SEVEN-RUN NORFOLK 10TH SINKS SHRIMP

Devvison De Los Santos homered on Thursday, but the Tides scored seven runs in the 10th inning to beat the Jumbo Shrimp 12-7. The game seesawed in the early portion, but once De Los Santos tied things with a two-run shot in the seventh, remained deadlocked at five through regulation. However, in the 10th, Norfolk plated seven runs. Jacksonville mustered two in the bottom of the 10th to get the final score to 12-7. The Shrimp left at least one runner on base in nine of their 10 at-bats, finishing with 12 runners stranded, tied for their seventh-most in a game this year.

IT GETS LATE EARLY OUT HERE

Over the last nine games, Jacksonville's offense has really struggled against opposing bullpens. The relief corps of both Nashville and Norfolk have combined to surrender only 11 runs, 10 earned, on 21 hits (5.3 H/9) in 36.0 innings (2.50 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB) against the Jumbo Shrimp over this nine-game run. From the sixth inning on during this stretch, Jacksonville is a woeful 21-for-113 (.186) at the plate, scratching across only 10 runs in 28 innings.

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled this season at 121 Financial Ballpark, mustering a meager 29-36 (.446) record. Jacksonville has scored only 276 runs at home (4.2 per game), the fewest in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp are scoring about a half-run more per game on the road, totaling 295 (4.8 per game). Meanwhile, also on the road, Jacksonville has surrendered only 277 runs (4.5 per game), tied for the second-fewest in Triple-A. They've yielded the 11th-fewest runs of any team at home (324, 5.0 per game). Thus, their run differential is +18 on the road, but -48 at 121 Financial Ballpark.

WHEN THERE'S A WILL. THERE'S A WAY

Jacksonville catcher **Will Banfield** suffered through a disastrous 10-game stretch from May 30 through June 14, going 0-for-36 at the plate. In the 35 games since then, however, the Snellville, Ga. native completely turned his season around. Since this stretch began with a three-hit game on June 16, Banfield is 38-for-125, slashing .304/.348/.488/.836 with six doubles, one triple, five home runs, 22 RBIs, nine walks and 19 runs scored.

STRAIGHT AND NARROW

Of Jacksonville's 11 wins during the month of August, eight have come by three runs or fewer, including six by just one run. The Jumbo Shrimp have played in 44 games this season decided by one run (20-24), tied with Iowa (26-18) for the most in the International League. Jacksonville registered 85 contests (57.0 percent of total games, 39-46, .459) contests decided by three runs or fewer during the 2023 season. In 2024, their 81 games this season determined by these narrow margins represents 63.8 percent of the club's 127 games played thus far in 2024. The Jumbo Shrimp are 41-40 (.506) in those tightly-decided contests.

BE STILL, MY BEATING START

Jumbo Shrimp starting pitching has picked up considerably over the last eight games, beginning in the midst of their set at Nashville. During this eight-game stretch, Jacksonville lid-lifters have combined to yield only 16 runs, 12 earned, on 28 hits (5.9 H/9) in 43.0 innings for a 2.51 ERA. Over this span, the Jumbo Shrimp starting rotation has combined for 47 strikeouts (9.8 K/9) against only nine walks (1.5 BB/9). Jumbo Shrimp starters have yielded three earned runs or fewer in all eight of these games, with shutout performances in two contests.

LADIFS FIRST

When Norfolk scored the game's first run on Thursday against Jacksonville, it marked the 14th consecutive home game for the Jumbo Shrimp in which the visiting team scored first. This streak, which dates back to July 30, has surprisingly seen Jacksonville go .500 in its contests at 121 Financial Ballpark, with a 7-7 record. Over the Jumbo Shrimp's 65 home games thus far in 2024, their opponent has scored first in 43 contests (66.2 percent). Jacksonville is 14-29 (.326) in those affairs.

SHRIMP BITES

Jakob Marsee was the 76th Jumbo Shrimp to play in a game this season. The club record is 79, set in 2022... Jacksonville has used 43 pitchers during the 2024 season, one away from matching the franchise mark of 44 set in 2023... Jeff Lindgren has not appeared in a game with Jacksonville since June 23 at Memphis. He went 2-4 with a 5.21 ERA with Double-A Pensacola (14 G, 8 GS).

ABOUT JEFF

-A graduate of Illinois State University, Lindgren was mainly a reliever in college, starting in just 17 of his 83 appearances. He went 8-14 with a 6.02 ERA over his four seasons. However, entering 2023, he has already totaled 45 minor league starts in 63 career games.

-Jeff comes from an athletic family; His father, John, played football at Henderson State University in Arkadelphia, Arkansas.

-An alumnus of Illinois State University, Jeff followed in his sister Allyson's footsteps in attending school in Bloomington-Normal, Illinois. Allyson is a fellow graduate of Illinois State.

2024 SEASON

-Began season with Double-A Pensacola and was transferred to Jacksonville on May 3. Was transferred back to Pensacola on June 27 before returning to Jacksonville on August 30.

2023 SEASON

-Named International League Pitcher of the Week for June 5-11.

-Threw a seven-inning complete game against Nashville on June 7 with one-run allowed on two hits with five strikeouts.

2022 SEASON

-Lingren played for the Pensacola Blue Wahoo's between stint with Jacksonville. In 2022 combined, Lingren posted a 7-4 record with 116 strikeouts in 136.2 IP.

2021 SEASON

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .234 (59-for-252) with a .740 OPS. However, with runners in scoring position, Lindgren buckled down for a .211 (16-for-76) opponents' average and .598 OPS.

-Lindgren got off to slower starts in 2021; in the first and second innings, opponents batted .290 (43-for-148). However, in the third and fourth innings, often his second time through the order, Lindgren held opposing hitters to a .183 (25-for-136).

-When Lindgren got hitters in a 1-2 hole, they were just 7-for-71 (.099) against him with 33

Interestingly, when Lindgren was pitching from behind on the scoreboard, he performed better, holding opponents to a .176 (24-for-136) average. When his team led, opposing hitters collected a .241 (27-for-112) average

2019 SEASON

-With High-A Jupiter, lefties hit .297 with a .680 OPS against Lindgren. However, he held right-handed hitters to a .176 average with a .432 OPS.

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .275 (11-for-40) against Lindgren with a .626 OPS. With runners in scoring position, Lindgren limited opposing batters to .194 (6-for-31) with a .508 OPS. Total, with runners on, Lindgren posted a .188 (9-for-48) batting average against with an OPS of .471.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-At Centennial High School (Champaign, Ill.), Lindgren competed in both baseball and basketball. He served as the baseball team captain, helped win two regional championships and one sectional championship.
