TODAY'S GAMES: Trailing the series 3-2, the Space Cowboys continue their seven-game series against the Round Rock Express... Today is game six of 13 in 13 days for the Space Cowboys as they embark on their second two-week road trip.

ABOUT FRIDAY NIGHT: Bligh Madris and Joe Perez hit early home runs to help open up a 4-0 lead for Sugar Land after 1 1/2 innings... The Express scored three in the 2nd and scored the tying run in the 4th... A bases-loaded walk in the 5th gave Sugar Land the lead, but back-to-back home runs for Round Rock in the 6th put the Express in front for good.

ROSTER MOVES: 6/3 - OF Rolando Espinosa promoted to Sugar Land from Fayetteville... RHP Jimmy Endersby placed on the Dev. List, retro to 6/1... 6/2 - RHP Tyler Brown promoted to Sugar Land from Corpus Christi... RHP Angel Macuare placed on the IL, retro to 6/1.

HOME GROWN TALENT: Sugar Land's roster has 12 players drafted by the Astros, 7 international signings and 2 player signed as non-drafted free agents in the five-round 2020 MLB Draft.

PROSPECTING: The Space Cowboys roster boasts seven of the Astros Top 30 Prospects according to MLB Pipeline. They include C Korey Lee (#5), OF Pedro León (#6), OF Justin Dirden (#7), RHP Misael Tamrez (#11), INF Joe Perez (#14), RHP Forrest Whitley (#19) & RHP Shawn Dubin (#23)

SERIES-OUSLY SPEAKING: Sugar Land is 3-5-0 in six-game series this year and 1-0 in three-game series... The Space Cowboys have gone 2-0-0 in their last two home series and 2-2-0 overall at Constellation Field.

BEGINNING WITH A BANG: Bligh Madris hit a lead-off home run on the very first pitch on Friday night, his sixth overall homer of the season... It was the fourth lead-off home run this year by Madris, who has hit in the lead-off spot 24 total times for the Space Cowboys. His lead-off home runs have come on the first pitch three times with the other coming on the second pitch of the game. When hitting in the lead-off spot this year, Madris is slashing .297/.405/.564/.969 with 5 doubles, 2 triples, 6 home runs, 17 RBI and 19 walks.

ON THE RECORD: RHP Joe Record has made 9 straight outings without allowing an earned run and picked up his second save in as many nights on Wednesday in Game Two, pitching a perfect seventh inning... In the month of May, Record made 13 appearances, giving up just 2 earned runs in 13.2 innings, converting 6 of 7 saves in that span... His 13 appearances were the most in the PCL and his 0.80 WHIP was the fourth lowest among pitchers that threw at least 10.0 innings in the month.

LEE-DING THE WAY: In the month of May, Korey Lee was T-2nd in the PCL in doubles (10), T-4th in Stolen Bases (7), T-6th in Hits (31) & 10th in Batting Average (.348)... He started June by collecting his 14th double of the year, tied for the third most in the PCL.

WHAT A WEEK: The Space Cowboys had the most prolific week for any team in MiLB this season during their trip to Albuquerque from 5/2-5/7, hitting .395 with 100 hits and 76 runs scored. Here is how their offensive output ranked compared to every other single-week high in MiLB.

GOING IN FRONT IN GRAND FASHION: On 5/13, for the second time in 8 games, the Space Cowboys hit a go-ahead grand slam in the seventh inning, with Rylan Bannon launching a grand slam. The grand slam capped a six-run frame and helped finish a comeback from 4-1 down to win 7-5... Justin Dirden delivered the other go-ahead grand slam on Friday, 5/5 @ ABQ, part of a 7-run frame that pushed the Space Cowboys over the top after trailing 8-2 going to the seventh.

GRAE ALL DAY: Grae Kessinger continues to get on base at a great clip for the Space Cowboys, reaching in 42 of his first 52 games with Sugar Land while recording hits in 33 of 52 contests, including 24 of the last 34... In the month of May, Kessinger slashed .323/.398/.525/.923 with 8 doubles, 4 home runs, 21 RBI and 21 runs scored... He led the Space Cowboys in hits (32), was second in total bases (52) and tied for second in RBI (21)... Kessinger came a triple shy of the cycle in Game 1 on Wednesday night, hitting his sixth home run of the season.

DOING IT WITH DEFENSE: The Space Cowboys have committed 35 errors this year, tied for the fewest in the PCL... Their .982 fielding percentage is tied for the seventh best fielding percentage in MiLB.

BIRTHDAY LAUNCHING POINT: Outfielder Pedro Leon turned 25 on Sunday and celebrated by blasting a solo home run... Since his birthday bomb, Leon has hit safely in five of his last six games, slashing .300/.333/.800/1.133 with a double, 3 home runs and 4 RBI... He's homered in three of his last six games as well.

DRIVING RANGE: INF/OF Joe Perez is currently sporting the best line-drive rate of his career at 30%, while also hitting the ball to the opposite field slightly over 1/3 of the time (33.9%). He's reached base safely in 10 straight games, hitting .333 (10-29) with a .425 OBP.

MOON WALKING: Sugar Land pitching walked 350 batters, the most in baseball (MiLB & MLB).

RECORD SETTING DAY IN ABQ: On 5/7 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys topped several franchise records in a 24-8 win over the Albuquerque Isotopes. They included:

- Most Hits in a Game: 30
- Most Extra-Base Hits: 14
- Total Bases: 60
- Most Individual Hits in a game: Korey Lee - 6

Sugar Land also tied the franchise record for runs scored in a game (24) and individual at bats, with three different players recording 7 trips to the plate.... This came just three days after Sugar Land had set new single-game records for doubles in a game (9), extra-base hits (13) & at bats (50) in a game on Thursday, 5/4.

GRAND DAY FOR DIRDEN: Outfielder Justin Dirden had a career day on 5/4 against ABQ, going 4-for-5 with 3 doubles, a grand slam, 6 RBI and 2 runs scored... The six RBI are a new career high for Dirden... The former SEMO Redhawk also tied two single-game Space Cowboys franchise records with three doubles and four extra-base hits. Dirden then hit a go-ahead grand slam on Friday night in a 9-8 Space Cowboys win.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: In the seventh inning on 5/5 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys rallied for seven runs, charging back from an 8-2 deficit for a 9-8 win. Justin Dirden delivered the go-ahead hit with a grand slam, his second consecutive day with a grand slam. It's the first time the Space Cowboys have hit grand slams on back-to-back days. The closest grand slams were the first and second slams hit in Sugar Land's affiliated history on 5/13 & 5/17 (G2) @ RR in 2021, both hit by Jose Siri.

MATJEVIC'S CAREER NIGHT: On Tuesday, 5/2 @ Albuquerque, INF JJ Matijevic re-wrote the Sugar Land Space Cowboys record books, going 5-for-6 with a double, 2 triples, 8 RBI and 2 runs scored. Since the Sugar Land franchise joined the affiliated ranks, Matijevic is the first player to record five hits in a game, surpassing the 17 times a player had registered four hits in a game, most recently done by... Matijevic on 4/5/23 vs. RR. His 8 RBI also establish a new single-game franchise record for Sugar Land, overtaking the 7 RBI recorded by Lewis Brinson on 8/3/22 @ LV. Matijevic also recorded two triples, the first player to record two three-baggers in single game. In the series finale on 5/7, Korey Lee surpassed Matijevic with six hits in a game.

UNA NUEVA Y DULCE IDENTIDAD: As part of MiLB's 'Copa de la Diversión,' the Space Cowboys will rebrand on multiple occasions in 2023 as 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land.' The name is to honor the Latino community's contribution to the foundation and growth of the City of Sugar Land, which are as real as the sugar that gives our hometown its name. The primary logo of 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land,' is vibrant and features a watermelon candy capped in a flame of chamoy and chili powder.

WHERE TO FIND US: Once again in 2023, all 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard on ESPN 92.5 FM (Gow Media). An audio streaming link is also available at sspacecowboys.com. All Space Cowboys games can be seen on MiLB.TV. Garrett Greene begins his first year as the 'Voice of the Space Cowboys' and will be on the call for all game, home and away. He'll be joined by longtime Houston area broadcaster Gerald Sanchez for home games.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his fourth season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his third with Sugar Land. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with two seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

TO INFINITY AND BEYOND: Key elements of the Space Cowboys brand include the Mission Patch, Horizon Gradient and Primary Space Cowboys Logo.

- **Primary Logo:** The primary logo features the Space Cowboy donning a traditional cowboy hat, a bandanna and a blast shield over his face that is peppered with space dust and has a starburst at the eye.
- **Horizon Gradient:** Inspired by a shot of the horizon of the earth from space, the color palette and gradient feature light blue, navy, orange, gray and black notes that are prominent in the franchise's logo and uniforms. The colors represent the ever-expanding Sugar Land community and an exciting new chapter on the horizon
- **Mission Patch:** This patch will be featured on all three uniforms and serves as an alternate logo. It intertwines elements from the Texas state flag, with a rocket superimposed over the front ready to launch.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

REST OF THE CREW: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Erick Abreu, hitting coach Aaron Westlake and development coach Wladimir Sutil. Abreu returns for his third season in Sugar Land as the pitching coach for the Astros' Triple-A affiliate. He's previously worked as the pitching coach for Astros affiliates at the Single A, Short-Season, Appalachian League, Gulf Coast League and Dominican Summer League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014. Westlake spent 2022 as the hitting coach in Double-A Corpus Christi and worked as a development coach for the Florida Gulf Coast League Astros in 2021. Sutil enters his second season on the Space Cowboys staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

AGAINST ROUND ROCK: Despite making 22 appearances with Salt Lake in 2016 and 11 appearances with Fresno in 2019, this is McGowin's first appearance in his career against Round Rock.

LAST TIME OUT: Started on Sunday evening for the Space Cowboys against the Bees at Constellation Field... Allowed a lead-off single, then retired the next 13 hitters in a row... Gave up one run on a solo home run in the fifth... Surrendered one run in the sixth before being replaced by Austin Hansen with two outs... Picked up the victory in a 5-4 Space Cowboys win.

WELCOME TO THE 'STROS: Signed by the Astros as a free agent on May 8 and assigned to Sugar Land... Had elected free agency following the 2021 season, did not pitch in 2022.

QUITE AN IMPRESSION: Was the opening day starter for the Staten Island FerryHawks of the independent Atlantic League on April 28, 2023 against the Charleston Dirty Birds... Threw 5.0 hitless innings, allowing just one base runner on a hit-by-pitch.... Struck out 11 on 67 pitches, 49 strikes.

IN THE CARDS: Owner of "World Champion Sports Cards." Helped organize the first ever Palm Beach Card Show at the Palm Beach Convention Center in January of 2023.

WITH THE NATIONALS: Has made 48 career appearances, two starts, at the Major League level... Amassed a career ERA of 5.98 with two holds and two save in two save chances... Across 64.2 innings with Washington, walked 28 and struck out 77, holding opponents to a .231 batting average against.

DEBUT SZN: Made his Major League debut with the Nationals on September 5, 2018... Appeared in five games, one start, going 0-0, 5.87 ERA in 7.2 innings.

MR. MCGOWIN GOES TO WASHINGTON: Traded from the Angels to the Nationals, along with RHP Austin Adams, in exchange for 2B Danny Espinosa on 12/10/2016... At the time of the trade, was rated as the #20 prospect in the Angels organization by MLB.com

PCL PRIOR EXPERIENCE: Made 22 starts with the Salt Lake Bees in 2016, going 6-12 with a 6.11 ERA, hurling 116.1 innings.... Also made 11 starts for Triple-A Fresno in 2019, going 7-2 with a 3.86 ERA.

LA LA LAND: Was selected in the 5th round of the 2013 draft by the Los Angeles Angels out of Savannah State University.

LAST TIME OUT: Entered with the bases loaded and two outs in the sixth inning on Sunday night... Issued a walk to force in a run but left the tying run at second base... Gave up one run in the seventh but retired seven in a row and eight of the final nine he faced to pick up a 3.1 inning save.

BACK IN THE SADDLE: On Opening Night, Hansen started for the Space Cowboys and went 3.1 innings... It was his first appearance since August 5, 2021 at Round Rock... The righty missed the entire 2022 season while recovering from Tommy John Surgery

IN SPRING: Appeared three times for the Astros in Spring Training in West Palm, all three in relief... Went 0-0, 4.76 ERA, allowing three runs in 5.2 innings pitched with four walks and five strikeouts... All three of his outings were over 1.0 IP (1.2, 1.1, 2.2)... In his final outing of Spring Training, spun 2.2 scoreless innings, giving up two hits and two walks while striking out two.

DOUBLE DIGITS: Hansen recorded his two 10+ strikeouts in a game during the 2019 season... The first came in his first start of 2019 when Hansen struck out a career-best 11 batters in 5.0 scoreless innings on April 9... He then struck out 10 hitters on May 6, 2019 @ Lansing, giving up just one hit and two walks across a career-best 7.0 frames.

HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR: The righty was named a New-York Penn League Midseason All-Star in 2018 before earning a Midwest League Midseason All-Star nod in 2019.

VALLEYCATS STRIKE: Hansen had an impressive professional debut with the then Class-A Short Season Tri-City ValleyCats, posting a 1.76 ERA with 45 strikeouts in 14 appearances, all but two in relief, spanning 30.2 innings.
