**SHELL SYNOPSIS...** On Sunday, Daytona fell behind early and never recovered. Lakeland struck first with a two-run homer from Cristian Santana in the second, added a run in the fifth, then broke the game open with a six-run sixth frame that featured a two-run inside-the-park homer from Woody Hadeen and a conventional two-run homer from Garrett Pennington. The Tortugas did scratch across a run in the ninth, but it was way too little, way too late, as the Flying Tigers breezed to a 9-1 victory.

**BATS GO QUIET...** Entering Saturday's game, Daytona's offense had scored 54 runs in their previous six games (eight runs per game), including four games with double-digit runs scored. However, the Tortugas went quiet in the last two games of the series, being shut out on Saturday and needing a ninth-inning tally on Sunday to avoid the same fate. Saturday's blanking was the first suffered by Daytona this year, snapping a franchise-record string of 66 straight games with at least one run scored. The last two games are the first time the Tortugas have been held to one-or-fewer runs in back-to-back games since scoring one run each on August 30-31, 2024 at Palm Beach.

**DUNO STREAKING...** Catcher Alfredo Duno was hitless on Sunday to lose an eight-game hitting streak, but he did draw a walk, extending his on-base streak to 14 consecutive games. In that span, Duno is slashing .391/.563/.587 with three doubles, two homers, 12 RBI, 17 walks, and 13 runs scored. That span included a tear from May 27-June 1 where he was named Florida State League Player of the Week.

**3 X 3 FOR SAMMY...** Infielder Sammy Stafura ripped a first-inning triple on Sunday, which adding to the baggers on Friday and Saturday gave him three straight games with a three-base hit. Stafura became the second player in Tortugas history to triple in three consecutive games, joining Aristedes Aquino, who accomplished the feat from June 23-25, 2016. Only seven players in the Florida State League have tripled in three straight games since 2005, the most recent being Jupiter's Mark Coley, who did so April 10-12, 2024.

**BIG MAC...** Catcher Ryan McCrystal did not play the previous road trip due to a minor injury, but he returns to the lineup tonight looking to extend a hot streak at the plate. After slumping for most of May, McCrystal has battered opposing pitchers over his current seven-game hitting streak, going 13-for-31 and slashing .419/.455/.774 with three doubles, a triple, two homers (which came in consecutive games), nine RBI, and nine runs scored.

**WHAT'S IN A NUMBER?...** For the first two months of the season, outfielder Malvin Valdez wore jersey #40 and struggled mightily, slashing .128/.259/.149 over his first 34 games of the season through May 30. However, on May 31, he switched to #20 (now available due to an injury to RHP Ty Floyd, who wore the number to begin the year) and that night he ripped a two-run double, breaking an 0-for-27 drought and driving in his first runs since April 11. In seven games since that date, Valdez is 9-for-25 (.360) with four RBI (out of seven for the year), four walks, and four runs scored. That span included his first three-hit game of the season on June 6.

**HENLEY STEALS 30...** Outfielder Kyle Henley stole two bases on June 5, reaching 30 stolen bases for the year and becoming the sixth player in Tortugas history to reach 30 steals and the first since Carlos Jorge stole 31 bases in 2023. Notably, Henley has reached that benchmark in substantially fewer games than anyone in Tortugas history. Here's how he stacks up to the all-time leaders and how many games they played in their historic seasons:

- Junior Arias (2015): 37 steals (46 attempts) in 99 games
- Jay Allen II (2022): 31 steals (37 attempts) in 73 games
- Carlos Jorge (2023): 31 steals (38 attempts) in 86 games
- Jonathan Reynoso (2016): 31 steals (42 attempts) in 112 games
- Phillip Ervin (2015): 30 steals (37 attempts) in 109 games
- KYLE HENLEY (2024): 30 steals (31 attempts) in 50 games

**HERE COMES KENYA...** RHP Kenya Huggins takes the ball for Daytona tonight looking to continue the strong pace he has set to 2025. The right-hander is coming off a start on June 4 at Lakeland in which he went 4.0 scoreless innings, allowing just one hit and one walk, while striking out three. Huggins has gone 4.0 innings in 10 of his 11 starts this year and in five of them he did not allow a run. Four of those have come in his last five starts, with Huggins allowing just three runs on eight hits over 20.0 innings (a 1.35 ERA) over that span of time, which dates back to May 11.

**A WEEK AT THE JACK...** Daytona returns to Jackie Robinson Ballpark for their first six-game series at The Jack since May 13-18 vs. St. Lucie. The last three weeks have seen Daytona play 15 of 18 games on the road, going 6-9 in the road contests, but going 2-1 in the lone home series, a three-game set vs. Jupiter May 30-June 1.

**MEET THE METS, MEET THE METS...** Daytona will welcome in the St. Lucie Mets this week, the third series between these two squads and the second at Jackie Robinson Ballpark. St. Lucie currently leads the season series 8-4, having won both series 4-2. With the first half winding down, St. Lucie is looking to solidify a first half FSL East Division title, currently leading Palm Beach by four games (St. Lucie and Palm Beach play four games to finish the half next week). This year, the Mets have scored 6.17 runs per game against Daytona, but have scored just 16 runs in their last seven games (2.29 runs per game) entering the series.

**TOP TURTLES...** A total of 12 Tortugas are ranked among the top prospects in the Cincinnati Reds organization and across Minor League Baseball. Here is how they currently stack up according to several key services:

Daytona currently boasts 6 of Cincinnati's Top 30 prospects by MLB Pipeline, 4 of Baseball America's Top 30 prospects, 3 of Reds Minor Leagues' Top 25 prospects, 5 of the The Athletic's Top 20 prospects, and 10 of FanGraphs' Top 45. Alfredo Duno was tabbed as the #29 prospect in MLB preseason by FanGraphs and debuted in the Baseball America Top 100 list in May.
