NOTES AND NUGGETS

JAC ATTACK

Last week, Royals top prospect **Jac Caglionone** was promoted from Double-A Northwest Arkansas to Triple-A Omaha ... last week in Omaha's series at Salt Lake, "Cags" went 9-for-26 with 5 homers and 10 RBI over his first 6 Triple-A games.

✦ Caglionone was selected by the Royals with the 6th overall pick in the 2024 MLB Draft, announced as a two-way player, though he has yet to pitch professionally.

✦ Caglionone leads Minor League Baseball with 53 RBI, is 4th in MiLB with 14 homers, 5th with 108 total bases and tied 5th with 61 hits.

✦ Cags is responsible for 5 of Omaha's 7 hardest-hit balls this season, including the hardest-hit ball of the year by a Chasers hitter, a home run on Wednesday at 113.6MPH ... his average exit velo is 1st in Omaha's offense, at 95.7MPH.

✦ Going 0-for-5 Tuesday, Cags snapped a 19-game hitting streak, a stretch where he hit .350 (28-for-75) with a 1.141 OPS from May 3 to 25, tied for the 3rd-longest hitting streak in the Minors this year ... he had reached base in 26 games, from April 25 to May 25, with a .356 average (37-for-104) and 1.097 OPS.

✦ Caglionone hit two home runs in Sunday's win over the Bees, his second two-homer game of the season ... he hit home runs in the last 4 games of the series against Salt Lake ... his first home run Sunday flew 459 feet, Omaha's longest of the season and the team's second-longest of the Statcast Era (since 2023).

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

✦ Omaha has successfully stolen 84 bases this year, and only been caught 12 times ... 84 steals rank 4th in the International League and among Triple-A teams.

✦ 84-for-96 in steal attempts is a 87.5% success rate, the highest stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and 3rd-best among full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 90.0%, 36-for-40).

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS

The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff sits near the top of the International League in strikeouts, with 520 strikeouts this season ... that is 2nd both in the league and also 2nd at the Triple-A level.

✦ Over 454.2 innings, Omaha pitchers are averaging 10.29 K/9, which ranks 3rd both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.

✦ With 520 strikeouts through 52 games, an average of 10.00 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,490 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.

WHAT A RELIEF

Omaha's bullpen has produced 11 scoreless games this season, most recently Tuesday night.

✦ Including Tuesday, 6 of 11 times the Storm Chasers' relievers have not allowed a run, it's been a stretch of 4.0 innings or more of scoreless relief.

✦ Going back to Sunday, Omaha's bullpen has combined to allow just 5 earned runs in 18.1 innings of work, a 2.45 ERA, 1.15 WHIP and .215 opponents' average.

✦ In the month of May, the bullpen has been responsible for more innings than the starters, pitching 114.2 of the team's 219.1 innings ... that is the 5th-most innings from relievers of the 20 International League teams in May.

SLOW YOUR ROLL

Omaha's offense has seen success this year against both fastballs and offspeed pitches ... but it's been in different ways.

✦ Against offspeed pitches, the Storm Chasers have a team OPS of .777, the best in the International League and 2nd among Triple-A teams, though an average exit velocity of 84.9MPH ranks 24th of 30 Triple-A clubs ... 10 home runs on offspeed pitches are the 2nd-most of any Triple-A club and 59 strikeouts are tied for the 3rd-fewest.

✦ Facing fastballs, Omaha's OPS is .800, which ranks 23rd of the 30 Triple-A teams ... however, an average exit velocity of 90.6MPH ranks 2nd at the Triple-A level.

FROM OMAHA TO THE SHOW

6 Omaha alumni have debuted in the Major Leagues this season, with the two most recent being members of the Storm Chasers' 2024 International League Championship team ... a third in poised for his MLB debut soon.

✦ Outfielder **John Rave** (2022-25) made his MLB debut with the Kansas City Royals yesterday afternoon, starting in right field and hitting 6th in the Royals' lineup ... he went 0-for-2 at the plate, but laid down a sacrifice bunt and drew a walk in the game against the Reds ... Rave is the 341st Triple-A Omaha player to reach the big leagues and currently leads the Minors in runs scored (46).

✦ Wednesday, the Royals selected the contract of pitcher **Andrew Hoffmann** (2023-25) ... his first appearance with Kansas City will be his Major League debut.

CHANDLER CHAMPLAIN SCOUTING REPORT

MLB Pipeline

Scouting grades: Fastball: 50 | Curveball: 50 | Slider: 50 | Changeup: 45 | Control: 50 | Overall: 40

A well-regarded high school pitching prospect, Champlain honored his Southern California commitment in 2018 and stayed close to home. Three years later, the Yankees selected him in the ninth round of the 2021 Draft and then traded him to the Royals as part of a three-pitcher package for Andrew Benintendi in 2022. Champlain returned to Double-A in '24 and showed he had mastered it with a 3.50 ERA, a 0.92 WHIP and a 34.5% strikeout rate in seven starts. The move to Triple-A was more challenging; Champlain made 28 appearances (27 starts) there for a 5.61 ERA, 15.5% strikeout rate and a 1.56 WHIP while batters hit .283 against him.

Champlain's average cutting fastball sits 91-94 mph, touching 97 in 2024. He spins the ball well and has improved his upper-70s curveball into a solid weapon. That pitch is different from his low- to mid-80s slider which has good depth and got some chase in '24 in a limited sample. Champlain also shows a cutter, which could be an out pitch eventually because of his natural movement, and his mid-80s changeup is still a work in progress, as it has been for several years. The lack of a pitch against lefties has hindered Champlain as he's faced better hitters. He has some effort in his delivery which affects his command at times, but he showed up to Spring Training over 100 pounds lighter.

Champlain has the look and mentality of a workhorse on the mound and has proven durable in the Minors, throwing 135 and 140 innings the past two seasons respectively. But he'll need to develop a weapon against lefties for him to reach his ceiling, otherwise there's thought he would have more in the tank as a multi-inning reliever with a fastball-curveball combination. He wasn't added to the 40-man when eligible for the Rule 5 Draft, but he'll return to Triple-A, be part of the Royals' depth and could make his debut in '25.

Track Record: Champlain was off to a good start in his return to Double-A in his second full year in the Royals organization since being acquired from the Yankees midway through 2022. In seven starts with Northwest Arkansas, the most noticeable statistic was an impressive 12 strikeouts per nine innings compared to just 1.8 walks. His promotion to Triple-A Omaha proved to be more challenging for Champlain. His strikeout rate decreased to 6.2 per nine innings, his walk rate rose to 4.0 and opponents hit .282 with 17 home runs in 104.1 innings.

Scouting Report: Champlain's four-seam fastball comes to the plate on a downward angle, sits 92-94 mph and touches 97—but he struggled to command it when he got to Triple-A. His 76-80 mph curveball improved enough in 2024 to be graded a plus pitch. At times it looked like one of the better benders in the minor leagues and misses plenty of bats in the zone with 12-to-6 shape and great finish. The slider is a distinct pitch from the curveball, averaging 85 mph with good depth. Champlain rounds out his repertoire with an 85 mph changeup and 86 mph cutter, both still in development. There's not a lot of athleticism in his delivery, making it more difficult to repeat and affecting his command.

The Future: Champlain projects as a big-bodied back-of-the rotation starter, although his stuff would tick up in shorter stints if he moved to the bullpen. He was not added to the 40-man roster when eligible after the 2024 season.

Took his second loss of the season, allowed a career-high 11 runs (9 earned) on a season-high 10 hits ... worked around a leadoff double for a scoreless 1st inning ... allowed 3 runs in the 2nd inning on a solo homer, error and wild pitch, triple and RBI single ... allowed a 2-run homer in the 3rd inning to Tucker Flint, his second home run of the game off Champ ... 5 singles and a walk opened the bottom of the 4th inning, could not get an out ... exited with 3 runs having already scored, all three runners he left on base came around to score, in what wound up a 9-run inning.

Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game since 2000. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.

Since 2000, there are **58** results in Triple-A Omaha games that have only happened once. **34** of those results (wins or losses) are a true scorigami, a scoring combination that has only happened once. Recent scorigami occurrences are listed to the right, with true scorigamis in bold.
