Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the second in a six-game series at the South Bend Cubs, High-A affiliate of the Chicago Cubs. These are the only six meetings between the two teams this season, with Lansing coming off winning four of six games at Wisconsin while South Bend split a six-game series at West Michigan. Today is the eighth game and ninth day of the Lugnuts' 12-game, 13-day road trip, wrapping up the 2022 road schedule.

Starting Matchup: Right-hander **Jacob Watters**, a fourth-round selection in 2022 from West Virginia, makes his first Lugnuts start. Watters is ranked the No. 27 prospect in the A's organization by MLB Pipeline. He is opposed by the Cubs' No. 22 prospect, **Porter Hodge**, making his seventh start for South Bend.

Last Night: **Cubs 4, Lugnuts 3**. With two outs in the ninth inning, **Sahid Valenzuela** and **Max Muncy** delivered RBI singles to make things interesting – but **Jarod Wright** retired **Shane McGuire** on a bases-loaded comebacker to lock down the series-opening South Bend victory.

On Deck: The Nuts play the Cubs through Sunday, followed by a six-game homestand with the Dayton Dragons at Jackson Field to end the 132-game Midwest League season.

LUG•NOTES

With a Win Today... the Lugnuts would notch their 1800th win as a franchise... it would also give the Lugnuts their 10th win in their last 13 road games.

Today's Transaction: Pitcher **Jake Walkinshaw** was promoted to Triple-A Las Vegas. He becomes the sixth former Lugnut on the Aviators' roster, one step away from the Major Leagues, joining **Garrett Acton**, **Hogan Harris**, **William Simoneit**, **Jordan Diaz** and **Kevin Smith**.

Streaking: In his first day back from the Covid IL, outfielder **Denzel Clarke** went 0-for-3 with a walk last night, extending his on-base streak to 12 games. The longest streak for a Lugnut this year is 13 games, held jointly by **Jared McDonald** and **Joshwan Wright**.

Tight Games: Nine out of the last 13 Lugnuts' road games have been decided by two runs or fewer; Lansing has a record of 7-2 in those games, including last night's series-opening defeat.

Running Men: When **Lawrence Butler** stole second base yesterday, the Lugnuts notched their 14th steal in 16 attempts on this road trip. They have 45 steals in 54 attempts in August.

But None For You: South Bend Cubs were thrown out trying to steal second base in three consecutive innings: **Owen Caissie** by catcher **Shane McGuire** in the fifth, **BJ Murray** by reliever **Brock Whittlesey** in the sixth, and **Pete Crow-Armstrong** by McGuire on a pitch-out in the seventh. In one of those weird coincidences, it was on the same day, August 30, 2011, that Lugnuts catcher **Chris Schaeffer** threw out three runners trying to steal, setting the franchise record. (A fourth runner was picked off by reliever Phil Brua.)

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has five players acquired by the Athletics via trade: **Cooper Bowman** (New York Yankees, acquired 8/1/22, for Frankie Montas and Lou Trivino); **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); **Euribiel Angeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); **Joey Estes** (Atlanta Braves, 3/14/22, for Matt Olson); and **Alexander Campos** (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17).

- Phil briefly played for the independent Laredo Lemurs in 2015, managed by Pete Incaviglia, hitting .311/.407/.473 with three home runs in 23 games. Laredo finished 57-43 and won the American Association championship.
- Since Phil is a native of Cooperstown, the National Baseball Hall of Fame is following his career closely. His gameworn Lugnuts baseball cap from the season's first weekend was sent to the Hall of Fame, by request.

To the Show: Ten former Nuts have debuted in MLB this year, namely A's pitchers **Norge Ruiz** (2021), **Zach Logue** (2018) and **Zach Jackson** (2017) and infielder **Christian Lopes** (2013); Jays utilityman **Vinny Capra** (2018), catcher **Gabriel Moreno** (2019) and pitcher **Max Castillo** (2018); M's reliever **Danny Young** (2016); Red Sox pitcher **Josh Winckowski** (2019) and Marlins pitcher **Jake Fishman** (2017).

Skipper for the Series: When **Phil Pohl** went on scheduled vacation from August 16-21 vs. Great Lakes; **Veronica Alvarez** stepped in as interim Lugnuts manager through Sunday. A stand-out at Villanova, Alvarez served as the starting catcher for Team USA Baseball Women's National Team, winning medals in 2008 (bronze), 2010 (bronze), 2012 (silver) and 2015 (gold). She joined the Team USA's coaching staff as assistant coach in 2018, rising to manager of the Women's National Team beginning in 2019, when she led Team USA to a 7-0 record and the gold medal at the Women's Baseball World Cup Qualifier in Mexico, earning her the honor of 2019 USA Baseball Rod Dedeaux Coach of the Year. Since 2019, she has worked as a coach in Spring Training for the Athletics. Alvarez went 2-4 with the Nuts against the Loons.

Inside the Park and Out of This World: On August 2-3, 2022, CF **Denzel Clarke** joined Fred Bello (Everett, July 2-3, 2010) as the only Minor Leaguers since 2005 to have inside-the-park home runs in back-to-back games. The feat has never occurred in the Majors.

Welcome to the Lugnuts! Jacob Watters makes his Midwest League debut today, becoming the Lugnuts' 55th different player used this year, the 20th different starting pitcher and the 895th all-time Nuts... he joins Micah Dallas (8th round) and TJ Czyz (12th round) as 2022 draftees on Lugnuts roster.

Pro Debut: Watters has made just one prior appearance in the minors before today, on August 23 for the Arizona Complex League Athletics vs. the Ariz. Complex League Cubs: he walked Esmarly Tatis, who stole second base, retired Raino Coran on a groundout, tossed a wild pitch to move Tatis to third base, struck out Dilan Granadillo and then ended the inning with a Christian Olivo flyout to Austin Beck.

Entering Draft Day: Rated Keith Law's No. 68 draft prospect for The Athletic, with Law writing, "Watters started the year in the Mountaineers' bullpen, where he hit 99 mph a few times, so the team moved him to the rotation around midseason, where he struggled more with control (37 walks in 50.2 innings) but also showed enough that some scouts think he can start in pro ball. Watters sits 94-97 mph with a power slider in the mid-80s that can miss bats ... when he locates it. It's not a bad delivery, with a reasonably short arm stroke and strong finish, so that's not the reason he doesn't throw strikes, but it's true across all of his pitches. It's much more likely he ends up a power reliever with two plus pitches. But with enough of a changeup to start and a delivery that looks like it should work, I wouldn't be surprised to see a pro team keep him in the rotation."... Fangraphs' No. 96 draft prospect.

Inked: Selected 124th overall by the A's in the 4th round and signed for \$491,750... highest pitcher taken by the Athletics in 2022 following first-round catcher Daniel Susac (currently starring at Stockton) and three straight outfielders (high schooler Henry Bolte in the second round, Michigan Wolverine Clark Elliott in the compensatory round B, and Mercer slugger Colby Thomas in the third round).

WVU to the Pros: First of three Mountaineers selected in the 2022 draft... the 2021 Fort Wayne TinCaps featured two WVU teammates in 2021 draftees Jackson Wolf (4th rd.) and Ryan Bergert (6th rd.)... the last West Virginia player taken in the first round was Alek Manoah by Toronto in 2019, who this year joined John Means as the only two Mountaineers to be named MLB All-Stars... the last West Virginia player to suit up for the Lugnuts was Ryan McBroom, who won the 2015 Midwest League Most Valuable Player award.

Current Ranking: MLB Pipeline ranks Watters the No. 27 prospect in the A's organization and the No. 11 pitching prospect... his grades: Fastball 60, Curve 60, Changeup 45, Control 40, Overall 40... his scouting report: "The 6-foot-4 Watters has the chance to have two at least plus pitches. His fastball was up to 99 mph as a starter this past spring, averaging close to 96 mph, and he can touch triple digits in shorter relief stints. He complements the heater with a true 12-to-6 power curve thrown in the mid-80s that can miss a ton of bats. He does have some feel for a mid-80s changeup, but it's well behind the two other offerings. For Watters to be able to have a chance at starting at the next level, he's going to have to continue improving his command. He has gotten better at finding the strike zone after walking 10.7 per nine in 2021. In all likelihood, he'll end up back in the bullpen, where he could have an 80 fastball to go along with a 65 or 70 curve."

Glory Days: Starred for the Bland County HS Rockets as an all-state baseball player as well as in basketball (where he regularly posted double-doubles and topped out at 45 points in one game) and football.

Off to College: Did not receive much notice before his high velocity was discovered at a tryout in Morgantown... named to the Academic All-Big 12 Rookie Team as a freshman (5 G, 4.70 ERA, 7 2/3 IP, 4 R, 6 BB, 11 K)... as a sophomore, made 19 appearances: 3.33 ERA, 27 IP, 15 H, 11 R, 32 BB, bullpen-leading 53 K, .165 avg. allowed, tied for team lead with four saves; named Academic All-Big 12 Second Team; NCBWA Stopper of the Year Midseason Watch List... made first college start in the 2021 Big 12 Championship vs. Texas: 3 IP, 0 H, 1 R, 4 BB, 8 K... as a junior in 2022, named preseason All-American; dominated early as team closer and was moved into role as Friday starter; struck out 15 Texas Longhorns in 6 1/3 IP on May 7; overall: 18 G, 11 GS, 3-7, 6.22 ERA, 59 1/3 IP, 64 H, 44 R, 41 BB, 75 K; named All-Big 12 Honorable Mention.

Hometown Hero: Home city of Rocky Gap, Virginia, is in the Ridge-and-Valley Appalachians, located near the West Virginia border... neighboring city: Bluefield, home of the Bluefield Ridge Runners, previously known as the Bluefield Orioles and Bluefield Blue Jays, which fed such stars as Alejandro Kirk and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. to the Lugnuts when both were part of the Jays' system.

Life as a Lugnut: Assigned to Lansing on July 10 after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays with Triple-A outfielder Cal Stevenson on July 9 for Christian Bethancourt... debuted for the Nuts on July 13 at Fort Wayne, looking great with a 1-2-3 first inning before allowing three runs on three singles and two walks in the second inning and then a fourth run in the third inning on two singles sandwiched around a wild pitch... after delay due to All-Star Break, made second start on July 27th, allowing seven runs at Great Lakes in two innings (four runs in 1st, three in 2nd... gave up leadoff home run in each frame (Eddys Leonard, Edwin Mateo)... impressed with five hitless innings at Dayton, August 10th.

Last Appearance: August 17th vs. Great Lakes. Recorded perfect 1st inning and 2nd inning... walked Kekai Rios and hit Luis Diaz in the 3rd, but set down the next three batters... departed in the 4th after allowing an RBI triple to Jose Ramos and RBI single to Damon Keith... exited trailing 2-1, but Lugnuts rallied for 6-3 win.

The Early Word: When announcing the trade with the Rays, Athletics general manager Dan Feinstein summed up Fernandez to the media, "A four-pitch mix. Fastball averages 93. Three really good off-speed pitches. The change-up is probably the best one. Has the ability to get swings and misses, plus a slider and curve ball." Feinstein also informed the media that Fernandez missed the 2021 season with an unspecified arm injury... Fernandez is eligible for the Rule 5 Draft at season's end.

Home Cooking: Home of Cabimas is located in northwestern Venezuela on the shore of Maracaibo Lake in the state of Zulia... notables from Cabimas include Marlins ace Pablo López and longtime Major Leaguer Vic Davalillo (1963-1980).

Path Through the Pros: Debuted in 2016 in the Dominican Summer League working entirely out of the bullpen... converted to starting pitcher in 2017 DSL with greater success... split 2018 between DSL and Gulf Coast League... spent 2019 in the Appy League with Princeton... missed all of 2020 (canceled MiLB season) and 2021 (injury).
