The Round Rock Express and Oklahoma City Baseball Club will open their six-game series tonight at Dell Diamond. Texas Rangers rehabber RHP Michael Lorenzen is scheduled to take the mound for the E-Train while Oklahoma City RHP Kyle Hurt gets the start for the Baseball Club.

EXPRESS SALVAGE THE SERIES

The Express earned a 9-6 victory over the Chihuahuas on Sunday afternoon to split the series three games apiece. El Paso took the lead in the second inning thanks to an RBI single by SS Mason McCoy and a two-run double from 3B Clay Dungan which yielded a 3-0 lead. Round Rock cut the lead to 3-2 in the third, SS Davis Wendzel drove in CF Derek Hill on a double, followed by a sacrifice fly from LF Trevor Hauver. Dungan added another RBI in the fourth by driving in RF Tim Locastro on a triple to the gap. The Chihuahuas extended the advantage to 4-2. In the fifth, an inside-the-park home run by 3B Dustin Harris started the inning and cut the lead to 4-3. The scoring in the frame continued as two more scored on a DH Andrew Knapp sacrifice fly and error. RF Sandro Fabian followed that up with a single to score two more. An RBI double by Biggers rounded out a six-run inning for the Express as they took an 8-4 lead. In the seventh, McCoy plated El Paso CF Oscar Mercado on a single to make it 8-5. Each team scored a run in the ninth but the Express hung on for a 9-6 victory to close out their first road series of 2024.

LET'S GO WITH LORENZEN

Texas Rangers rehabber RHP Michael Lorenzen is slated to get the start for Round Rock to open the series with Oklahoma City. Lorenzen is preparing for his third start with the Express after he missed all of Spring Training and signed with the Rangers on March 22. The righty owns a 5.40 ERA (4 ER/6.2 IP) with four walks and seven strikeouts through his first two starts

WENDZEL MOVES UP

Express INF Davis Wendzel was called up to the Texas Rangers on Monday and is starting tonight at third base in his debut against the Oakland Athletics. In his first nine games this year, Wendzel slashed .314/.419/.657/1.076 with three doubles, three home runs, eight RBI, 10 runs scored, four walks and four strikeouts. In 226 games over parts of the last four seasons in Round Rock, Wendzel blasted 51 home runs, which is the most in the Pacific Coast League during that span.

NOBODY IS STOPPING SANDRO

Express RF Sandro Fabian picked up three hits and collected his fifth consecutive multi-hit game on Sunday in El Paso. He has a hit in all seven games he has played in this year and is slashing .483/.500/.759 with five doubles, a home run, 11 RBI, five runs scored, one walk and three strikeouts.

SOME SERIOUS SPEED

Express 3B Dustin Harris recorded an inside-thepark home run in the fifth inning on Sunday. It was the first inside-the-park home run by a Round Rock hitter since June 18, 2022, when OF Bubba Thompson rounded the bases against Sugar Land.

GOING DEEP

The Express have relied on the long ball early in the season. They are 4-1 in games where they homer compared to 1-3 when they do not. Round Rock enters today tied for second in home runs in the PCL with 13. Their lone home run on Sunday was an inside-the-park homer for OF Dustin Harris.

ALCS EXPRESS REUNION

Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the

most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
