Today is the third of a six-game series at historic Modern Woodmen Park and the third of 12 meetings this year between the Lugnuts and River Bandits, who split a six-game season series last year in Davenport. The Nuts and Bandits have split the first two games of the series.

Yesterday: Bandidos del Río 6, Lugnuts 5. Ramon Ramirez and Davis Diaz played an incredible game of “Can You Top This?” Ramirez doubled Quad Cities into a 1-0 lead; Diaz homered Lansing into a 3-1 lead; Ramirez tied the score with a two-run homer; Diaz deked Austin Charles into an out at third base; Ramirez gave Quad Cities a 5-4 lead with a two-run double in the eighth; Diaz ended the inning with a diving unassisted double play, and then tied the game with an RBI single in the ninth. But Asbel Gonzalez had the last laugh with a game-winning RBI single with one out in the bottom of the ninth, giving Quad Cities the win.

LUG-NOTES

Prospecting: The Nuts’ roster has No. 8 (**Devin Taylor**), No. 15 (**Gavin Turley**) No. 16 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 19 (**Zane Taylor**), No. 26 (**Nate Nankil**) and No. 30 (**Bobby Boser**) on MLB Pipeline’s Top 30 rankings of Athletics prospects.

Shipped Up to Boston: 2024 Lansing southpaw **Eduardo Rivera** had a brief, rough time in the Midwest League (4 G, 2 GS, 11.88, 8 1/3 IP, 11 H, 13 R, 11 ER, 10 BB, 8 K). Two years later, Rivera made his Major League debut for the Boston Red Sox, tossing 3 1/3 one-hit scoreless innings of relief against the Yankees, walking none and striking out three in a 4-1 Red Sox loss. Rivera is the second former Nut to debut in the Majors this year and the 202nd all-time to reach MLB from Lansing.

Atop the League: The Lugnuts lead the Midwest League in base hits (144); committing the fewest errors in the league (7 in 576 total chances, .991 pct.) while turning the most double plays (21); and posting the lowest road ERA in the league (2.83).

Individual Excellence: **Davis Diaz** is tied for 1st in the MWL in doubles (7), 2nd in OBP (.508), 4th in batting average (.370) and 5th in OPS (1.095). **Bobby Boser** is tied for 2nd in base hits (19) with teammate **Devin Taylor** and is tied for 3rd in runs (15). **Casey Yamauchi** is tied for 3rd in home runs (4). **Zane Taylor** leads the league in ERA (1.26).

The Mighty Casey: Infielder **Casey Yamauchi** had two career home runs (one an inside-the-park home run) in his first 230 MiLB games before slugging four home runs in his last nine games, including one two days ago.

That’s Quality: Lansing starters **Jackson Finley** and **Steven Echavarria** have posted quality starts in each of the first two days of the series, with each allowing three runs in six innings. These were also the first starts of the season in which a Lansing pitcher worked into the sixth inning.

Patience is a Virtue: The Lugnuts have drawn 18 walks in the first two games of the series, five by **Justin Riemer**. The Nuts’ .365 team OBP ranks 3rd in the Midwest League, while Riemer has lifted his own on-base percentage to .490 (14 walks/24 times on base in 12 games).

All Aboard: Shortstop **Bobby Boser** has reached base in 15 straight games, reaching base 32 times (19 hits, 10 walks and three HBPs). **Davis Diaz** has reached base in 13 straight games: 30 times on base (17 hits, 12 walks, one HBP).

Milestone Watch: Lansing is 10 wins away from the 2,000th win in Lugnuts history and 3 players away from 1,000 players all-time.

Cooperstown Bound: 18-year-old **Carlos Beltrán** was in the first Lugnuts starting lineup on April 5, 1996. Over the course of his ensuing 20-year career, Beltrán was voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown, becoming the first Lugnut to be enshrined.

Miller Time: The most dominant former Lugnut in the Majors is untouchable Padres closer / 2022 Lugnut **Mason Miller**, not to be confused with Quad Cities southpaw **Mason Miller**. In 11 appearances spanning 11 1/3 scoreless innings this season, batters are 2-for-36 with two singles, two walk and 27 strikeouts. Miller has tossed 33 2/3 consecutive scoreless innings, bringing him within one inning of matching San Diego’s franchise record.

APRIL 23RD IN LUGNUGS HISTORY

2006: In four hours and 50 minutes, the Lugnuts outlasted the Beloit Snappers at Olds Park, 4-3, in 17 innings, thanks to Joey Metropoulos two-out RBI single. The score was tied 1-1 at the end of nine innings, with each team scoring runs in the 12th and 13th innings (including a two-out game-tying Anthony Garibaldi home run in the bottom of the 13th). Aaron Tressler fired the final five innings, allowing one run, to earn the victory.

2011: The Lugnuts and West Michigan Whitecaps combined to set a professional baseball record with 10 double plays, six by Lansing and four by West Michigan. The Nuts won, 6-1, wrapping up the victory when Rob Brantly lined into an unassisted double play to first baseman K.C. Hobson.
