**SPRINGDALE, AR** – Despite trailing by three runs in the seventh inning, the Naturals worked back into the game and won in the bottom of the ninth on a walk-off two-run homer from **Diego Hernández**, for a 6-4 win over the Cardinals.

- Naturals starter **Andrew Hoffmann** delivered his second quality start in Double-A, allowing just three runs over 6.0 innings, striking out three, but did not get any run support in his six innings of work ... **Stephen Woods Jr.** followed Hoffman with 2.0 scoreless innings and four strikeouts, to extend his scoreless inning streak to 6.1 innings.
- After Woods Jr. stranded the bases loaded in the top of the seventh, the Naturals entered the bottom of the inning trailing by three runs but came alive to jump back in the game. **Luca Tresh** reached on a three-base error to open the inning, then scored on a **Seuly Matias** sacrifice fly to the warning track ... **Jake Means** proceeded to connect on a solo home run, his 10th of the season, to bring the Naturals within a run.
- In the bottom of the eighth, **CJ Alexander** singled in a run to tie the game, then **Jeison Guzmán** singled Alexander home for a 4-3 lead.
- Yefri Del Rosario** came one strike away from securing his sixth save of the season in the top of the ninth but allowed a trio of singles that allowed Springfield to tie the game.
- With one out in the bottom of the ninth, pinch-hitter **John Rave** doubled off the right field wall to put the winning run in scoring position. With two outs, Hernández stepped to the plate and connected on his first Double-A home run, a 399-foot home run that scored Rave to win the game, 6-4.
- Hernández' home run was his second walk-off this season, after his walk-off fielder's choice last week against San Antonio. It was the Naturals' third walk-off home run this season, tying a franchise record, as well as the team's fifth walk-off win of the year.

### THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

#### The Naturals are 6-7 all-time when playing on August 27

On August 27, 2010, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals shut out the Springfield Cardinals, 5-0 at Hammons Field in Springfield. Starting pitcher **Everett Teaford** allowed just one hit over 5.0 scoreless innings while striking out five, then **Ben Swaggerty** and **Henry Barrera** each contributed two scoreless innings with the three combining to strike out two batters, including Barrera striking out five of six he faced. The Naturals scored two runs in each the second and sixth innings, then added a run of insurance in the eighth on a solo home run from first baseman **Eric Hosmer**, his 12th of the season with the Naturals.

**FOLLOW THE LEADER**

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 14 of the Naturals' 27 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 3 of the Naturals' 27 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: **Jonah Dipoto**, **Jake Means** and **John Rave**.

**EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM**

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring seven runs or more, the Naturals are 37-10, while when scoring six runs or less, just 12-59.
- The Naturals are 34-15 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 15-53.
- The Naturals are 44-14 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 5-54 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 30-21, whereas 19-47 when the opponent scores first ... the team that scores first in through 117 Naturals games is 77-40 (.658 winning %).

**ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY**

The Naturals are 6-17 in one-run games this season, meaning 17 of their 68 losses (25.00%) this season have been decided by just one run.

- The Naturals have had the tying run at the plate or on base in 22 losses this season (including 13 of their one-run losses).

**Yo, YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?**

Through 117 games, the Naturals have stolen *149 bases in 185 attempts* (average 1.27 steals/game, 80.54% success rate).

- 149 steals is second in the Texas League, ranks sixth in Double-A and 33rd in the Minors.
- The Naturals have stolen at least one base in 77 of 117 games this season (65.81%), including 37 games with two or more steals ... the team stole a season-high six bases on July 6 vs. Tulsa with a pair of five-steal games as well this season.
- The Naturals have pulled off a double steal 18 times, meaning 36 of 149 steals this year (24.16%) have come on a double-steal.
- Naturals players have stolen multiple bases in a game 15 times, SIX of those occasions being Garcia ... **Tucker Bradley** had the first three-steal game of the season (and of his career) on July 9 vs. Tulsa.
- Maikel Garcia's** 27 steals (in 30 attempts) still ranks sixth in the Texas League, **Nick Loftin's** 24 (in 27 attempts) ranks eighth in the league.

**TUCK(ER) AND ROLL**

Naturals outfielder **Tucker Bradley** has been consistent from the start of the season and established himself as one of the team's most reliable hitters.

- Bradley has reached base at least once in 82 of 101 games played this season (81.19%) and reached base multiple times on a team-best 51 occasions ... he has hits in 71 of 101 games and has a team-best 31 multi-hit games, as well as 15 multi-run games and 11 multi-RBI games.
- Bradley's .293 batting average leads qualified active Naturals hitters ... 109 hits are second among Kansas City's minor league hitters, while his .293 average, .374 on-base percentage and 22 doubles are fourth, 164 total bases rank seventh, 34 extra-base hits rank tied seventh, 66 runs scored are tied eighth and a .826 OPS is ninth.
- The Georgia native has hit first in the order 33 games this year, which ranks second behind Maikel Garcia (76) ... when hitting first, Bradley is a .277 hitter (38-for-137) with a .369 on-base percentage and .785 OPS ... when leading off innings, he hits .284 (29-for-102) with a .371 on-base percentage.

**TYLER, THE CREATOR (OF RUNS)**

Naturals outfielder **Tyler Gentry** has been one of the best hitters in the Kansas City Royals' system this season, with an incredible impact since joining the Naturals in June.

- Among qualified full-season Minor League hitters, Gentry ranks SIXTH in batting average (.326)* when you combine his stats between Northwest Arkansas and Quad Cities (A+).
- He is the Royals' organization leader in batting average (.326), slugging percentage (.541) and OPS (.969) and ranks second in on-base percentage (.428) ... his 18 home runs between the River Bandits and Naturals are tied second in the system, 179 total bases are third and 70 runs batted in are fourth.
- Gentry has reached base in 49 of 54 games (90.74%) and has hits in 38 of his 54 games with the Naturals, with already 20 multi-hit games.
- In 54 games since his call-up to Double-A on June 14, Gentry is batting .320 (65-for-203) with nine doubles, 13 home runs and 47 runs batted in, with a .980 OPS ... he's driven in at least one run in 27 of 54 games, with 11 multi-RBI games.
- Gentry leads the Naturals in nearly every category since joining the team, with the highest average (.320), most total bases (113), most home runs (13) and most runs batted in on the team (47) ... his 47 runs batted in, 113 total bases and .980 OPS are third in the Texas League since June 14, while his 13 homers rank tied fifth since his promotion to Double-A.
- Tyler has compiled the two longest on-base streaks among Naturals hitters this season, including an active 21-game stretch ... since July 30, he has hit .333 (25-for-75) with five extra-base hits and 17 walks, for a .485 on-base percentage over the last 21 games, the third-longest active streak in the Texas League.

**ALEXANDER THE GREAT**

Infielder **CJ Alexander** has quickly heated up at the plate since joining the Naturals in a trade last month from Atlanta.

- Over 31 games with the Naturals, the corner infielder is hitting .258 (33-for-128) with 16 extra-base hits (nine home runs) and 35 runs batted in, with 23 runs scored as well.
- He has hits in 20 of 31 games with the Naturals, 12 of which are multi-hit performances, while he's driven in runs in 14 of 31 games, including already 10 multi-RBI games.
- Over 18 games in the month of August, Alexander is hitting .293 (22-for-75) with eight home runs and 27 runs batted in ... *eight HR and 27 RBI lead the Texas League this month, while and 51 total bases are tied third ... he leads all Double-A hitters this month in RBI and is second in HR ... among full-season Minor League hitters in August, he ranks tied third in runs batted in and home runs.*
- CJ homered in four straight games at home against Tulsa, August 3 to 6 ... he is the third Natural this season and just the sixth all-time to homer in four consecutive games.
- Alexander began his Naturals tenure 0-for-12 over his first three games, then homered on July 16 @ Corpus Christi for his first hit with the team and went 4-for-10 in his next two games.

**WALK-OFF HEROS**

Naturals outfielder Diego Hernández sent the fans home happy last night with a walk-off home run, his first Double-A homer and the fifth walk-off this year for the Naturals.

- The two-run blast from Hernández was the Naturals' third walk-off home run this season, after Seuly Matias (June 4) and Sebastian Rivero (August 20) ... three walk-off homers ties a franchise record, which the Naturals also accomplished in 2009 and 2014.
- Hernández is now the fifth player to have walk-off home run for their first homer of the season with the Naturals ... he's just the second, however, to have it also be the first home run at the Double-A level, after Jeff Bianchi hit a walk-off home run in his 8th Double-A game on June 27, 2009 against the Arkansas Travelers.
- Five walk-off wins this year still ranks on the lower end in club history, a feat they've accomplished in now 10 of 14 seasons since 2008.

**Pitchers of the Month (1)**

**May: LHP Drew Parrish** ... started five games and went 3-1 with a 0.59 ERA (2 ER in 30.2 IP) ... only allowed 15 hits and four walks, while striking out 29 opposing hitters ... among qualified Texas League pitchers, threw the most innings and had the lowest ERA and WHIP (0.62), while holding opponents to a .144 average.

**Players of the Week (3)**

- April 25 to May 1: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.
- May 23 to May 29: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. - Widger and his wife, Whitney, reside in Pennsville, N.J., with their children: C.J., Ashlynn and Skylar.



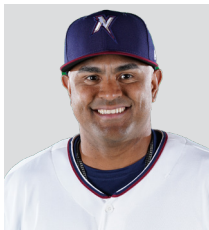
## #43 DERRICK LEWIS • PITCHING COACH

## #6 ABRAHAM NÚÑEZ • HITTING COACH

- Abraham Núñez enters his fourth season as Northwest Arkansas' hitting coach after serving in the same capacity with High-A Wilmington (2015-2018), Class-A Lexington (2014), Rookie Advanced Burlington (2013) and the Dominican Royals (2012).
- Núñez played for parts of 12 seasons in the Majors with the Pirates (1997-2004), Cardinals (2005), Phillies (2006-2007) and Mets (2008). A switch-hitter, he owns a career average of .242 as a utility infielder in the big leagues, primarily playing third base, but could play all four infield positions.
- His best season came in 2005 when he batted .285 in 139 games for the National League Champion St. Louis Cardinals.
- Lifetime .346 (9-for-28) hitter in the postseason, including the 2005 National League Championship Series with St. Louis when he hit .385, though did not play in the World Series.
- Born in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, he now resides in Hudson, Massachusetts.



## #24 CHRISTIAN COLÓN • ASSISTANT HITTING COACH

- Christian Colón returns to the organization as the Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach in 2022, following a 12-year professional career.
- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
- During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.
- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.
- Christian lives in Cave Springs, Ark. (15 minutes North of Arvest Ballpark) with his wife, Kayla, and three daughters, Marley, Mia and Lucy.



## #23 MIKE JIRSCHLE • BENCH COACH

- Mike Jirschele enters his first season as the Bench Coach for Northwest Arkansas after spending last season in the same role for Manager Chris Widger in Quad Cities.
- He served as a Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020 and was on the Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015.
- Jirschele previously managed the Triple-A Omaha franchise for 11 seasons (2003-13), leading the team to four division titles, three-straight trips to the Pacific Coast League championship round (2011-13), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and a Triple-A Championship in 2013.
- He earned the 2011 Mike Coolbaugh Award for outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field.
- Prior to his 11-year stint with Omaha, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years (1998-2002), while he held managerial positions with Omaha (1995-97), Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- Jirschele was originally selected by the Texas Rangers in the fifth round of the 1977 MLB Draft and played in 999 minor league games over 13-plus seasons in the Rangers and Royals systems.



## DANNY ACCOLA • CERTIFIED ATHLETIC TRAINER

- Danny Accola is entering his seventh season with the Royals organization and first as the certified athletic trainer with the Naturals, after serving in the same role with the Quad Cities in 2021.
- He was slated to serve in that role with Wilmington in 2020 and previously filled those roles with Lexington in 2019, Burlington from 2017-18 and with Surprise in 2016.
- Accola graduated from the University of Central Missouri in 2014 and previously held an athletic training internship with the Denver Broncos in 2013.



## C.J. MIKKELSEN • STRENGTH & CONDITIONING COACH
