WELCOME TO THE DOG HOUSE

♦ Backed behind an efficient outing on the mound by **Logan Allen**, the Reno Aces came out on top in Thursday's matchup against the El Paso Chihuahuas in a tight 4-3 victory at Greater Nevada Field... Allen came away with the win after limiting the Chihuahuas to three runs across 6 2/3 innings, walking one and punching out three. It was the southpaw's first quality start since July 3... **Kyle Garlick** broke out of a slump, putting Reno on the board in the first inning with a line-shot RBI single into left field... **Sergio Alcantara** continued to swing it, going 2-for-2 with a walk. The switch-hitting infielder has gone 5-for-11 with five RBI this series... **Scott McGough** collected his sixth save of the campaign in the with, shutting down El Paso in order with one strikeout... Reno will look for another win in Friday's matchup against the El Paso Chihuahuas, the Triple-A affiliate of the San Diego Padres, with the first pitch scheduled for 6:35 p.m. PT.

♦ Reno leads Triple-A in AVG (.287), Hits (1346), Runs (825), and RBI (789)... 2nd in 2B (287)... 3rd in Total-Bases (2226)... 2nd least amount of strikeouts (999).

♥ This is the 10th of 12 matchups between the two clubs this season.

ACES vs WALDRON

♦ The Aces will take on right-hander Matt Waldron in Friday's matchup... Waldron is known for his knuckleball as he utilized his main pitch 38.2% of the time in 26 starts with the Padres this season... His knuckleball has been effective this season, posting a 66:6 K: BB in 900 pitches, limiting batters to .250/.297/.403 slashline, .276 xwOBA. It only has a spin rate (RPM) of 244... After spending most of the season with San Diego, Waldron was optioned to El Paso at the end of August and has made one start with the Chihuahuas... He allowed three runs (two earned) on four hits and no walks in 4 2/3 frames and just 72 pitches (49 strikes) against the Tacoma Rainiers, he punched out four... The 27-year-old enjoyed a great month of June with the big-league club, posting a 2.45 ERA with a 27:9 K: BB in 36 2/3 innings... He punched out 10 batters on May 17 against the Atlanta Braves, tossing 5 2/3 frames of one-run ball with the win... The righty owns a 3.86 ERA heading into the matchup.

TOMMY TIME

♦ **Tommy Henry** is slated to make his 18th start of the year on Friday against the El Paso Chihuahuas... Henry was efficient in his previous outing, allowing two runs (one earned) across five frames against the Albuquerque Isotopes, he walked two and punched out five... The southpaw was lights out vs El Paso in mid-August, striking out nine batters, and surrendering two runs in five innings with one walk... He enjoyed a dominant month of August, posting a 2.16 ERA with 43 punchouts and 12 walks in 33 1/3 innings (six starts)... The 27-year-old owns a 4.08 ERA with a 102:47 K: BB in 90 1/3 frames this season.

♦ Posted a 4.15 ERA across 17 games (16 GS) and 89 IP with ARI in 2023.

♥ Enters his sixth year (fifth season) in Arizona's organization.
