ROUGHRIDERS SWEEP DOUBLEHEADER IN SAN ANTONIO, BROOM MISSIONS IN SIX GAMES:

The Frisco RoughRiders swept aside the San Antonio Missions in a doubleheader on Saturday night, winning 4-3 and 4-1 from Nelson Wolff Stadium. The wins completed a six-game brooming of the Missions in the series. In game one, **Jack Leiter** started for the RoughRiders and went four innings, allowing just one run on one hit while striking out four and walking three. **Grant Wolfram** (2-0) earned the win for the Riders in his 1.2 innings while **Nick Starr** recorded a four-out save, his first of the season and the Riders MLB-best sixth. On the offensive side, Frisco jumped out in front early with a two-run double from **Dio Arias** in the second inning to make it 2-0. Leiter surrendered his only run in the bottom of the second to San Antonio (2-7) on an RBI groundout from Connor Hollis. In the third, the Riders added on when **Dustin Harris** ripped an RBI single and **Josh Stowers** lifted a sacrifice fly to center, putting Frisco up 4-1. The Missions tried to fight back in the sixth with a pair of tallies on a wild pitch and an RBI single by Hollis, but they came up just short. Thomas Eshelman (1-1) took the loss, despite throwing a complete game, for the Missions. Game two brought more early offense for Frisco as they took the lead first for the ninth time in as many games. Harris started the scoring with a sacrifice fly before Trey Hair laced a two-run double to right-center field to put Frisco in front 3-0. **Cole Ragans** was strong in his start for the Riders, allowing just one run in the third on a solo home run from Jorge Ona, and finishing after 4.1 innings with four strikeouts. Frisco extended their lead in the fourth on a J.P. Martinez RBI single ballooning their lead to 4-1, which was plenty for the bullpen. **Grant Anderson** threw 1.1 scoreless frames and Lucas Jacobsen recorded the save in the ninth. Missions starter Ryan Lillie (0-2) was handed the loss in his two innings.

KEEP YOU FRIENDS CLOSE AND YOUR ENEMIES CLOSER:

Through seven games, the RoughRiders have won seven of their eight contests by three runs or fewer. So, through those eight close wins the Riders have collected seven saves, the most in all of Minor League Baseball. Though Frisco is 8-1, their run differential is just +16, which is still good for best in the Texas League and tied for second best in Double-A.

YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT:

Over the last seven games, the RoughRiders have banged out at least 10 hits in five contests. Their 67 hits in the last seven games are more than 47 teams in MLB have all season. Overall, Frisco is hitting .290/.358/.399 to start the season, a batting average good for second in the Texas League and tied for third in Minor League Baseball. The Riders are also averaging 5.8 runs per game (fourth in the Texas League) while only hitting three home runs this season. Only the Northwest Arkansas Naturals (one) have fewer home runs in the Texas League this season, while the Springfield Cardinals lead the way with 11.

REARVIEW MIRRORS:

Since the 2019 season ended and the standings reset on September 3rd, 2019, the RoughRiders have not been in second place for 959 days. From the season-opening game in 2021, the RoughRiders held first place the entire season and have now been in first place for every game in 2022 as well.

STRIKE EARLY, STRIKE OFTEN:

The RoughRiders have scored first in every single game, leading to their 8-1 record. The Riders have plated 12 total runs in the first inning on the season, including seven in the first inning on April 13th at San Antonio.

OUT OF THE GATES:

After starting the year 6-1, the RoughRiders have had their best start to the season since 2016 when the Riders began the year 9-1. This is the third time in franchise history that Frisco has started 8-1 (2016, 2008). In 2021, the RoughRiders began the season 3-0 and raced to a 14-6 record through their first 20 games. The 2016 squad started 17-4 through 21 games and 23-7 through 30 games. After that, they struggled, going 40-69 the rest of the way, finishing the season in third place in the Texas League South.

WELCOME TO THE LEIT SHOW:

Rangers No. 1 prospect, RHP **Jack Leiter** was as-advertised on Saturday in his first start of his professional career. Over his three innings, Leiter whiffed seven while allowing just one run on one hit with two walks. The second-overall pick out of Vanderbilt in the 2021 draft, Leiter was a unanimous First-Team All-American in his final season with the Commodores while tying the NCAA lead in strikeouts on the year. The son of two-time All-Star and two-time World Series champ Al Leiter, Jack is ranked as the No. 17 prospect in baseball by MLB.com.

LOOK AT ALL THAT TALENT:

While Leiter headlines the top 30 prospects talent on the squad, the Riders back up him with plenty of players to watch. INF **Ezequiel Duran** slots in as the No. 4 prospect in the organization after the Rangers acquired him from the Yankees as part of the **Joey Gallo** deal at the 2021 deadline. INF **Justin Foscue**, who joined the club after sustaining an injury during spring training, is the No. 5 prospect. OF **Dustin Harris** is the No. 6 prospect after his incredible 20-20 campaign a year ago. Another trade piece, Harris came to the Rangers when they dealt **Mike Minor** to the A's in 2020. LHP **Cody Bradford** is the No. 20 prospect. Bradford, a former Baylor Bear from Aledo, Texas, led all Rangers farmhands in strikeouts last season while Kent finished third in the organization in strikeout rate (31.9%).
