NOTES AND NUGGETS

NEW (AND OLD) KIDS ON THE BLOCK

Omaha added 2 hitters to the team's offenses ahead of this week's series with Indy.

✦ Outfielder **Dairon Blanco** joined Omaha yesterday, on a Major League rehab assignment ... he landed on Kansas City's 10-Day Injured list on March 31 with *right Achilles tendinopathy* ... Blanco previously played 194 games with the Storm Chasers previously, between 2021 and 2023.

✦ Additionally, infielder **Peyton Wilson** has been promoted to Omaha from Double-A Northwest Arkansas ... the 66th overall pick in the 2021 MLB Draft out of Alabama, Wilson has been in Double-A since the start of the 2023 season and racked up 267 games with the Naturals, where he's slashed .268/.365/.418 with NWA ... Wilson currently ranks Top-10 among qualified Minor League hitters in on-base percentage, slugging percentage and OPS.

DON'T LEAD ME ON

Omaha has not held a lead since last Wednesday, April 23 in Toledo, and the Storm Chasers only led for 6 innings in last week's series to the Mud Hens.

✦ Over the final 4 games of the series, Omaha led for 0 of the 32 innings played, with Toledo leading for 25 of the 32 innings (78%) ... in the series as a whole, the Mud Hens led for 34 of 54 innings (63%).

✦ Going back to last Wednesday, the Storm Chasers have not led for a stretch of 49 innings ... after taking a 1-0 lead in the 1st inning in Toledo on April 23, the Mud Hens tied the game up in the 2nd inning, then took a lead in the 3rd and Omaha has played from behind or tied since.

GETTING SWEEPED UP IN TOLEDO

Omaha was swept in last week's series at Fifth Third Field, and yesterday's loss stretched the team's losing streak to 8 games (since April 19).

✦ A 8-game losing streak is Omaha's longest since an 11-game losing streak, August 1 to 12, 2023 ... that stretch also includes the last time the Storm Chasers were swept in a 6-game series, August 1 to 6, 2023 @ Louisville.

✦ Last week's series against the Mud Hens marked just the second time Omaha was swept in a 6-game series since the 6-game series were adopted in 2021.

✦ A .196 team average last week in Toledo was Omaha's lowest in a 6-game series since August 1 to 6, 2023 @ Louisville, when the Chasers hit .184 ... a .542 team OPS was the 2nd-lowest for Omaha in a 6-game series since 2021, trailing only May 10-15, 2022 @ Iowa, when the Storm Chasers produced a team OPS of .506.

DOWN, BUT NOT OUT

Comeback games have been a common theme through the first 25 games of Omaha's 2025 season, with 12 of the 26 games Omaha has played in this year being games where the winning team trailed at some point.

✦ The Storm Chasers have trailed at some point in 8 of 10 wins this year, with 4 wins where they trailed for at least half the game before coming back to win.

✦ Additionally, the Chasers have had a lead for at least an inning in 4 of the team's 16 losses ... in the 15 losses, Omaha has had a lead for a total of 13 innings.

WHAT A RELIEF!

Relievers stepped up lately for Omaha, including a bullpen game last week.

✦ Since Wednesday, April 16, relief innings accounted for 62.1 of Omaha's 94.1 innings, approximately 66% of the team's total innings.

✦ 32.0 innings from Omaha's starting pitchers across the last two weeks (12 games) are the fewest of any Minor League team since April 15.

✦ When accounting for the reliever Anthony Simonelli opening Game 2 of Saturday's doubleheader, Omaha's bullpen arms recorded 93 of the team's 148 outs last week (62%) ... the wee=outs (79%).

DUSTIN TIME

After joining the Storm Chasers two weeks ago and starting off slow, infielder **Dustin Dickerson** heated up last week at Fifth Third Field.

✦ Dickerson began his Omaha career 0-for-8 with 3 walks ... since the start of last week, Dustin has hits in 6 of 7 games with 4 RBI, a walk and sacrifice fly ... he had multiple hits in each of the first four games of last week's series before going hitless in Game 2 of Saturday's doubleheader ... he has hits in his last 2 games.

✦ In 9 games with Omaha, he is slashing .353/.439/.412 (12-for-34) with 4 RBI and 5 walks with only 5 strikeouts.

✦ His 12.2% strikeout rate is the 2nd-lowest among 16 Storm Chasers hitters with at least 10 plate appearances this year ... it ranks 14th among 224 International League players that have taken at least 40 plate appearances this season, one of 17 players with a 1:1 walk-to-strikeout ratio, or better.

CHANDLER CHAMPLAIN SCOUTING REPORT

MLB Pipeline

Scouting grades: Fastball: 50 | Curveball: 50 | Slider: 50 | Changeup: 45 | Control: 50 | Overall: 40

A well-regarded high school pitching prospect, Champlain honored his Southern California commitment in 2018 and stayed close to home. Three years later, the Yankees selected him in the ninth round of the 2021 Draft and then traded him to the Royals as part of a three-pitcher package for Andrew Benintendi in 2022. Champlain returned to Double-A in '24 and showed he had mastered it with a 3.50 ERA, a 0.92 WHIP and a 34.5% strikeout rate in seven starts. The move to Triple-A was more challenging; Champlain made 28 appearances (27 starts) there for a 5.61 ERA, 15.5% strikeout rate and a 1.56 WHIP while batters hit .283 against him.

Champlain's average cutting fastball sits 91-94 mph, touching 97 in 2024. He spins the ball well and has improved his upper-70s curveball into a solid weapon. That pitch is different from his low- to mid-80s slider which has good depth and got some chase in '24 in a limited sample. Champlain also shows a cutter, which could be an out pitch eventually because of his natural movement, and his mid-80s changeup is still a work in progress, as it has been for several years. The lack of a pitch against lefties has hindered Champlain as he's faced better hitters. He has some effort in his delivery which affects his command at times, but he showed up to Spring Training over 10 pounds lighter.

Champlain has the look and mentality of a workhorse on the mound and has proven durable in the Minors, throwing 135 and 140 innings the past two seasons respectively. But he'll need to develop a weapon against lefties for him to reach his ceiling, otherwise there's thought he would have more in the tank as a multi-inning reliever with a fastball-curveball combination. He wasn't added to the 40-man when eligible for the Rule 5 Draft, but he'll return to Triple-A, be part of the Royals' depth and could make his debut in '25.

Track Record: Champlain was off to a good start in his return to Double-A in his second full year in the Royals organization since being acquired from the Yankees midway through 2022. In seven starts with Northwest Arkansas, the most noticeable statistic was an impressive 12 strikeouts per nine innings compared to just 1.8 walks. His promotion to Triple-A Omaha proved to be more challenging for Champlain. His strikeout rate decreased to 6.2 per nine innings, his walk rate rose to 4.0 and opponents hit .282 with 17 home runs in 104.1 innings.

Scouting Report: Champlain's four-seam fastball comes to the plate on a downward angle, sits 92-94 mph and touches 97—but he struggled to command it when he got to Triple-A. His 76-80 mph curveball improved enough in 2024 to be graded a plus pitch. At times it looked like one of the better benders in the minor leagues and misses plenty of bats in the zone with 12-to-6 shape and great finish. The slider is a distinct pitch from the curveball, averaging 85 mph with good depth. Champlain rounds out his repertoire with an 85 mph changeup and 86 mph cutter, both still in development. There's not a lot of athleticism in his delivery, making it more difficult to repeat and affecting his command.

The Future: Champlain projects as a big-bodied back-of-the rotation starter, although his stuff would tick up in shorter stints if he moved to the bullpen. He was not added to the 40-man roster when eligible after the 2024 season.
