CHURCH, LLDYD POWER CARDS TO 7-6 VICTORY: Matt Lloyd homered for the second straight game and Nathan Church had two hits, including a two-run homer of his own, and had two outfield assists as the Cardinals took the series opener 7-6 over the Tulsa Drillers. Ryan Shreve picked up the win for the second straight game, and Matt Svanson notched his fifth save of the season. Jacob Buchberger had two hits for Springfield, extending his hitting streak to seven. The Cardinals have now won three straight games.



DPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Yon Castro** makes his 5th start of the season for Tulsa in game one...Last pitched on Thursday, May 16 against Wichita allowing 4 ER on 5 H with 3 BB and 4 K oer 4.0 IP...In his previous start allowed 5 ER on 5 H in just 0.1 IP at Midland...Made his 2nd start of the season against the Cardinals at ONEOK Field and allowed 4 ER on 5 H with 4 BB and 2 K over 3.0 IP...The Cards won the game 6-5 in 10 innings...Made 12 starts with High-A Great Lakes in 2023, going 4-2 with a 2.27 ERA with 103 K in 87.2 IP...Missed 3 months last season due to two IL stints... Selected by the Dodgers in the minor league phase of the Rule 5 Draft in 2022 from the Yankees...Signed with the Yankees as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic in Jan 2018...24 years old

Right-hander **Christian Romero** starts for Tulsa in game two...Added to the Drillers roster today from High-A Great Lakes where he went 2-2 with a 2.38 ERA in 6 appearances (2 starts)...Also made one start for Triple-A Oklahoma City and allowed 4 ER on 3 H in 4.2 IP...Went 8-2 with a 3.17 ERA in 20 appearances (10 starts) for Low-A Rancho Cucamonga in 2023, his first year in full-season ball...Signed by the Dodgers as an International Free Agent out of Mexico in January 2021...21 years old

LONGEST HOMESTAND OF 2024 CONTINUES WITH SEVEN AGAINST THE DRILLERS: For the first time this season, the Cardinals play host to the Tulsa Drillers (Double-A, Los Angeles Dodgers) as the two teams play a seven-game series at Hammons Field this week. The Cardinals won 4 out of 5 at ONEOK Field from April 30-May 4. The Cards and Drillers will play a doubleheader on Wednesday to make up for the postponement on May 5.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

LET'S PLAY TWO: The Cardinals and Drillers will play a doubleheader on Wednesday in a makeup of the series finale in Tulsa that was rained out on May 5 at ONEOK Field. The Drillers will be the home team in game one, and the Cardinals will be home in game two. The Cards swept a twinbill in Tulsa on May 3, 9-4 and 7-4. Overall the Birds are 5-1 in doubleheaders this season.

GRINDIN': Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats and put the ball in play. The Cards have struck out just 283 times in 39 games, the 3rd-fewest in all of full-season Minor League Baseball. In the Texas League, Springfield trails the Frisco RoughRiders (279 K's in 39 games) for 2nd-fewest in the circuit. The Birds are averaging just 7.25 K's per game.

The Wisconsin Tiber Rattlers have struck out the fewest times in the minors, with just 277 K's in 40 games (6.9/game).

CARDS PLAGUED BY BIG INNINGS: So far in 2024, the Cardinals have had a hard time limiting the big inning. Springfield has surrendered 31 innings in which the opponent has scored 3 or more runs. In those 31 innings, the Cardinals have allowed 119 of the 219 total runs scored by the opposition. In summation, the Cards have allowed 54.3% of the runs scored against them in 2024 in just 9.2% of their innings pitched. In the other 305.2 IP Springfield has allowed 97 runs, which comes out to 2.86 runs per 9 innings.

HE GETS ON BASE...AND HITS TANKS: With a walk in his first plate appearance on Tuesday night, Matt Lloyd extended his on-base streak to 18 straight games, third longest for the Cardinals this season and the fifth-longest active streak currently in the Texas League. Bryan Torres had a 23-game streak from April 5-May 9 and Jeremy Rivas had a 20-gamer from April 14-May 12. Lloyd has walked a team-high 23 times and has homered in back-to-back games, giving him a team-high 7 on the season. He finished a triple shy of the cycle in the series finale against Midland on Sunday.

WELCOME BACK TO SPRINGY: Since returning to Springfield on April 25 after beginning the season with Triple-A Memphis, Cardinals OF **Mike Antico** has picked up where he left off in 2023. In 16 games in the month of May since returning to the Springfield regular lineup, **Antico** is batting a team-high .344 (21-for-61) with 3 doubles, a triple, 2 HR and 11 RBIs, most on the club during that time. Among qualified hitters in the Texas League, **Antico** is 6th in the Texas League in hitting in May.

The former Texas Longhorn led the Cardinals in hits (126) and stolen bases (52) last season.

TABLE SETTERS: The hitters that occupy the top two spots in the Cardinal lineup on the most regular basis, **Bryan Torres** and **Nathan Church**, have been the fuel to Springfield's league-leading offense. Combined, **Torres** and **Church** are batting .313 (86-for-275) with 47 R, 15 2B, 24 SB, 4 CS and have struck out a combined 37 times compared to 30 walks.

Springfield leadoff hitters are batting .284 which is good for 4th in the Texas League, and .305 out of the 2-hole, the top mark in the circuit. Combined, the Cardinals batting .294 between the two spots in the lineup, the top mark in the circuit.

TAKE ME TO CHURCH: Not only has Cardinals OF **Nathan Church** swung the bat well to start the season, but he has also been a well above-average defensive outfielder. Along with several highlight-reel catches this season, **Church** is 2nd among all outfielders in the Texas League with 4 outfield assists this season trailing only Midland's Colby Thomas, with two coming on Tuesday night against Tulsa.

REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY: With his

go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 206.

Since tying the record, however, **Redmond** has gone 19 straight games wihtout a home run.




