**Today:** The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, and the West Michigan Whitecaps, High-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, play the second game of a three-game miniseries, the 14th meeting in a 21-game season series, and the 442nd all-time game between the two rivals.

**Last Night: Lugnuts 8, Whitecaps 1.** The Nuts tied the season high for margin of victory in an all around shellacking of the Whitecaps on Marvel's Defenders of the Diamond Night. 'Nuff said... but we'll say a little more: **Daniel Susac** led a 10-hit attack with a 3-for-4 showing, drawing a walk and knocking in three runs, **Euribiel Angeles** delivered a two-run single and **T.J. Schofield-Sam** singled, doubled and scored two runs in his debut. On the pitching side, bulk man **Jake Garland** limited the Whitecaps to one run on five hits in five innings, striking out five, and a trio of relievers faced the minimum with five strikeouts over the final three innings.

**On the Air:** Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jakska deliver the call via StreamGuys, while Dan Hasty and Nate Wangler are on Bally Live and MiLB TV

**On Deck:** The Lugnuts and the Whitecaps wrap things up tomorrow, enjoy a day off on Monday, and then the Nuts return home to welcome in the Great Lakes Loons in a six-game series running from July 18-23 featuring Wizarding Weekend at Jackson Field.

### LUG•NOTES

**Welcome to the Show:** The No. 1 prospect in the A's system and a Lugnuts standout last season, 1B/C **Tyler Soderstrom** became the 179th Lugnut to reach the Majors all-time and the sixth Nut this year to make his MLB debut, going 0-for-3 with a walk as the A's designated hitter last night. The 21-year-old Soderstrom was hitting .254 / .303 / .536 with 15 doubles, two triples and 20 home runs in 69 games for the Aviators.

#### A'round the Farm:

- \* RF **Lawrence Butler** debuted for the Las Vegas Aviators, supplying a two-run single in his first at-bat and finishing 1-for-3 with a walk in a 7-3 loss to Reno.
- \* SS **Max Muncy** debuted for the Midland RockHounds with an RBI single in his first at-bat, finishing 1-for-2 with a HBP. The standout performer, however, was pitcher **Joey Estes**, who struck out eight in 4 1/3 shutout innings in a 5-4 win over Tulsa. **Jonny Butler** added a double and a triple in four at-bats.
- \* DH **Brayan Buelvas** belted two home runs, 19-year-old **Yeniel Laboy** slugged one and 20-year-old 6-foot-7 lefty **Eduardo Rivera** fanned eight batters in six two-hit innings, but the Stockton Ports fell 9-8 to Inland Empire.

**Red Hot in July:** The Nuts are slashing .297/.333/.459 through ten games in July, averaging 5.8 runs per game. The hottest is **Daniel Susac**, slashing .424/.459/.545 in nine games, has 12 hits in his last 25 at-bats and back-to-back three-hit games. Susac is third in the league in average (.296) and tied for fourth in hits (79).

**Streaking:** OF/1B **Danny Bautista, Jr.** went 1-for-5 with a single, extending his hitting streak to 10 games (16-for-43, .372). It is his second 10-game hitting streak of the year. He has hit safely in 18 of his last 19 games.

**Two for the Price of One:** The Lugnuts' defense leads the league with 72 double plays this year, five more than second-place West Michigan.

**Historic on the 4th:** A crowd of 11,521 packed in to Jackson Field on July 4, the largest home attendance in Lansing since July 4, 2013. It was also the largest single game crowd in all of High-A, led alone the Midwest League, and an attendance larger than any crowd drawn by every Minor League Baseball team save for six Triple-A teams (Buffalo, Albuquerque, Salt Lake, Indianapolis, Norfolk and Round Rock) and one Double-A team (Frisco).

**The Cycle:** On June 21 at Wisconsin, **Jack Winkler** went 4-for-4 with a single, double, triple, home run and four RBIs, becoming the eighth player in team history to hit for the cycle. The other cycles: **Corey Patterson** (7/5/99 at South Bend); **Donnie Hood** (4/21/03 vs. Dayton); **Chip Cannon** (6/2/05 vs. Clinton); **Travis Snider** (7/7/07 at Fort Wayne); **Brad Glenn** (7/26/10 vs. Clinton); **Edward Olivares** (4/24/17 vs. South Bend); and **Ryan Gold** (4/18/19 vs. Dayton).

**They Know Their Trade:** Lansing has three players acquired via trade by the Oakland Athletics on its roster: **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); **Euribiel Angeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); and **Junior Pérez** (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo).

- The All-Star Game included three former Lugnuts in **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** (who won the Home Run Derby), **Bo Bichette** and **Jordan Romano**.

### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2009:** The Nuts hammered future Major Leaguer Tyler Chatwood for eight runs in the 2nd inning, including a Johermyn Chavez two-run homer, on their way to an 11-7 home win over Cedar Rapids. In the game, the Lugnuts were 8-for-14 with runners in scoring position and left only four runners on base.

**2019:** Griffin Conine, Johnny Aiello and Otto Lopez homered for the Lugnuts, but the Cedar Rapids Kernals hit six homers, including a Wander Javier grand slam in an eight-run fourth inning, in a 14-7 victory at Perfect Game Field at Veterans Memorial Stadium. Javier added a two-run homer later in the game, helping the Lugnuts dubiously tie their franchise record for most home runs allowed in one game. The Nuts ended a nine-game, ten-day road trip with a 6-3 record.

**Personal:** Brady's last name is pronounced "bass-o," with 'bass' like the fish rather than the instrument... got married during the 2020-2021 offseason after spending 2020 hiatus planning his wedding in addition to preparing for the 2021 season... made seven appearances for the Lugnuts in 2021 before suffering ACL tear... 687 days between MiLB appearances, June 15, 2021, and May 3, 2023, in returning from Tommy John... has tied professional high with four innings pitched in each of last two outings.

**Raising Expectations:** An MLB.com article from Athletics MiLB camp by Jonathan Mayo on April 28, 2021, carried a bit of surprising news on a couple of breakout pitchers, specifically, as Mayo wrote, "Brady Basso's role is changing. A lefty who signed for just \$75,000 as a 16th-round pick in the 2019 Draft out of Oklahoma State, Basso pitched almost exclusively in relief in college and threw well in that role in the Rookie-level Arizona League in 2019. Now that he's up to 95-96 mph with his fastball to go along with a curve that flashes plus and a work-in-progress changeup, he's going to get the chance to start." Melissa Lockard, writing for The Athletic on May 2, 2021, included Basso in her Lugnuts preview, writing, "Left-hander Brady Basso (2019, 16th round) opened a lot of eyes this spring with his fastball sitting at 95-97 mph."

**Pro Debut:** Brady pitched for Athletics Gold in the AZL after signing: 15 G, 1 GS, 1.64 ERA, 25 2/3 IP, 0 HR, 8 BB, 38 K... limited right-handed hitters to .194/.257/.313 in 74 PA, while lefties hit .250/.344/.286 in 32 PA... opposing base stealers were nabbed twice out of three attempts... made first professional start on 8/16/19, tossing three innings with 4 K's.

**Draft Day:** Basso was selected 494th overall in the 16th round of the 2019 draft from Oklahoma State... scout: Chris Reilly... signed for \$75,000... in the same round, two all-name players were drafted: the Tigers selected Kona Quiggle and the Blue Jays took Jackxarel Lebron... one of eight OSU Cowboys to be drafted in 2019.

**College Days:** Brady was primarily a reliever at Oklahoma State (12 G, 2 GS as freshman; 18 G, 5 GS as sophomore; 14 G, 0 GS as a junior)... after a rough sophomore season (8.27 ERA), rebounded as a junior (1.64 ERA, 11.0 IP, 6 H, 16 K)... majored in finance in Stillwater with the intention of becoming a financial advisor after his playing career ends.

**Let Your Babies Grow Up to be Cowboys:** Oklahoma State players in MLB have included Allie Reynolds, Robin Ventura, Jeromy Burnitz, Pete Incaviglia, Mickey Tettleton, Mike Henneman, Doug Dascenzo, Andrew Heaney, Matt Hague and Jordy Mercer... teammate Caeden Trenkle was drafted from Oklahoma State University in the ninth round last season.

**Baseball Runs in the Family:** Brady's father, Mike, played in the minors for nine seasons in the San Diego Padres system, 1986-1994, rising as high as Triple-A... after retiring as a player, immediately began managing in 1995 at age 30, and managed in the Padres' org. from 1995-2000... joined the Toronto Blue Jays and managed in the Jays system in 2003-2006 and 2009... spent the next decade as an MLB scout before being let go by the Pittsburgh Pirates in 2020.

**Hometown:** Hails from Pearland ("PAIR-land"), Texas, south of Houston... during senior year at Pearland H.S., posted 0.48 ERA, with 101 strikeouts in 57 innings... named All-District in football, averaging 29.9 yards per catch as a receiver with one primary route: go deep... also from Pearland H.S.: Kirk Dressendorfer, Clay Hensley and Robbie Weinhardt; Megan Thee Stallion spent her teen years living in Pearland.

**International Respect:** Mitch is ranked No. 3 in the world in the video game *Super Monkey Ball*.

**Hometown Hero:** Hometown of Lanett’s motto is “The Gateway to Alabama,” since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

**The Buc Starts Here:** Initially committed to University of Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).
