batter on Wednesday). 3) After Jair Camargo failed to overturn a call at the plate yesterday, the Saints have now been incorrect on their last 13 consecutive ABS challenges (Armando Alvarez had the last successful challenge on 4/6 @COL).

**BACK, TRACK, WALL...YOU KNOW THE REST:** The 10 home runs allowed by the Saints the past two games in Iowa are the most homers the St. Paul pitching staff has allowed in a [two-game span](#) in franchise history. The Saints had entered Wednesday giving up just three homers (the fewest allowed in Triple-A at the time) in 110.0 innings through 13 games of the season, an average of 0.25 HR/9. The 10 longballs they've ceded in the last two games translates to an average of 5.6 HR/9, buoyed by the 8 allowed in Wednesday's game two, including 5 round-trippers hit in a nine-run seventh inning (both the runs and homers allowed were the most allowed in a single-inning in Saints history). The Saints now rank t-20th out of 30 Triple-A teams in total homers allowed, but the 2 HRA by the starting staff is tied for the fewest given up in Triple-A.

**THE FUTURE IS NOW:** This week's series in Des Moines pits two of the top-4 most "most talented, MiLB teams" according to Baseball America to open the season. The series features seven of BA's top-100 pre-season prospects, including two on the Saints (Emmanuel Rodriguez-#19 & Luke Keaschall-#43) and five on Iowa (Matt Shaw-#33, Cade Horton-#51, Moises Ballesteros-#57, Owen Caissie-#60, & Kevin Alcantara-#66).

**FORGET ABOUT THE CURVEBALL, RICKY...GIVE 'EM THE HEATER!** The Saints have crushed fastballs to begin the season and rank [4th in the International League](#) as a team by weighted on-base average (wOBA) with a .378 mark. The Saints are hitting .294 (80-272, 2nd in IL) while slugging .441 (7th in IL) with a 22.2% whiff-rate (4th-lowest) on the hard-stuff. Eight of the 12 St. Paul home runs have come vs fastballs so far this season. Conversely, the Saints rank 13th in team wOBA against non-fastballs (.275). Some of the Saints' best hitters against fastballs early are listed below:

**MCCUSKER MASHING:** Saints outfielder Carson McCusker is crushing the ball to open the season and currently ranks 3rd in Triple-A in average exit velocity to start the year (see below), averaging 96.3 mph on his batted balls in 2025. The 6-8 slugger has hit four home runs in the past seven games which is [tied for the MiLB-lead since April 9](#) and now ranks t-3rd in the International League in HR this season. His two-run double on Tuesday in Iowa registered at 111.8 mph off the bat, the fifth-hardest hit ball by a Saint this year. McCusker now has four of the top-6 hardest hit balls by a St. Paul hitter this season and five of the top-10, including a 114.2 mph single on April 2 in Columbus that ranks t-9th in exit velocity in Saints history. While his top-end exit velos are impressive, he's also consistently hit the ball hard, and [leads the International League with a 69.2% hard-hit rate](#), meaning nearly 70% of his batted balls are put in play at 95 mph or harder.

**WALKIN' DOWN THE LINE:** St. Paul's 82 walks drawn as an offense currently ranks 5th in the International League entering Thursday and the Saints' .362 team on-base percentage is third. The Saints have drawn at least two walks [in each game this season](#) and have taken four or more bases on balls in 11-of-15 contests so far this year.

**START ME UP:** The Saints starting rotation has gotten off to a tremendous start to the year, spinning a 3.15 ERA among starters that ranks sixth in Triple-A and fifth in the International League. If you throw out Andrew Morris' outing on Wednesday (7 ER, 3.2 IP), the Saints starting staff have a 2.24 ERA (14 ER, 56.1 IP). The rotation went off with a bang to start the season when David Festa, Zebby Matthews, and then Andrew Morris all went at least 5.0 shutout in three consecutive starts, the first time in Saints history that three consecutive St. Paul starters have done so.

**THE STARS OF TOMORROW, TODAY:** The Saints Opening Day roster features nine of Minnesota's Top-30 prospects according to MLB.com and ten according to Baseball America while also touting five of Minnesota's top-10 prospects on the MLB Pipeline list. The Twins prospects in the rankings include OF Emmanuel Rodriguez (No. 2, MLB.com, No. 2 BA), INF Luke Keaschall (3/3), RHP Zebby Matthews (-/4), RHP Marco Raya (6/8), RHP Andrew Morris (9/10), RHP Cory Lewis (11/20), INF Payton Eeles (23/17), RHP Travis Adams (22/22), C Diego Cartaya (24/21), & C Jair Camargo (-/23). Both Rodriguez (19/37) and Keaschall (45/60) rank among the top-100 overall lists of both publications.

**TWINS REPORT:** The Minnesota Twins have won three of their last four games following a 4-11 start after walking off the Mets 4-3 in 10 innings on Wednesday. Minnesota start a three-game series in Atlanta Friday night. High-A Cedar Rapids (7-5) are out to the best start among Twins affiliates even after falling 9-4 in Peoria last night. Twins' No. 14 prospect Billy Amick, a 2nd round pick out of the Univ. of Tennessee last year, has hit safely in seven straight after going 1-for-3 last night; he ranks 2nd in the Midwest League in average (.395) & OPS (1.092).

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Made his second consecutive start with St. Paul since being optioned, starting on Saturday against Omaha. Retired six-of-seven hitters to start the ballgame before running into trouble with a leadoff walk in the third and allowing three singles in the inning, a four-run frame that saw the Saints cede a 3-0 lead. Went 5.0 innings for a second straight start. Got both of his strikeouts on the four-seam fastball, but generated 6-of-his-10 swings-and-misses on the slider, throwing 35 total sliders, 32 four-seamers, 18 sinkers, and 11 changeups. Allowed 11 "hard-hit" balls (95 mph+), five of which went for hits.

**THAT'S MISTER SAINT TO YOU:** In 2024, Dobnak eclipsed several single-season pitching records for the Saints franchise. Both Caleb Boushley (134.1) and Dobnak (133.1) exceeded the previous record for innings thrown in a single-season (126.1 by Dobnak in '23), while Dobnak set new single-season franchise marks with 12 wins and 134 strikeouts. Dobnak still holds the single season mark for starts in a season, when he began 33 games on the bump in 2023, four more than Simeon Woods-Richardson's total that same season. Dobnak's 281 Career Strikeouts and 297.2 IP in a St. Paul uniform are both the most in the club's short Triple-A history entering 2025.

**KNOW ANY GOOD PIRATE JOKES? NEITHER DO AYYYYE:** Dobnak grew up a huge Pittsburgh Pirates fan and we would often go to PNC Park. His favorite food to get there was nachos with pulled pork and cheese. He finally pitched at PNC Park on August 5, 2020. The irony was no fans were allowed in, not even his parents. He tossed 6.0 shutout innings allowing three hits and striking out one.

**A BATTLE(R) OF WILLS:** You can be forgiven if you've never heard of the DII school that Dobnak attended from 2014-17. He spent four years at Alderson Broadbudds (WV) University, located in Philippi, a town of 3,380. During his time with the Battlers he finished his career as the conference's all-time leader in ERA (2.61) and strikeouts (284). In his sophomore season in 2015, Dobnak threw a no-hitter against Bluefield State.

**TWILIGHT SPARKLE, MEET BUTTERCUP:** Upon graduating from Alderson Broadbudds, Dobnak went undrafted and was looking for a way to continue his career. He got his break with the Utica Unicorns in the United Shore Professional Baseball League (a four team league where all four teams play in the same ballpark in Utica, MI near Detroit). He signed with them because he caught the eye of manager Jim Essian (a one time Cubs manager in 1981 & also played from 1973-84 in the Majors), whose son played with Dobnak at Alderson Broadbudds. Dobnak would become the only player to reach the Major League's out of the USPBL.

**THERE'S ALWAYS THAT ONE PERSON:** In order to make ends meet in the USPBL, Dobnak drove for Uber and Lyft. He began driving for both in October, 2017. His Uber rating was stellar, but not perfect. He had a 4.99/5.0 rating which meant he received all five-star ratings with the exception of one four-star rating. According to Dobnak, "I have one four-star. I'm hoping it was a mistake. I don't remember doing anything bad."

**NOTE QUITE MIKE ROWE:** Just prior to joining the big leagues, Dobnak worked as a consultant for Jordan Tax & Accounting Services in Bethel Park, PA (2017), an accounting clerk at Accountant and Associates in PA (2017), pizza delivery for Italian Village Pizza in South Park, PA (2012-13) and supermarket stocker at Foodland in Pittsburgh (2010-12).

**WE'RE BETTER THAN YOU, AND WE KNOW IT:** Dobnak got married to Aerial Munson on September 28, 2019, never thinking he'd be in the Major Leagues. He returned home after the Twins finished a series in Detroit and got married on a Saturday. He wasn't exempt from the rookie ritual of having to dress up in a crazy costume. He had to dress up in a Globo Gym outfit and flew commercial home instead of the chartered flight. He showed up to his fiancée in full attire.
