**Today:** The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland A's, play the second in a six-game series at the Lake County Captains, High-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. 20-year-old right-hander **Joey Estes**, the reigning Low-A East Pitcher of the Year, acquired in the offseason in a four-player package from the Atlanta Braves for first baseman Matt Olson, makes his third start of the year for the Nuts. Lake County counters with right-hander **Aaron Davenport**, who was drafted last year from the University of Hawaii in the sixth round and will be making his third start as well.

**On the Air:** Listen in via <http://mlb.streamguys1.com/lansing> as **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** hopefully delivers the call, while **John Vicari** has the Captains' home call on WJCU 88.7 FM.

**Tuesday Night: Lansing 3, Lake County 1.** Southpaw starter **David Leal** delivered six masterful innings, striking out seven while limiting the Captains to two hits and one unearned run, and **Brett Harris's** tie-breaking RBI double in the eighth lifted the Lugnuts to the series-opening win. Relievers **Trayson Kubo** and **Angello Infante** finished the stellar pitching effort, with the Captains managing just three hits in all, while Harris, **Austin Beck** and **Patrick McColl** each finished with two hits.

**On Deck:** The Lugnuts play the Captains through Sunday at Classic Park, including a Saturday doubleheader to make up last night's postponement, before returning home for a 12-game, 13-day homestand at Jackson Field stretching from May 3-15 against the West Michigan Whitecaps and the Dayton Dragons. With the Lugnuts out of town this week, Jackson Field will host Beerfest at the Ballpark on Saturday, with over 50 local vendors bringing their top selections for tasting.

### LUG•NOTES

**Let's Play Two... Again:** The Lugnuts have had doubleheaders scheduled in each of their first four series of this season, getting swept in a twinbill at home against the Captains on April 9, splitting two at West Michigan on April 14, getting swept in two at home against Fort Wayne on April 23, and now Saturday's scheduled doubleheader following Wednesday's postponement. Last year, the Lugnuts played seven doubleheaders – five of them in the second half (including four in September).

**Lugnuts in the Pen:** For the second time this season, the Athletics used the former Lugnut combo of **Zach Jackson**, **Kirby Sneed** and **Dany Jiménez** to close out a victory, with Jiménez recording the final three outs in a perfect 9th to lock down an A's 1-0 win over the Giants last night. The trio's ERAs this year: Jackson - 3.38, Sneed - 3.18, Jiménez - 0.00. Entering this year, the three had a combined nine MLB career innings between them.

**Key Indicators:** The Lugnuts scored first Tuesday and outhit Lake County overall, two important aspects to note when it comes to the team's overall success. When the Nuts have scored first, they're 4-1 (but 1-10 when the opposition scores first); when they outhit the opposition, they're 4-3 (but 1-8 when the opponent collects more hits).

**Streaking:** Infielder **Brett Harris** went 2-for-4 Tuesday, reaching base in his 11th straight game. Harris is hitting 13-for-41, .317, with nine walks over that span.

**Amongst the League Leaders:** Outfielder **Lawrence Butler** is tied for second in the Midwest League with 14 walks, infielder **Euribiel Ángele**s is tied for third with 20 hits, starter **David Leal** is third with a 0.70 WHIP, relievers **Kumar Nambiar** and **Angello Infante** are tied for second with six appearances, and Infante is tied for second with three saves.

**164 Major League Nuts:** Infielder **Christian Lopes** (2013 in Lansing) debuted off the bench last Wednesday for the Oakland Athletics, becoming the 164th all-time Nut to reach the Majors and the third this year, joining A's relievers **Zach Logue** and **Zach Jackson**. There are currently 15 Major League teams with at least one Lugnut representing, including five (Jackson, **Dany Jiménez**, **Christian Lopes**, **Kirby Sneed** and the injured **Kevin Smith**) on the A's.

**Welcome Back:** The Nuts return one coach (hitting coach **Javier Godard**) and 12 players from 2021, pitchers **Osvaldo Berrios**, **Jeff Criswell**, **Stevie Emanuels** and **David Leal**; catcher **Jared McDonald**; infielders **Brett Harris**, **Patrick McColl** and **Drew Swift**; and outfielders **Lazaro Armenteros**, **Austin Beck**, **Jonny Butler** and **Lawrence Butler**.

**Talent Rich:** The Nuts boast the No. 1 prospect in the Athletics' organization in **Tyler Soderstrom**, a 20-year-old catcher drafted 26th overall in 2020 who is considered MLB Pipeline's No. 56 prospect in all of baseball. Soderstrom is one of six Top 25 A's prospects on the roster, joining teenager **Brayan Buelvas** (No. 10) and **Euribiel Ángele**s (No. 11), starting pitcher **Joey Estes** (No. 18), first baseman/outfielder **Lawrence Butler** (No. 20) and pitcher **Jeff Criswell** (No. 21).

**Recent Acquisitions:** Three Lugnuts – pitcher **Joey Estes**, infielder **Euribiel Ángele**s and outfielder **Gabriel Maciel** – join the Athletics organization for the 2022 season from outside the system. Estes was picked up from Atlanta in a four-player package for first baseman Matt Olson on March 14, 2022; Ángele was acquired from San Diego with a fellow prospect for pitcher Sean Manaea on April 3, 2022; and Maciel was selected in the Rule 5 Draft Triple-A portion from the Minnesota Twins on December 3, 2021.

## 26 PHIL POHL MANAGER

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

**Personal:** Signed for \$497,500 as the 487th overall selection in 2019... others taken in the 16th round: Brady Basso, Oraj Anu, Kona Quiggle, DJ Gladney, and the immortal Jackxarel Lebron... first ever player drafted out of Paraclete H.S... at age 17, was one of the youngest players in the draft, but had velocity already touching 96 mph... signed away from commitment to Long Beach State.

**2019 Professional Debut:** Made first MiLB appearance on July 20, shutting out the GCL Rays on one hit in two innings, striking out three... gave up five runs apiece over the next two outings before recovering with three perfect innings vs. GCL Orioles on August 5... allowed .300 avg. to left-handed batters, .241 to right-handers.

**2021 Breakout: Named 2021 Low-A East Pitcher of the Year...** established himself as the ace of the Augusta GreenJackets, though he began season as the No. 5 starter... led Low-A East in strikeouts (127), ERA (2.91), average (.184) and WHIP (0.96)... struck out 11 Myrtle Beach Pelicans in 5 2/3 IP on June 9... twirled seven scoreless innings, allowing two hits, striking out seven vs. Myrtle Beach on July 9... whiffed 10 Columbia Fireflies in 5 1/3 IP on July 21... fired nine-inning CG vs. Kannapolis on August 14 (9 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 0 BB, 14 K)... emphatic home/road splits: at home in Augusta: 0.81 ERA in 10 GS, 1 CG, 55 1/3 IP, 30 H, 5 ER, 2 HR, 11 BB, 76 K, .153 avg., 0.74 WHIP... on the road: 5.56 ERA in 10 GS, 43 2/3 IP, 36 H, 27 ER, 5 HR, 18 BB, 51 K, .221 avg., 1.24 WHIP... limited lefties to .148 avg.; right-handers batted .213.

**2022 to Oakland:** Traded by Atlanta to Oakland with OF Cristian Pache, C Shea Langeliers and P Ryan Cusick in exchange for 1B Matt Olson on March 14, 2022... Pache is in the Majors, Langeliers is in Triple-A and Cusick is in Double-A... made unofficial debut for the Lugnuts in the 2022 Crosstown Showdown presented by Delta Dental, tossing four innings against Michigan State on April 6: two hits, one run (a Peter Ahn solo HR), one walk and five strikeouts, as the Lugnuts won, 3-2... made official Lugnuts debut in Game 1 of a doubleheader at West Michigan, April 14... departed one out into the 5th with a 7-2 lead (though reliever David Leal then allowed an inherited runner to score); Nuts went on to triumph, 8-5... **last start, April 20 vs. Fort Wayne:** gave up two 2-R HRs to Joshua Mears, in the 3rd and the 5th, to spoil a solid outing; departed after 4 2/3 innings with 5 K's in Nuts' 9-7 loss.

**Evaluations:**

- MLB Pipeline ranks Estes as the No. 18 prospect in the A's system and the No. 6 pitching prospect... grades: fastball 55, slider 50, changeup 45, control 50... "All of Estes' stuff is trending in the right direction. He averaged 93.5 mph with his fastball in 2021, a good tick or two harder than in 2019 when he first entered pro ball, and it has unique characteristics and good life. At times, he relied on overpowering Low-A hitters just with the fastball, and other times, he mixed in an effective slider with better depth as well. There was some variability to it, thrown anywhere in the 82- to 87-mph range, with Estes having more success with it when he started throwing it a little harder. His changeup also improved, though it's still his third pitch."

- Keith Law had ranked Estes as the Braves' No. 15 prospect: "Drafted out of a California high school, Estes has gained about 2 mph since he was drafted, topping out now at 96 with good quality on the pitch and a slew of strikes. He struck out nearly a third of the guys he faced in Low A and did that mostly with his fastball, as his slider and changeup are still works in progress, with neither an average pitch yet. He has a super-short arm action and can come from a slightly lower slot, neither of which is ideal for a starter, but neither of which is a reason not to start him — they're just atypical. If he can improve those secondaries without changes to his delivery, which might in turn affect his control, he could be a back-end starter."

- Fangraphs places Estes at No. 21: "In Estes, Oakland acquired one of the Braves' breakout players from the 2021 campaign. A 16th-round pick in 2019 out of a California high school, Estes signed for a bonus of just under \$500,000, and that investment looks to have paid off handsomely after he put up a 32% strikeout rate in his full season debut. Estes doesn't blow you away with his stuff, but all three of his offerings are average to a tick above. His fastball was up and down much of the season, as he sat in the low-90s in some outings and was more 93-95 mph at his best. His low-80s slider ranges from fringy to plus, as he'll show occasional ability to put big sweep on the pitch, while his changeup is a bit firm but features good tumble. The three-pitch mix is made all the more effective by unpredictable sequencing and command of the entire arsenal that is well advanced for a pitching prospect who doesn't turn 21 until October. Estes has a back-end starter ceiling, and only injury should prevent him from reaching that mark."
