LAST NIGHT: Rocket City shortstop Jeremiah Jackson belted two homers and drove in three runs as the Trash Pandas won for the ninth time in 10 games with a 9-2 win Tuesday evening at Birmingham. Jackson started the scoring with a two-run shot to left in the first before Rocket City tallied four more runs in the second on RBI singles from Kevin Maitan, Livan Soto, and Zach Humphreys, as well as a sac fly by Orlando Martinez. The Trash Pandas added single runs in the third and fourth innings on an RBI triple from Maitan and an RBI double by Preston Palmeiro before the Barons got on the board with an RBI single from Jose Rodriguez in the fifth. Rocket City pushed across their final run in the sixth on a solo-homer by Jackson before Birmingham received a solo blast by Lenyn Sosa in the eighth for the final score. Rocket City pounded out 15 hits with Jackson, Soto, Martinez, Palmeiro and Teodosio collecting two apiece. Maitan finished 3-5 with a triple, two RBI and a run scored. Starter Adam Seminaris got the win by tossing by allowing a run on five hits over five innings. Reliever Cristopher Molina went the final three frames for the save for Rocket City.

PANDAS PARTY INTO PLAYOFFS: With their 7-2 win over Montgomery on Sunday, the Trash Pandas clinched the Southern League's first-half North Division title, taking a six-game lead over the Tennessee Smokies with six games remaining in the half, having clinched the tiebreaker over Tennessee by winning the season series 7-5. The Trash Pandas will now have home field advantage in the Division Series, set to begin on the road on September 20 before Game 2 at Toyota Field on September 22 and Game 3 (if necessary) on September 23. The Trash Pandas would also have home field advantage in the best of three Southern League Championship Series if they advance.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY LIVAN: Trash Pandas infielder Livan Soto celebrates his 22nd birthday tonight in Birmingham riding a hot streak. Over his last 29 games, Soto is batting .301 (58-193). He entered play on 4/20 with a .167 average, but now is batting .279 in light of his play. He finally belted his first Double-A homer after 193 plate appearances as a Trash Panda, ripping a three-run blast against Tennessee on 5/27. Known for his glove, Soto joined the Angels before the 2018 season from the Braves as part of MLB's punishment to Atlanta for their illegal signings of international free agents.

GOMEZ GOING GONZO: Quietly playing well for the Trash Pandas is utility infielder Jose Gomez. A longtime member of the Rockies organization, Gomez joined the Angels this past offseason to provide depth in the farm system. With an injury to Jeremiah Jackson keeping him on the bench for most of April and May, Gomez seized the opportunity, hitting .292 for the season with three homers and 18 RBI. He batted .320 for the month of May. He has at least one hit in 23 of his last 31 games, going 35-108 (.324) over that stretch

JUNE IS FOR JJ: After missing about eight weeks due to an abdominal strain, middle infielder Jeremiah Jackson (the number seven prospect in the Angels system) has shown why scouts are so high on him. Since 5/31, Jackson is 20-61 (.328) with seven homers and 18 RBI. He is batting .321 for June and belted six dingers with 12 RBI over a seven-game stretch from 6/14-6/21.

BULLISH PEN: A huge key to Rocket City's success has been the work of its bullpen. Specifically, co-closers Kolton Ingram and Eric Torres and setup man Luke Murphy have been especially tough. Ingram has posted a 1.29 ERA with four saves and 20 Ks in his last 14 innings of work with only one walk. Torres, meanwhile, has four saves and a 2-0 record in his last 11 innings with no hits allowed and 16 punchouts. Murphy leads the team with six wins and has not allowed a run in his last seven outings and in eight of his last nine appearances. In fact, in 18 appearances this season he has not allowed a run in 15 of them. Opponents are batting a paltry .045 against him for June.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER: RHP Mason Erla will toe the rubber for the Trash Pandas. After missing about eight weeks due to injury, Erla returned on 6/9 in game one of a doubleheader against Mississippi and tossed 3.2 innings of shutout baseball on two hits. In his last outing, Erla picked up his first win tossing five shutout innings on three hits against Montgomery with five strikeouts and one walk. This is Erla's first season of significant pro experience after appearing in only three combined games with the ACL Angels and Tri-City last season. Erla was selected in the 17th round of the 2021 draft out of Michigan State.

## WHAT IS A TRASH PANDA?

The name was chosen in a name-the-team contest and is a reference to the area's association with the space industry and the determination and ingenuity of raccoons, aka trash pandas.

Trash Pandas, slang for raccoon, was included in the original 10 nominations following several Brandiose-led focus groups in Madison and Huntsville. The ballot descriptor read: Our community is known for engineering, and no creature in our galaxy is as smart, creative, determined and ingenious a problem solver - dedicated to the challenge at hand - as our local raccoons!

In July 2018, after the results from several focus groups in Madison and Huntsville, 10 names were selected, based on their uniqueness and how each name relates to the characteristics of the area: (Alphabetically) Army Ants, Comet Jockeys, GloWorms, Lunartics, Moon Possums, Puffy Head Bird Legs, Space Chimps, Space Sloths, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas. The focus groups were led by San Diego-based Brandiose, the Minor League Baseball industry's premiere branding partner.

Over the next few weeks, two rounds of online voting took place. The first round narrowed the list to Comet Jockeys, Moon Possums, Space Chimps, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas.

Trash Pandas won the final round with 44.75 percent of the vote to ThunderSharks 19.25 percent. Moon Possums was third (12.57 percent); Space Chimps fourth (12.05 percent); and Comet Jockeys fifth (11.38 percent).

By the way, Trash Pandas dominated both rounds.

More than 28,500 nominations and votes were recorded. According to Brandiose, this represented - by far - the largest community participation in a Name the Team contest in the history of Minor League Baseball.

The team name was announced in a local microbrewery in September 2018 with nearly 1,500 fans on hand. Trash Pandas was nominated by Matthew Higley of Lacey's Spring, Ala. He received two box seats for the first five seasons and will throw out the ceremonial first pitch at a Trash Pandas home game.

The regional identifier was also chosen by the community. Out of 13,559 votes cast, 67.4 percent chose Rocket City over North Alabama (18.09 percent) and Madison (14.51 percent).



# NEW MILB RULES FOR 2022

Press Release From Major League Baseball - March 14, 2022

Major League Baseball announced a variety of experimental playing rules that have been approved by the Competition Committee and the Playing Rules Committee for use during the 2022 Minor League season. Consistent with the preferences of fans, these rules are designed to improve the pace of play, create more action on the field, and reduce player injuries.

Many experimental rules were first tested on a limited basis in 2021. The use of the most promising rules has been expanded to additional levels of play, providing more players and fans with exposure to the rules and allowing the Competition Committee to better evaluate the impact of each on game play. Below is a summary of the experimental rules that will be tested during the 2022 Minor League season:



**PITCH TIMER:** On-field timers will be used at all full-season affiliates to enforce regulations designed to create a crisp pace of play, with batters required to be ready to hit and pitchers required to deliver the pitch within allotted periods of time. With runners on base, pitchers will have additional allotted time for each pitch but will risk automatic baserunner advancement if a third pick-off attempt or step-off within the same plate appearance is made without recording an out. These rules were used in tandem in the Low-A West and in the Arizona Fall League in 2021 and led to a significant improvement in pace of play and a reduction in average game time of more than 20 minutes.

**LARGER BASES:** The size of first, second and third base will be increased from 15 inches square to 18 inches square at all full-season affiliates to reduce player injuries. Bigger bases were used in 2021 at the Triple-A level and in the Arizona Fall League, and were associated with a decrease in the severity of base-related injuries. In addition, the reduction in distance between bases led to a modest increase in the rate of successful stolen base attempts.

**DEFENSIVE POSITIONING:** In Double-A, High-A and Low-A, the defensive team must have a minimum of four players on the infield, with at least two infielders completely on either side of second base. These restrictions on defensive positioning are intended to allow infielders to better showcase their athleticism, to increase batting average on balls in play, and to restore a more traditional set of aesthetics and outcomes on batted balls.

He returned to Spokane in 2019 for his first season managing in affiliated baseball and led the Indians to the Northwest League playoffs after posting a 45-31 record. #### TRASH TALK

THE ERLA FILE: RHP Mason Erla will toe the rubber for the Trash Pandas in the second game of this six-game series at Birmingham in his seventh professional outing (sixth start). Erla is coming off his first Double-A win last Tuesday, tying a career high with five scoreless innings before Braden Olthoff finished a 9-0 shutout with four scoreless innings of his own. That marked the second straight shutout for Erla and Olthoff, who have combined to throw 16 scoreless innings in their last two outings. Erla made his Toyota Field debut in the first game of a doubleheader against Mississippi on 6/9 and tossed 3.2 scoreless innings before Olthoff finished with 3.1 scoreless frames of his own for a 7-0 Trash Pandas win. The Angels' 17th round draft pick in the 2021 draft out of Michigan State made his Double-A debut in the second game of the season at Birmingham on 4/9 and was brilliant, giving up one run on two hits with five strikeouts in the longest start of his professional career as Rocket City went on to win 3-2. Following that start, Erla was placed on the Injured List on 4/19 and was there for nearly two months before being activated on 6/8. For the season, lefties are hitting .107 against Erla while righties are hitting .235 against him.

<u>VS. BIRMINGHAM</u>: Making his fourth Double-A start, Erla will face the Barons for the second time in his career tonight. He made his Double-A debut at Regions Field on 4/9 and gave up a run on five innings with five strikeouts, leaving with a no-decision. Brent Killam went on to pitch the final four innings in a 3-2 Rocket City victory.

#### **MORE NOTES**

**PRO DEBUT**: He made his professional debut with the ACL Angels on 8/23/21 and pitched two scoreless innings with two hits and three strikeouts. He earned a win in relief in his next outing on 8/30 vs. the ACL Dodgers with three scoreless relief innings and six strikeouts. He was promoted to High-A Tri-City on 9/1 and made one start for the Dust Devils, giving up two runs, one earned, on two hits with two strikeouts to take the loss at Eugene on 9/15.

<u>COLLEGE CAREER</u>: Erla finished his five-year career at Michigan State with 243 strikeouts to rank third on MSU's career list, the most since Tony Bucciferro's 273 strikeouts from 2009-12. He became just the fifth pitcher in Spartans history to reach the 200-strikeout plateau, topping the 200-strikeout mark with seven strikeouts on 4/9/21 vs. Penn State. He began 2021 as a redshirt junior for the Spartans, where he earned the Robin Roberts Most Valuable Pitcher MSU team award for the second-straight season. For the season, he went 5-6 with a 3.50 ERA along with 80 strikeouts in 13 starts. The 80 strikeouts led the Spartans and tied for 10<sup>th</sup> in the Big Ten Conference, and he struck out six or more in 11 of his 13 starts. In 2020, he was named Big Ten Pitcher of the Week on March 10, 2020 and was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week on March 12, 2018. Between 2017-21, Erla made 48 starts for Michigan State, going 14-21 with a 4.03 ERA in 275.0 innings.

**SUMMER BALL**: In 2018, Erla appeared in one game for the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox of the Cape Cod League, getting the start and giving up four runs in 5.0 innings with five strikeouts.
