Welcome to the MWL: Southpaw Will Johnston makes his Lugnuts debut tonight, moving up from Class-A Stockton after striking out 26 of 46 batters faced. Johnston, selected in the 13th round from Texas A&M last year, is one of three 2023 Oakland Athletics draft picks on the roster, joining Will Simpson (15th round, Washington) and Colby Halter (17th round, Florida).

MLB Sensation: One of the best stories ongoing in the Majors is the emergence of 25-year-old Mason Miller, who made three starts for the Lugnuts at the end of 2022, debuted with the Oakland Athletics in April 2023, and is now the A's lights-out closer, going 8-for-8 in saves with a 1.26 ERA in 14 1/3 innings, posting a 29:4 K:BB ratio while limiting hitters to a .140 batting average.

Where There's a Will, There's a Way: 1B/3B Will Simpson went 0-for-3 with two walks yesterday; he has reached base in 20 of 21 games and leads the Midwest League in batting average (.366), is tied for 2nd in walks (21), ranks 3rd in OBP (.505), 1st in OPS (1.082), tied for 2nd in triples (2), 4th in RBIs (20) and 5th in slugging (.577). Last year, Daniel Susac hit .303 to become the first Lugnut since Bo Bichette (2017) to win the Midwest League batting crown.

League Leaderboard, Will Excluded: Colby Halter's 19 walks tie him for 4th in the league; Brayan Buelvas is 2nd in runs scored (21); and Buelvas and Henry Bolte are tied for 3rd in stolen bases (10).

Streaking: Jonny Butler has reached base in 15 consecutive games. The longest streak on the team is 17 games, belonging to Will Simpson.

Lighting Up the Scoreboard: The Lugnuts are 3rd in the Midwest League in runs scored with 129, trailing only the Great Lakes Loons (138) and Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (134). The Nuts are tied for 1st in the league in triples (9), 2nd in walks (116), 4th in the league in base hits (195) and 3rd in total bases (296).

A Grand Start: On April 3, Will Simpson crushed a grand slam (as well as a solo shot) in an 18-0 victory over Michigan State in the Crosstown Showdown. Ten days later, Simpson launched a grand slam off the Great Lakes Loons in an 8-5 loss.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster includes three MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in pitcher Luis Morales (No. 2), outfielder Henry Bolte (No. 10) and first baseman Will Simpson (No. 28). Morales was just activated off the Injured List and made his 2024 Midwest League debut last night; he is the top pitching prospect in the organization. Bolte, the A's No. 2 outfield prospect, was selected 56th overall in 2022 from Palo Alto High School, where he led all California high schoolers with 13 home runs. Simpson impressed with a .319/.367/.543 line in his professional debut after he was drafted in the 15th round from Washington last year.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2008: RF Moises Sierra had a rocket arm, as Wisconsin's Juan Diaz discovered. In the top of the 4th, Diaz singled to right but Sierra threw him out trying to stretch it into a double. In the 6th, Diaz walked and attempted to score on a Joseph Dunigan double, Sierra threw him out at the plate. Diaz was tagged out again on the bases in the 8th, thrown out by catcher Matt Liuzza trying to steal second base. The Timber Rattlers did win, 5-2.

2011: With a fire alarm going off at Cooley Law School Stadium in the bottom of the 10th inning, Jake Marisnick stayed calm against Lake County closer Clayton Ehlert. Marisnick lined an RBI single off the glove of third baseman Giovanny Urshela, lifting the Lugnuts to their first walk-off victory of the year, 4-3.

2015: Tim Locastro hit a three-run inside-the-park home run in the bottom of the 9th, but the Lugnuts lost to Bowling Green, 10-4.

2018: Kevin Smith, Kacy Clemens, Brock Lundquist and Chavez Young all hit solo home runs in a 6-2 Lugnuts victory over the Kane County Cougars at Cooley Law School Stadium.


