**TULSA, OK** – The Northwest Arkansas Naturals and Tulsa Drillers split a doubleheader Friday night at ONEOK Field, as the Naturals took game one 5-3 and the Drillers came ahead with the victory in game two, 12-1.

- **Tyler Gentry** led the way at the plate for the Naturals, he went a combined 5-for-8 in the two games, with two doubles and two runs batted in. Gentry has now reached base in 27 consecutive games dating back to July 30, tied for the second-longest on-base streak in Naturals history... the Naturals added insurance in the third and fourth, including a two-run homer from **Diego Hernández** and solo home run from **Tucker Bradley**, his third straight game with a homer.
- Starting pitcher **Andrew Hoffmann** earned his second win of the season in game one, as the right-hander allowed three runs on four hits over 5.0 innings with three strikeouts.
- The second game of the night took a drastic turn from the first, as Tulsa struck for four runs in the bottom of the first inning, all unearned to starting pitcher **T.J. Sikkema**, then the Drillers tagged Sikkema for six more in the third to end his night, for a season-worst 10 runs allowed in just 3.0 innings of work.
- The Naturals' lone run of the second game came with two outs in the top of the seventh, as Gentry bounced a single up the middle to score **Morgan McCullough** as Northwest Arkansas avoided the shutout.

### THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

#### The Naturals are 4-5 all-time when playing on September 3

On September 3, 2017, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the Arkansas Travelers, 4-2 at Dickey-Stephens Park. Starting pitcher **Emilio Ogando** allowed just two runs on four hits and no walks over 7.0 innings, as he earned his 10th win of the season to improve to 10-10. 73 pitches over 7.0 innings, or an average of 10.43 pitches per inning, ranks as the fifth-fewest pitches per inning for a Naturals pitcher that throws at least 70 pitches. **Richard Lovelady** followed with 2.0 scoreless innings and two strikeouts to earn his third save. Four Naturals recorded multi-hit games, including right fielder **Anderson Miller**, who went 2-for-4 with two runs batted in, on an RBI groundout in the second and RBI single in the seventh.

**FOLLOW THE LEADER**

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 13 of the Naturals' 26 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 3 of the Naturals' 26 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: **Jonah Dipoto**, **Jake Means** and **John Rave**.

**EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM**

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring seven runs or more, the Naturals are 38-10, while when scoring six runs or less, just 14-62.
- The Naturals are 36-15 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 16-56.
- The Naturals are 47-14 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 5-57 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 32-23, whereas 20-48 when the opponent scores first ... the team that scores first in through 123 Naturals games is 80-43 (.650 winning percentage).

**ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY**

The Naturals are 7-18 in one-run games this season, meaning 18 of their 71 losses (25.35%) this season have been decided by just one run.

- The Naturals have had the tying run at the plate or on base in 23 losses this season (including 14 of their one-run losses).

**Yo, YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?**

Through 123 games, the Naturals have stolen **159 bases in 197 attempts** (average 1.29 steals/game, 80.71% success rate).

- 159 steals is second in the Texas League, ranks sixth in Double-A and 32nd in the Minors.
- The Naturals have stolen at least one base in 82 of 123 games this season (66.67%), including 40 games with two or more steals ... the team stole a season-high six bases on July 6 vs. Tulsa with a pair of five-steal games as well this season.
- The Naturals have pulled off a double steal 18 times, meaning 36 of 159 steals this year (22.64%) have come on a double-steal.
- Naturals players have stolen multiple bases in a game 16 times, SIX of those occasions being Maikel Garcia ... **Tucker Bradley** had the first three-steal game of the season (and of his career) on July 9 vs. Tulsa.
- Maikel Garcia's** 27 steals (in 30 attempts) still ranks sixth in the Texas League, **Nick Loftin's** 24 (in 27 attempts) ranks eighth in the league.

**TUCK(ER) AND ROLL**

Naturals outfielder **Tucker Bradley** has been consistent from the start of the season and established himself as one of the team's most reliable hitters.

- Bradley has reached base at least once in 88 of 107 games played this season (82.24%) and reached base multiple times on a team-best 55 occasions ... he has hits in 75 of 107 games and has a team-best 33 multi-hit games, as well as 16 multi-run games and 11 multi-RBI games.
- Bradley's .293 batting average leads qualified Naturals hitters ... his .378 on-base percentage ranks third among Kansas City's minor league hitters, while 115 hits rank tied third, .293 average ranks fourth, 22 doubles are tied fourth, an .835 OPS is fifth, 37 extra-base hits and 179 total bases total bases rank tied sixth, 71 runs scored are seventh.
- The Georgia native has hit first in the order 38 games this year, which ranks second behind Maikel Garcia (76) ... when hitting first, Bradley is a .280 hitter (44-for-157) with a .379 on-base percentage and .838 OPS.
- Four of Bradley's 11 home runs this year came in the month of August, on 8/20 and 8/21, as well as 8/30 and 8/31 ... four homers last month ties a career-high of home runs in a month, which he also accomplished in May 2022.

**Let's Go (ON-BASE) STREAKING!**

August was a good month for on-base streaks among Naturals hitters, with five players setting season-best streaks of 10 games or more.

- Outfielder **Tyler Gentry** has reached base in 27 consecutive games, dating back to July 30 ... that is tied for the second-longest on-base streak in Naturals history with MJ Melendez (6/19/21 to 7/18/21), Derrick Robinson (6/16/10 to 7/20/10) and Clint Robinson (6/11/10 to 7/12/10).
- The longest on-base streak in Naturals history belongs to Jecksson Flores, who reached in 34 straight games between May 29, 2018 and July 7, 2018 ... over that stretch he hit .343 (47-for-126) with a .412 OBP.
- After Gentry's streak, the next longest active on-base streak is **John Rave's** 15-game stretch since August 16, while **Luca Tresh** has reached in 11 straight going back to August 13 ... in the second game of yesterday's doubleheader, **Robbie Glendinning's** 24-game on-base streak came to an end.

**TYLER, THE CREATOR (OF RUNS)**

Naturals outfielder **Tyler Gentry** has been one of the best hitters in the Kansas City Royals' system this season, with an incredible impact since joining the Naturals in June.

- Among qualified full-season Minor League hitters, Gentry ranks 6TH in batting average (.330), while his .430 on-base percentage is 10TH* when you combine his stats between Northwest Arkansas and Quad Cities (A+).
- He is the Royals' organization leader in batting average (.330), slugging percentage (.543) and OPS (.973), while he ranks second in on-base percentage (.430) behind Logan Porter's .439 ... his 116 hits and 191 total bases between the River Bandits and Naturals are each second in the system, 18 home runs are tied third and 73 runs batted in are fourth.
- Gentry has reached base in 55 of 60 games (91.67%), including 27 straight games ... he has hits in 42 of his 60 games with the Naturals, with already 23 multi-hit games.
- In 60 games since his call-up to Double-A on June 14, Gentry is batting .326 (73-for-224) with 13 doubles, 13 home runs and 50 runs batted in, with a .985 OPS ... he's driven in at least one run in 30 of 60 games, with 12 multi-RBI games.
- Gentry leads the Naturals in nearly every category since joining the team, with the highest average (.326), most total bases (125), most home runs (13) and most runs batted in on the team (50) ... his .985 OPS is second in the Texas League since June 14, while 125 TB are third, 50 RBI are fourth, and his 13 homers rank tied sixth since his promotion to Double-A.
- Tyler has compiled the two longest on-base streaks among Naturals hitters this season, including an active 27-game stretch that ranks tied for the second-longest in franchise history ... since July 30, he is hitting .344 (33-for-96) with nine extra-base hits and 20 walks, for a .480 on-base percentage over the last 27 games, the longest active streak in the Texas League and tied for the sixth-longest this year ... he has hits in 20 of the 27.

**ALEXANDER THE GREAT**

Infielder **CJ Alexander** has quickly heated up at the plate since joining the Naturals in a trade last month from Atlanta.

- When combining his number between the Naturals and Mississippi Braves (Double-A), he has a career-best 24 home runs and 80 runs batted in ... among all Double-A hitters this year, he ranks tied third in RBI and tied seventh in home runs.
- In 36 games with the Naturals, the corner infielder is hitting .260 (38-for-146) with 17 extra-base hits (nine home runs) and 37 runs batted in, with 27 runs scored as well.
- He has hits in 24 of 36 games with the Naturals, 13 of which are multi-hit performances, while he's driven in runs in 15 of 36 games, including already 11 multi-RBI games.
- On Thursday, Alexander was named the Naturals' August Player of the Month ... over 21 games in the month of August, Alexander hit .297 (27-for-91) with eight home runs and 29 runs batted in ... **29 RBI led both the Texas League and all Double-A hitters last month, while tied second among all full-season Minor League hitters ... his 8 HR were tied for the league lead, tied third in Double-A and tied tenth in the minors ... 57 total bases last month were tied fourth in Texas League and tied seventh in Double-A.**

**Pitchers of the Month (1)**

May: **LHP Drew Parrish** ... started five games and went 3-1 with a 0.59 ERA (2 ER in 30.2 IP) ... only allowed 15 hits and four walks, while striking out 29 opposing hitters ... among qualified Texas League pitchers, threw the most innings and had the lowest ERA and WHIP (0.62), while holding opponents to a .144 average.

**Players of the Week (3)**

April 25 to May 1: **2B Michael Massey** ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.

May 23 to May 29: **2B Michael Massey** ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. - Christian Colón returns to the organization as the Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach in 2022, following a 12-year professional career.
- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
- During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.
- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.
- Christian lives in Cave Springs, Ark. (15 minutes North of Arvest Ballpark) with his wife, Kayla, and three daughters, Marley, Mia and Lucy.



**#23 MIKE JIRSCHOLE • BENCH COACH**

- Mike Jirschele enters his first season as the Bench Coach for Northwest Arkansas after spending last season in the same role for Manager Chris Widger in Quad Cities.
- He served as a Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020 and was on the Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015.

- Jirschele was originally selected by the Texas Rangers in the fifth round of the 1977 MLB Draft and played in 999 minor league games over 13-plus seasons in the Rangers and Royals systems.
